- G- 1 Approved College Prep Elective


## Course Selection

All Freshmen must pick 6 classes including:

- Science

Then choose any of the following to fill your 6 classes:

- VAPA (Visual and Performing Art) and/or Elective
- World History (need 1 years in either 9th or 10th grade
- World Language (need 2 years before graduation)
