Unique opportunity to help yourself and help the Church.

For the last 10 years the church has paid an attractive rate of interest on funds members and friends have loaned to the church to reduce the size of the mortgage. The church pays less interest than on our mortgage loan and you earn substantially more interest than offered by financial institutions on CD's and savings accounts. The church will pay 3% simple interest for 5 years. Interest is paid quarterly.

In 5 years, you will have the option to cash out your investment or renew it for another 5 years. Early withdrawal is permitted in the event of an emergency. The next opportunity will start October 1st, 2021. Minimum amount is \$20,000, increasing from there in increments of \$5,000.
