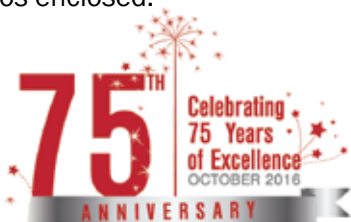


FROM THE Principal's Desk...

Co-Ed Volley Ball Wins the League!

Volunteer Coach Luis Morejon led the Triple C Co-Ed volleyball team into another successful season. He created the school's first volleyball team in 2013 and took the team to their first PSA volleyball tournament in 2015, winning the first PSA volleyball tournament. The team regained the title in 2017 and has held on to the title for a consecutive season. Coach Wiltshire and Mr. Marcus Patterson finished the season with the team. The team took the victory with an 8-0 win. The PSA Volleyball League is a five-week competition with other private schools on the island.



Chlouie Gaetos was awarded the MVP of the tournament. In her own sportsmanship style Gaetos delegated the MVP to Omar Roach. Triple C's Vice Principal, Mr. Robert Lankford, confirmed that Roach was to receive an honorable mention for his contributions to the team.

Triple C's U18 boys football team won the PSA league tournament. As with the volleyball win mentioned above, this was also for the second year in a row!

Coach Luis Morejon carried the team through to the championship. Jayden Downey was voted MVP of the tournament. Coach Morejon, a volunteer parent coach began coaching the team 10 years ago. "This is the first time that a school has won the PSA championships in two sports, for two consecutive years. I am so proud of both of the soccer and volleyball teams and it has been such great privilege to be able to mentor and coach these students. They have become like a family to me. Many of the team members are graduating this year and I wish them all the best." Coach Wiltshire, one of the physical education teachers at Triple C continues to lead the U18 soccer team through the PSA league with other private schools. The U18 Soccer league is ongoing for 10 weeks following the one-day championship tournament.

Triple C's Vice Principal, Robert Lankford congratulated the team and noted that this year was another historical year, as it was the first time a Private School in the Cayman Islands has won both the football and volleyball tournaments two years running.

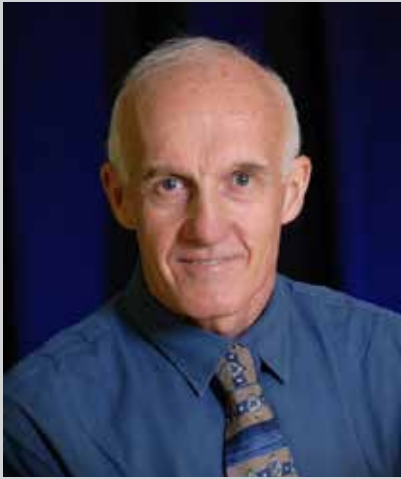

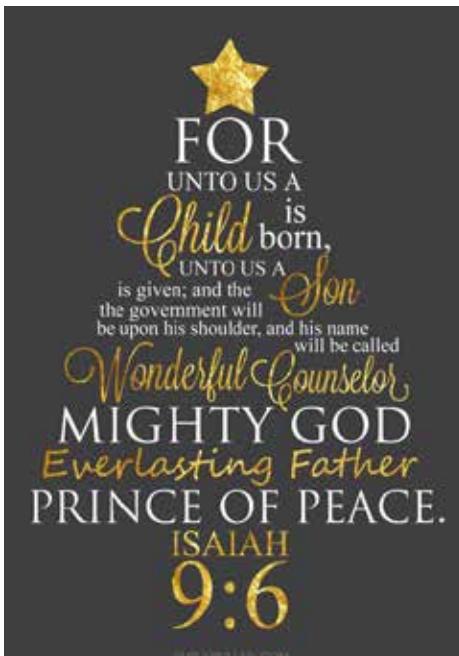
other purposes as needed.

Preschool Field Trip to See the Fire Trucks

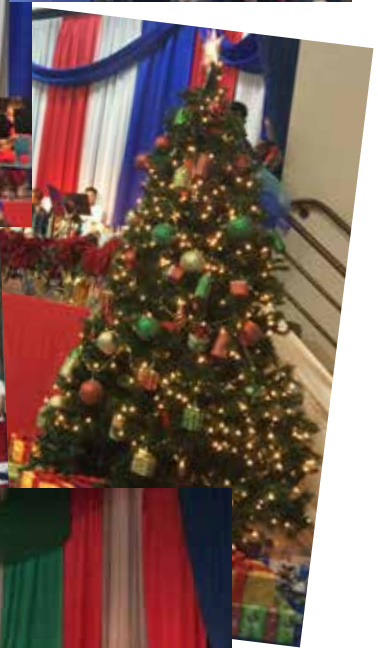

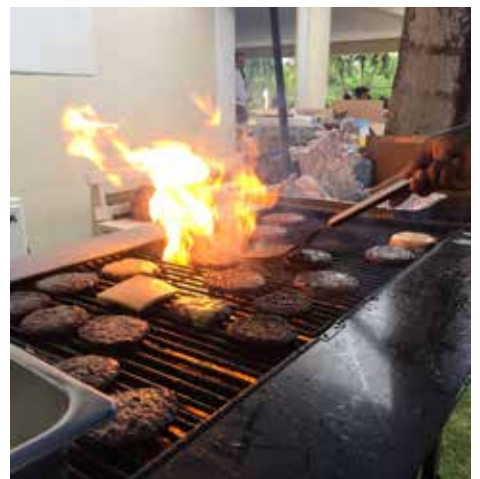


Christmas Fun for Every Class!
