DALLA STAZIONE DEI TRENI

Usciti dalla Stazione attraversare il Ponte degli Scalzi. Proseguire a destra lungo la Fondamenta S. Simeon Piccolo, girare la prima calle a sinistra in Calle Nova de San Simeon. Proseguire per il Ramo delle Chioverete, Calle delle Chioverete e Calle Sechera. Attraversare il Ponte Canal e proseguire per Calle de la Laca. Si arriva in Campiello della Scuola: ingresso principale sulla sinistra.

DA PIAZZALE ROMA (BUS STOP)

Lasciandosi alle spalle Piazzale Roma nelle vicinanze della pensilina del tram si arriva al ponte in marmo bianco. Attraversarlo e proseguire diritto costeggiando i Giardini Papadopoli fino al Ponte dei Tolentini alla fine del quale bisogna girare a sinistra. Proseguire verso il portico che immette in Calle dei Amài. Superare il Ponte de le Sechere e prendere a sinistra la Calle del Campazzo. Proseguire fino alla fine immettendosi a destra in Calle de la Laca. Proseguire lungo quest'ultima fino al Campiello della Scuola: ingresso principale al civico 2454, a sinistra.

DALL' AEROPORTO

Prendere l'autobus numero 5 per Venezia. Scendere al capolinea (Piazzale Roma Bus stop). Seguire le indicazioni sopra descritte.

DA SAN TOMA (FERMATA DEL VAPORETTO Actv)

Scendere dal vaporetto alla fermata S. Tomà proseguire lungo la calle, in fondo girare a destra in Campo S. Tomà e prendere il Ramo dei Calegheri, alla fine girare a sinistra e quindi a destra in Calle Larga. Proseguire per tutta la Calle Larga, fino al Campo dei Frari. In Campo dei Frari girare a destra costeggiando tutta la Basilica dei Frari. Attraversare il Ponte dei Frari e girare a sinistra. Attraversare il Ponte di S. Stin e girare a sinistra in Rio Terà San Tomà fino alla Calle del Magazen. Percorrere tutta la Calle del Magazen fino al Portale Monumentale d'ingresso della Scuola Grande San Giovanni Evangelista. Entrare nel Campiello della Scuola: ingresso principale sulla destra.



FROM THE TRAIN STATION

Exit the station and cross the Ponte degli Scalzi. Continue on the right along the Fondamenta S.Simeon Piccolo, turn left into Calle Nova de S.Simeon. Continue for the Ramo delle Chioverete, Calle delle Chioverete and Calle Sechera. Cross Ponte Canal and continue for the Calle de la Laca; you arrive at Campiello della Scuola: main entrance is at n° 2454 on the left.

FROM PIAZZALE ROMA (BUS STOP)

Leave the bus terminus by following indications for Frari and cross the white marble bridge. Continue straight across the Giardini Papadopoli. Cross the Ponte dei Tolentini and turn left. Continue towards the porch that leads into Calle dei Amài. Pass the Ponte delle Sechere and bear left for Calle del Campazzo. Continue until the end and turn right to Calle de la Laca. Continue through the Calle until Campiello della Scuola: main entrance is at n° 2454 on the left.

FROM THE AIRPORT

Take the bus number 5 for Venice. Alight at the terminus (Piazzale Roma - Bus stop). Follow the above directions.

FROM SAN TOMA - WATERBUS (VAPORETTO Actv) STOP

Alight from waterbus (vaporetto) at S. Tomà, continue along the calle and at the end turn right into Campo S. Tomà. From Campo S. Tomà take the Ramo dei Calegheri, and at the end turn left and then right into Calle Larga. Continue down the Calle Larga until Campo dei Frari. From Campo dei Frari turn right alongside the Basilica dei Frari. Cross Ponte dei Frari and turn left. Cross Ponte di S. Stin and turn left in Rio Terà S. Tomà until Calle del Magazen. Cover the all Calle del Magazen until Marble Septum which is the entrance of Scuola Grande San Giovanni Evangelista. Enter the Campiello della Scuola: main entrance is at n° 2454 on the left.
