Jung's central hypothesis about Alchemy is that its texts and images are projections from the collective unconscious

- Alchemy is not only proto chemistry but also proto psychology
- Participation Mystique unspoiled by Cartesian Enlightment
- The imagery represents a catalogue of the structure and dynamics of the collective unconscious
- Jung suddenly stopped his work on The Red book when he learned about Alchemy

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Hermes: the holder of opposites, the beginning and end





Resurrection of the United Eternal Body, Rosarium Philisophorum, 1550

- Hermes as prima materia as well as the Lapis; holder of opposites; the beginning and end
- Hermes -Senex who is like Hermes trimegistus, Hermes the saviour, Hermes as archetype of the unconscious,
- Hermes as bringer of dreams, messenger God, metaphor for the transcedent function.
- Mercurius is the Cosmic Child, the Filius Macrocosmi (which is also the Philosopher's Stone and the inner man);

Prima Materia (Maier, Atalanta Fugiens 1618, plate 43)

Prima Materia

- Prima Materia is the *increatum*, the chaos prior to the operation of the world-creating logos
- The matter lies before the eyes of all; everybody sees it, touches it, loves it, but knows it not. It is glorious and vile, precious and of small account, and is found everywhere... But, to be brief, our Matter has as many names as there are things in this world; that is why the foolish know it not. Waite. trans The hermetic Museum 1:13
- The prima materia is undifferentiated, without definite boundaries, limits or form. This corresponds to a certain experience of the unconscious that exposes the ego to the infinite, the $\alpha \pi \epsilon \rho ov$ (the undetermined), it may invoke the terror of diddolution or the awe of eternity. It provides a glimpse of the $\pi \lambda \eta \rho \omega \mu \alpha$ (the all, the totality of divine powers)

Examinandus says:

I make known to you, ye sons of the doctrine, that the beginning of all creatures is a certain primary everlasting and infinite nature whoch cooks and rules everything, and whose active and passive [aspects] are known and recognized only by those on whom the knowledge of the sacred art has been bestowed

Art. aurif. I, p66. Eximindus is a corruption of Anaximenes or Anaximander






Individuation

In general, it is the process by which individual beings are formed and differentiated; in particular, it is the development of the psychological individual as a being distinct from the general, collective psychology. Individuation is therefore a process of differentiation having for its goal the development of the individual personality

Clinically it is important to distinguish between the lesser and the greater conjunctio

the lesser coniunctio

- * the lesser conjunctio is a union of substances that are not yet thoroughly separated
- * it occurs whenever the ego identifies with contents emerging from the unconscious
- * it is always followed by the Morteficatio and further Separatio

the greater coniunctio

- * is the goal of the opus
- * the supreme accomplishment
- the experience of the coniunctio is almost always a mixture of the lesser and greater aspects (Circulatio)


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Separatio as a first step can spark specific meaning





Golden Section

the Golden Section is a very interesting separatio symbol: it expresses the idea that there is a particular way to separate the opposites that will create a third thing (the proportion or mean between them) of value











Two Fishes in the Sea (Book of Lambspring , North Germany 16th century)

The Sages will tell you That two fishes are in our sea Without any flesh or bones. Let them be cooked in their own water; Then they also will become a vast sea, The vastness of which no man can describe. Moreover, the Sages say That the two fishes are only one, not two; They are two, and nevertheless they are one, Body, Spirit, and Soul. Now, I tell you most truly, Cook these three together, That there may be a very large sea. Cook the sulphur well with the sulphur, And hold your tongue about it: Conceal your knowledge to your own advantage, And you shall be free from poverty. Only let your discovery remain a close secret.
