Leroy Webre, a member of the class of 1960, became a Brother with the Order of St. Benedict at St. Joseph Abbey in Covington, Louisiana. He is now known as Brother Joseph LeRoy Webre and is actively involved in the Pennies for Bread program.

In October 1990, Saint Joseph Abbey began the Pennies for Bread program providing 1,000 loaves a week, 52 weeks a year, to be distributed to the hungry through designated charitable organizations. Presently 2000 loaves are distributed weekly providing bread for more than 1 million meals annually in the New Orleans area.

Brother Joseph LeRoy Webre, O.S.B. has been an integral part of this ministry. He baked and delivered bread to the poor neighborhoods of New Orleans for 18 years, becoming a friend and a welcome sight to the poor and homeless, literally feeding the Lord's sheep. Without him it may not have been as successful as it is today.

Sacred Heart boys and girls continue to serve the Lord and Brother Webre is a shining star!
