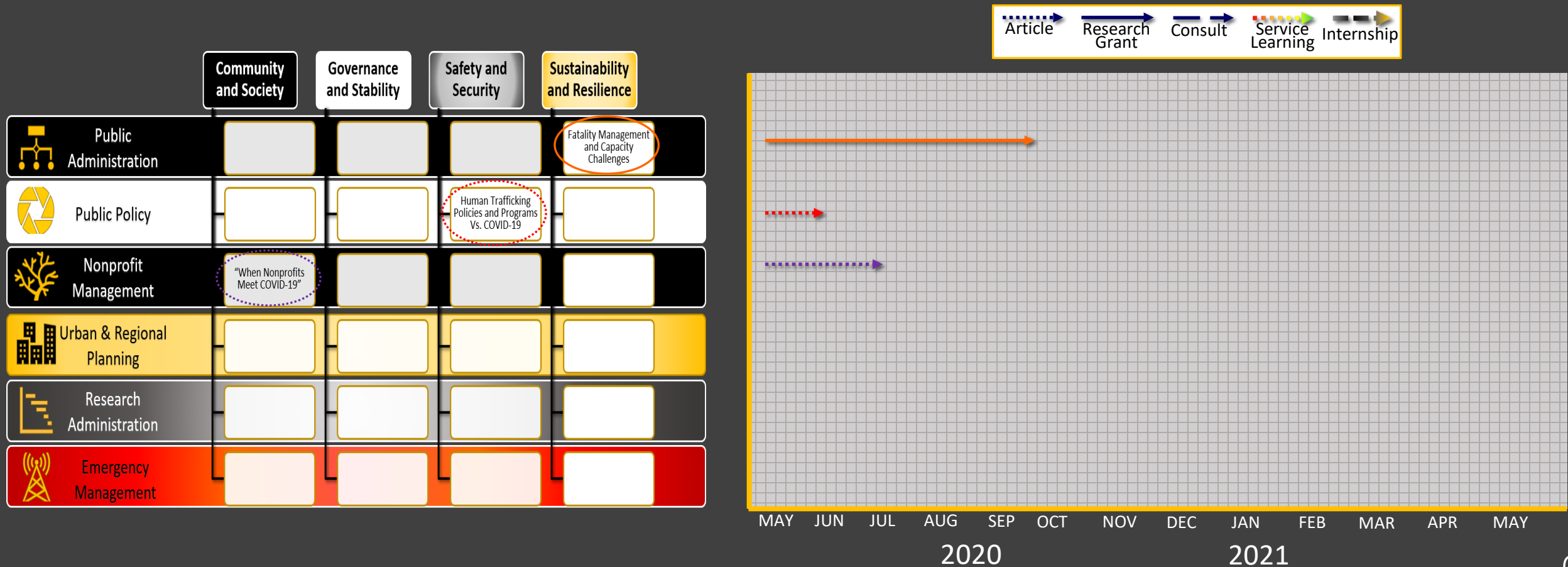

COVID-19 Projects Map - Current

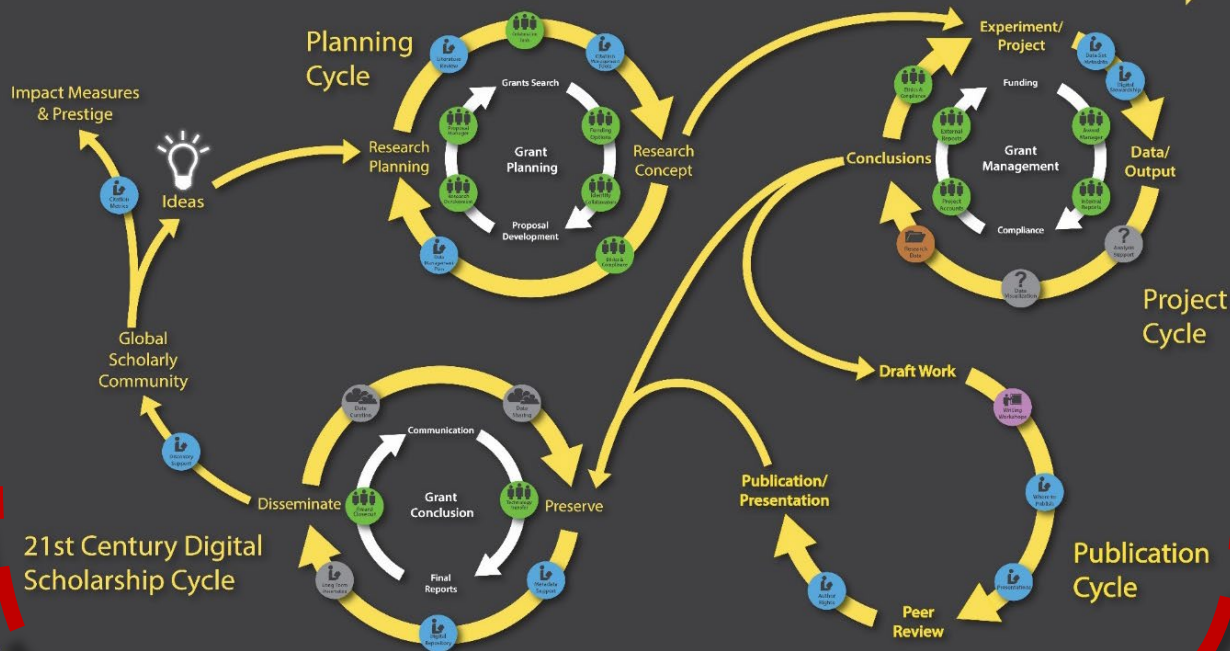

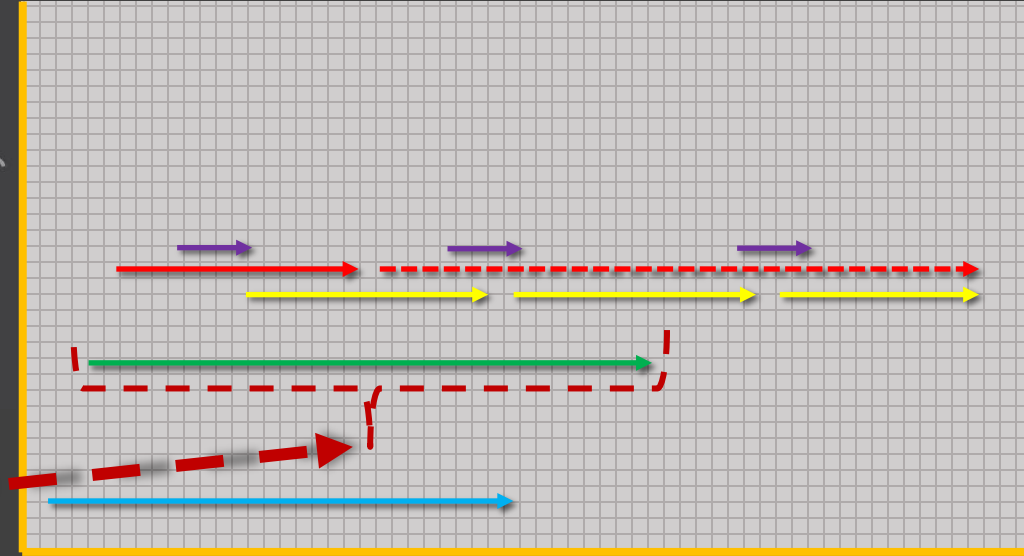
