DATE: Jan. 16-17 THEME: Honesty

MEMORY VERSE: 1 John 3:18

BOTTOM LINE: I will be truthful always.

BTBLE STORY: Zacchaeus - Luke 19:1-10

Craft:

GET THIS:

- » Zacchaeus Handout
- » Cut out of Zacchaeus
- » Green Tissue Paper Squares
- » Piece of String (1)
- » Tape or Glue*

DO THIS:

- Take the Zacchaeus handout and thread the piece of yarn through the two holes and tie the ends together on the back side.
- Crumple the green tissue paper squares and tape/glue those to the top of the tree.
- Cut out and tape Zacchaeus to the yarn at the bottom of the tree.
 Pull the yarn to move Zacchaeus up and down.

CONNECTION POINT:

When we move Zacchaeus up and down, we remember that he was honest with Jesus.

GET THIS:

- » Zacchaeus Craft
- » Bible or Bible App*

DO THTS:

- I. Read Luke 19:1-10
- While reading the story, use your craft to recreate what Zacchaeus did throughout the story

CONNECTION POINT:

Every time we read this story, we are reminded how important it is to always be truthful, even when it's hard.

Memory Verse:

GET THIS:

- » Dixie Cups (10)
- » Memory Verse Labels (10)

DO THTS:

- Stick one sticker to each dixie cup starting with the first dixie cup upright and then alternate with the second flipped upside down.
- 2. Stack the cups in numbered ordered. Start with the first cup upright then flip the next cup so the openings match up. Flip the next cup so the bottoms match up.
- Try to make a tower without the cups falling over.

CONNECTION POINT:

Sod reminds us through this verse that we should show love to others by being honest.


