“ I have no digestive symptoms! When is the time to screen for intestine cancer (colonoscopy)?”

- We'll let you know, according to your profile, which and when to do the preventive screening tests - **Secondary prevention** is the detection of early asymptomatic disease or risk factor, through periodic medical evaluation

“What can I do to decrease my risk of heart attack or stroke?”

- We'll assess your risk and tailor recommendations to decrease your chance for a cardio vascular event – **Primary prevention**

“ I want my memory great for many years”

- After a **Comprehensive Medical Evaluation**, you'll learn how to diminish your chances to mental decline

“I feel fine! Should I have a medical evaluation?”

- The (2015) US Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommend yearly physical exam for adults with risk factors. Adults with no risk factors should be rescreened every three to five years - **Primary prevention** are interventions to keep disease from occurring, that includes behavioral counseling, immunization among others

“ I would like an english speaking doctor that knows about my health”

“ I would like a generalist, geriatrician to go over my medications, and evaluate the real need of them”

- Your primary care MD cannot guarantee 24 hours access, but you'll have his personal cell phone number and email. Your primary care MD have 24 hour access to your medical records and can make home or hospital visits if needed. He'll coordinate and make recommendations for your chronic physical or mental conditions - **Tertiary prevention** describes clinical activities that prevent deterioration or reduce complications after a disease has declared itself

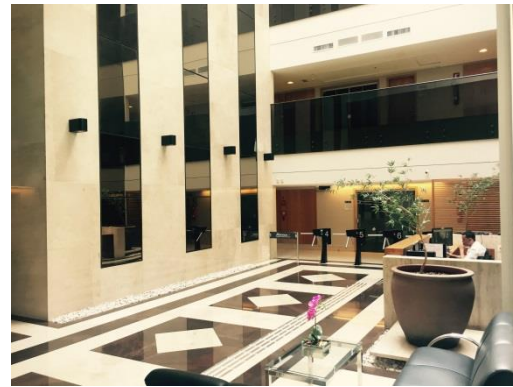
- Reference: driving from North to South, to reach 915 sul, turn right just the “pyramid of LBV” (*Legião da Boa Vontade*)
