Class Dojo

Thank you for your patience so we could look into departmental policy and seek advice from the legal department regarding the use of Class Dojo. Teachers may use this platform to communicate with parents and parents with teachers. Some teachers may use Class Dojo to provide some feedback about your child, relay organisation and arrangements for activities and events such as Starstruck and provide class stories. Please be conscious of teachers' personal time as they will put quiet times on their phones. Also, please be mindful that your communications to teachers are appropriate. Sending photos of your child, questions and comments about other children and sharing personal family experiences on Class Dojo are not appropriate on this platform.

Dojo points will be used in classrooms with Clancys being a part of the Positive Behaviour for Learning. Certificates and medals are aligned to this award system. Dojo points will be internally used within classes to recognise such things as behaviour, classwork and effort and will not be a part of communications from teachers. I hope this clarifies that Class Dojo can be an effective means of communication for some of our teachers. Care though needs to be taken for teachers and their personal time and use of the platform in an appropriate fashion.

Library News

Premier's Reading Challenge Reminder

To register for the Premier's Reading Challenge students go to <u>https://online.det.nsw.edu.au/prc/home.html</u> and logon using their school (DET) username and password (eg. john.smith, password student, or kim.brown2, password student). Once logged on, students can add books to their online reading logs (Student Reading Record) simply by searching by book title and adding each book to their reading record. If you experience any difficulty registering or logging on, please see your child's class teacher or Mrs Gibson in the library for the correct username and password.

Kindergarten students are not aware of their school usernames, therefore paper reading logs were handed out to only students in Kindergarten. These students are able to write the books that they have read on the paper reading log, and when it is full, the log can be returned to Mrs Gibson in the library for completion online. A list of PRC approved books is accessible on the Premiers Reading Challenge website.

The 2018 Challenge kicks off **Monday 5th March** and closes **Friday 31st August** (midnight) for **students**. For students in 1-6, once their reading logs have been finalised, please print the reading log and hand it to Mrs Gibson for verification. If a printer is not available at home students are welcome to print their reading logs at school. The PRC certificates will be sent directly to the school and will be handed out at assembly at the end of the year.

The class with the most students completing the Premier's Reading Challenge will be rewarded with a whole class surprise at the end of the challenge.
