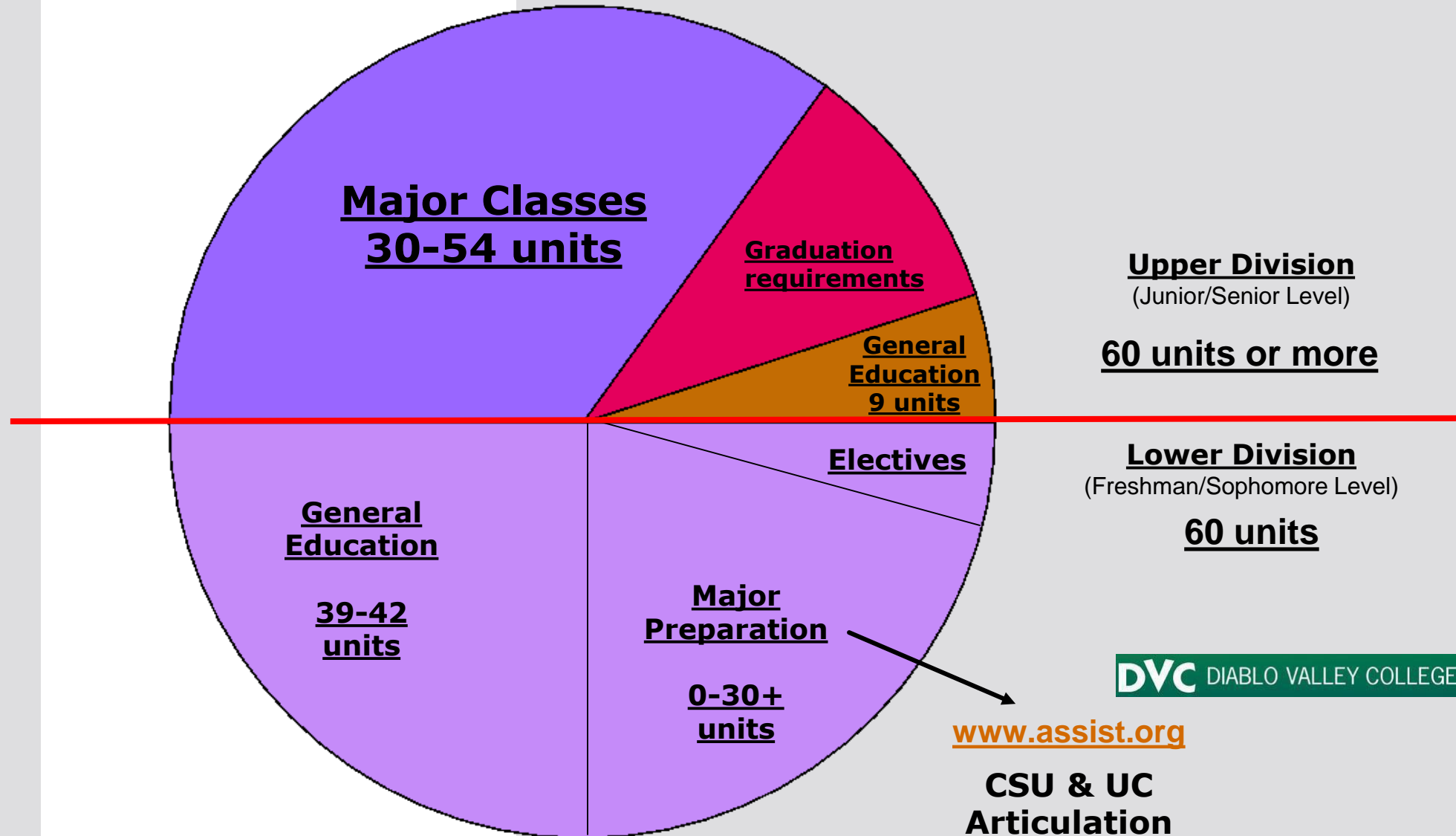

# CSU Transfer Admission Requirements

- ✓ 60 CSU transferable units
- ✓ 2.0 minimum GPA
- ✓ Golden Four completed with a “C” or better:
  - ✓ Written Communication
  - ✓ Oral Communication
  - ✓ Critical Thinking
  - ✓ Transfer-level Mathematics
- ✓ 30 semester GE units

