Scrip is a fund raiser for Sacred Heart, which is easy and painless. Parishioners purchase gift cards at face value and Sacred Heart purchases the cards direct from merchants or Great Lakes Scrip at a reduced price, resulting in an instant rebate for our parish.

In order to minister this program, volunteers are needed to sell scrip after our weekend Masses. Typically, our sellers sell after one Mass once a month. This involves staying approximately 15 to 20 minutes after Mass.

Sacred Heart also has two Scrip Coordinators who are responsible for ordering scrip, maintaining inventory, reconciling scrip sales and depositing sale proceeds in the scrip account.
