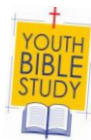
Children’s Choir

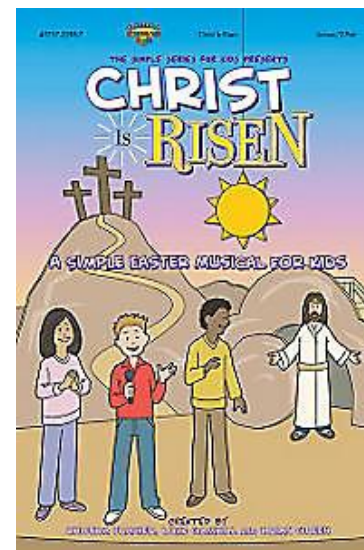