## AA-T/AS-T: Who is it for?

This kind of Associate Degree is most beneficial for students who are:

- ▶ Preparing for impacted CSU majors or campuses, AICCU/HBCU partners
- ▶ Seeking an associate degree while preparing to transfer
- ▶ Preparing broadly for more than one CSU/HBCU/AICCU
- ▶ Attending a college that does not have major preparation for their intended CSU campus and/or AICCU/HBCU campus

- ▶ Take only 60 units after transfer to get earn BA or BS
- ▶ Meet all lower division major prep at most CSU, AICCU, HBCU campuses that offer a **similar major**

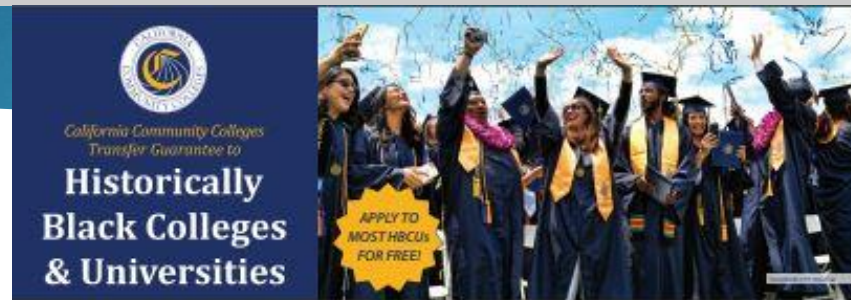

# What is the UC TAG Program?

TAG = Transfer Admission Guarantee

*A formal, written agreement guaranteeing admission to a UC Campus!*

*Available at all UCs except Berkeley, LA, & San Diego*

## How it works:

- Meet GPA criteria (differs by campus but usually around 3.2)
- Completion of 30 UC transferable units by end of the summer prior to the fall semester which they will be filing an application.
- Apply for TAG in September of year prior to transfer
- Demonstrate you will have completed required GE and major preparation
- Lock in an admission guarantee well in advance of transfer!
- You are not locked in - can choose to attend another campus

# How Students Apply for a TAG Agreement

Students who are eligible need to:

1. Complete the online [UC TAG application](https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu) (<https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu>) and submit it during the appropriate filing period - September 1-30
2. Once TAG is submitted, fulfill all remaining coursework and GPA requirements designated on the TAG agreement.
3. Apply for admission to UC during November 1-30 for fall admission and July 1-31 for Spring/Winter admission:

