Costs of Infant Milks Marketed in the UK

February 2017

We have calculated the cost of all the infant milks currently marketed over the counter in the UK that are featured in the *Infant Milks in the UK* report, February 2017. We have calculated this based on the cost of 100ml of made-up powdered product, or 100ml of the ready to feed (RTF) equivalent.

How did we calculate prices?

We have taken prices from the Boots the Chemist website, Ocado or Tesco online supermarket or for organic products from the organic supermarkets Planet Organic and Wholefoods. Prices may vary between retailers, and some products which are not covered by specific regulations that prohibit it, can be price reduced, but these represent typical prices at the time the calculations were made. We used scoop weights either from our own analysis work (where they were measured in duplicate in a chemistry laboratory) or from manufacturer information. There might be some slight discrepancy in weights as some manufacturers give a more general scoop weight for all products, and in some cases we have estimated scoop weight from the nearest product equivalent as the data has not been provided.

We calculated the amount of powder in g that would be in 100ml of made up infant milk using the standard of 1 scoop to 30ml of water (or 1 scoop to 60ml of water for Similac products), and recalculating to the amount of powder that would then be present in 100ml of made up formula. Typically 3 scoops of formula and 90ml of water make 102-104g of formula, so weights have been adjusted accordingly for each milk type.

1.0 Starter packs of First infant formula

These 70ml bottles are marketed in packs, for families to use in the first days after birth. We have calculated the cost per day if these milks are used, based on guidance that approximately 8 feeds are given in 24hours in the first week of life (Table 1). This is an extremely expensive way of giving infant milk: giving an infant given Aptamil Profutura 1 First Infant Milk RTF starter pack bottles in the first week, based on 8 bottles a day, would cost a family £102.34 a week, using Aptamil 1 First Infant Milk starter pack bottles would cost £74.48, using SMA Pro First Infant Milk RTF starter packs would cost £65.45 a week and using Cow & Gate 1 First Infant Milk RTF starter packs would cost £60.76 a week.

2.0 First Infant milks – Ready to feed (RTF)

Table 2 shows milks marketed as first milks suitable from birth sold as ready to feed milks. We have compared costs by cost per 100ml milk, and costed a day's intake based on an average intake at 2-3 months of 920ml/day.

RTF milks maybe a useful option when facilities to make up milks safely are lacking or when travelling, but are around three times more expensive than powdered formula. The most expensive RTF (Aptamil Profutura 1 First Infant Milk) costs 50p per 100ml, the cheapest first infant milk in RTF format is Cow & Gate 1 First Infant Milk in 1 litre bottles which costs 32p per 100ml (we do not recommend milks marketed for hungrier babies).

3.0 First Infant milks – powdered formulations (PIF)

Infant milks can be made from cows' or goats' milk or be soy protein based by law, and first milks detailed here include first infant formula, hungry baby milks and those specialised milks sold over the counter. We have compared costs by cost per 100ml made up milk, and costed a day's intake based on an average intake at 2-3 months of 920ml/day.

Powdered infant milks are highly variable in cost. The most expensive Holle Organic Infant Goats Milk Formula 1 costs 35p per 100ml. All three goats' milk based formula on the market are the most expensive powdered milks, with Kabrita Gold 1 and NANNYCare First Infant Milk both costing 33p per 100ml. For powdered cows' milk based infant formula there are considerable cost differences: Holle Organic infant formula 1 at 28p per 100ml and Aptamil Profutura 1 First Infant Milk at 21p per 100ml are the most expensive compared to the cheapest powdered first infant formula Bebivita First Infant Milk costing 11p per 100ml and Mamia First Infant Milk costing 10p per 100ml. As all first infant milks must meet current EU regulations for infant formula composition, there is no need for families to buy more expensive formula. Many of the more expensive brands make health claims, but can only do so for those ingredients that are not needed, and these unnecessary ingredients may in fact be a burden on a young child's metabolism. The cheaper milks do not currently make claims through marketing and advertising and therefore families benefit when companies simply produce a product which meets regulations without making health claims. The cost of feeding a 2-3 month baby over a month (30 days) can therefore vary in cost from £96.60 to £27.60. Considering the most available brands in supermarkets, a family choosing Aptamil 1 Profutura powdered infant milk would spend £57.90 a month compared to £36.00 if Hipp Organic Combiotic First Infant Milk was chosen.

4.0 Follow-on Formula

<u>Follow-on formula are not recommended</u>, but are marketed for infants from 6 months of age, both as powdered and RTF milks. Table 4 summarises the cost of these milks, and considers a daily cost of 600ml formula per day used at 7-12 months of age. RTF and goats' milk based products remain the most expensive, and there are some small differences in cost between first and follow-on formula dependent on scoop weight differences. The cost of the follow on milk packs however are generally the same as those for first milks and it is recommended that a first infant milk is used throughout the first year if formula is used.

5.0. Other infant milks: 'Growing up' and toddler milks

<u>These milks are not recommended</u>. The cost of these have been compared to a whole cows' milk equivalent, which is suitable for most children from 1 year of age who are eating well. Using the more expensive of these milks would cost a family over £11 per week, and there may be disadvantages to using these products as they are typically sweeter than whole animal milk, may be flavoured, and may be lower in many important nutrients.