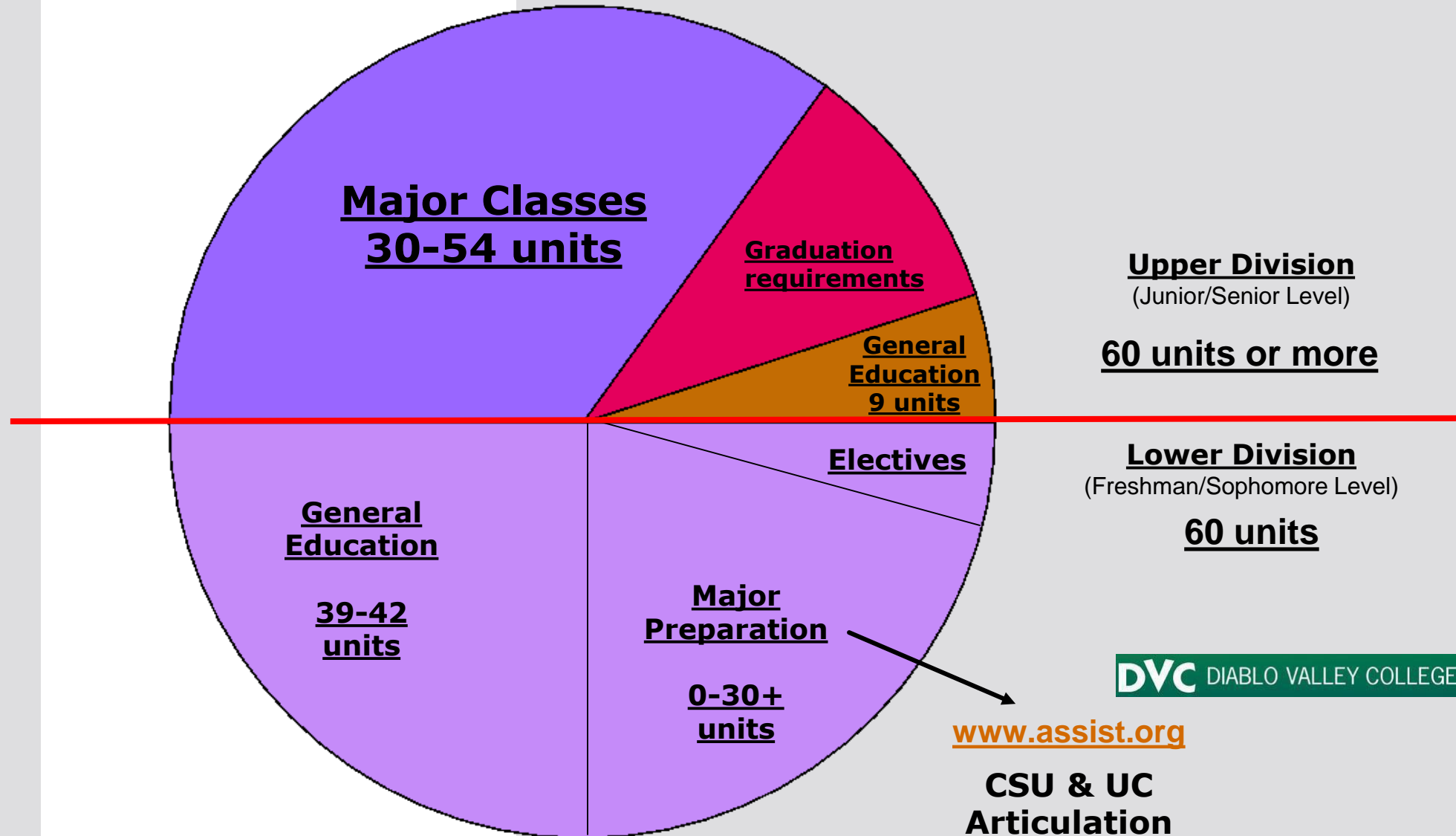

Examples:

- St. Mary's College, Santa Clara University, University of the Pacific, University of San Francisco (USF), University of Southern (USC), University of San Diego, Pepperdine University, Mills College, Loyola Marymount University
- Campuses vary in size
- Typically, have smaller class sizes than CSU & UC
- Costs \$60,000 + per year (tuition only)
- Often large financial aid awards and grants are available including scholarships

# AP EXAMS & THEIR MANY APPLICATIONS

## Student Scenario 1:

- ▶ Student 1 is beginning to work on their Education Plan with the Counselor. The student indicates, “I’m all done with IGETC because I took all my AP exams in high school and earned 3’s on all, so I should only have to be at DVC for 1 year and then transfer, right?”

## Student Scenario 2:

- ▶ Student 2 is a Psychology major at DVC pursuing the Associate’s Degree for Transfer (AA-T) in Psychology. Since they earned a score of 3 on the AP Psychology exam, they ask the Counselor if they can use their AP Psychology exam to satisfy the requirement or if they need to take PSYCH-101 at DVC.

## Student Scenario 3:

- ▶ Student 3 wants to apply to the Psychology major at UC Davis. Since PSYCH-101 is a required course for UC Davis’ Psychology major, the student wants to use their score of 3 on the AP Psychology exam to satisfy this requirement. Can they, or do they have to take DVC’s PSYCH-101 course?
