# Crowds Welcome Jesus to Jerusalem

Psalm 118:19-29; Matthew 21:1-11



# What Was He Thinking?

In this passage, why did Jesus send his disciples to "borrow" a donkey and her colt without asking? And why would he tell them to respond, "The Lord needs them" if questioned? Some have speculated that Jesus had arranged in advance to borrow the donkey. Others suggest that he likely knew the owner and knew the donkey would be offered if needed. Or, as God, he may have already known how the owner would respond.

Jesus obviously couldn't ride both animals at the same time. Riding on a colt fulfilled the prophecy from Zechariah 9:9 and demonstrated Jesus' humble spirit. The mother donkey likely walked alongside her colt, since it would have been typical for a donkey to accompany her colt wherever it was led.

# **A Carpet of Cloaks**

Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem was the high point of his earthly ministry. Military victors were often honored with such a procession when they returned from battle. People placing their cloaks as a carpet on the street was an act of honor and of submission. The people also used cut palm branches as a victory celebration for Jesus. These acts fulfilled other prophecies about Jesus.

### **A Garment of Praise**

The passage the people quoted as they shouted "hosanna" is Psalm 118:25-26, where the word hosanna is translated "Lord save us!" Or it could be simply translated "Save!" used as an expression of praise.

The crowd stirred up the city so dramatically that many asked who Jesus was. Yet five days later, a crowd in that same city demanded Jesus be crucified

(Matthew 27:22-26)! If the events ended there, we would have little reason to praise. But when Jesus rose from the dead, he demonstrated that he truly was God.

### The Jesus Connection

Jesus' life, death, and resurrection made it possible for us to have eternal life through a relationship with him. He is the reason for our hope and our happiness. Praise Jesus for everything he is!

Praising Jesus is about more than just thanking him—it keeps us focused on his love for us. Jesus wants us to praise him publicly and privately, so others see his love as well. What can you personally praise Jesus for? Praise him by writing down four or five things he has done for you, and thank him. Share your praises with someone else so that person can be blessed, too. You can write your praises here.

# Welcome and Celebrate

**Tip** Consistently use the same signal to announce a transition to the next activity. You could flip the lights off and on, use a train whistle, have a puppet rustling inside a bag, or sing cleanup songs. Keep it simple, consistent, and fun.

# What You'll Do

As the children arrive, greet each one with a smile. When it's time to begin, use your signal to gather the children together in a circle.

Lead children in singing "All the Children Praise the Lord" (track 2 on the CD) to the tune of "Yankee Doodle." Encourage children to follow the motions in parentheses.

All the kids have come to church, (spread arms wide)
And we're so glad to be here. (clap hands)
All the kids have come to praise (raise hands toward heaven)
The Lord that we hold so dear. (clasp hands to chest)
All the children praise the Lord. (wave hands above head)
All the children praise the Lord. (wave hands above head)
All the children praise the Lord. (wave hands above head)
Now aren't you glad you're here? (nod head)
(Repeat 2x.)

Say: Are you glad to be here? Pause. I'm glad, too, because we can praise God together for his great love. That's something to sing about!

Have kids stand and sing "His Great Love" (Romans 5:8) (track 3 on the CD). Encourage children to follow the motions in parentheses.

God loves us. (cross arms over chest)
God sent his Son to die for us (raise both arms high and lower them slowly)
Because of his great love. (cross arms over chest and sway)
(Repeat.)

His great love, (point up)
God showed his great big love (move hands side to side)
By sending Christ to die for us (lower arms and march in place)
While we were still sinners.
(Repeat.)

# Talk With Kids

Say: I love it when ▶ WE PRAISE JESUS. He's so great and I love telling him that!



# Circle of Praise

#### What You'll Do

Have the children sit in a circle. Open your Bible to Galatians 2:20, and show children the words.

Say: Our Key Verse from the Bible says, "The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." That means that when we believe in Jesus he's a part of our lives. It means that Jesus loved me and gave himself for me. Let's say that together. Lead the children in repeating the simplified Key Verse with you: Jesus loved me and gave himself for me (Galatians 2:20).

Say: Jesus loved us so much that he gave his life for us! Before Jesus died for us, we couldn't live in heaven because of all the wrong things we do. But he died so that we can be forgiven. That's great news! And we can praise Jesus for what he did in many ways. Some people clap their hands when they hear good news. Lead children in clapping. Some shout when they hear good news. Lead children in shouting, "I just love Jesus!" Some people sing to Jesus like we sang earlier.

#### Talk With Kids

Lead children in this discussion.

#### Ask:

- Why do people get excited about Jesus?
- What ways do you like to praise Jesus?

Say: Our Key Verse says: Jesus loved me and gave himself for me. That's definitely something to get excited about! WE PRAISE JESUS to thank him for giving his life for us and to show him how we excited we are.

# What You'll Do

Say: Listen everyone, Theo's coming! He has something to show us. Let's find out what it is. Play "Here, Theo" (track 4 on the CD), and bring out Theophilus the FaithRetriever.

Theo: Hi, everybody!

Teacher: Hello, Theo! It's so good to see you at church with us today. I see you've

brought a CD with you.

**Theo:** A friend of mine gave me this CD—and I thought you'd like it.

**Teacher:** What kind of music is on it?

Theo: It's music about Jesus.

Teacher: Then you were right! I really like songs about Jesus - I sing to praise Jesus all

the time.

**Theo:** Sounds great—would you show me?

Teacher: I'd love to-

**Theo:** (Cuts teacher off.)...I'm kind of shy about singing.

**Teacher:** You don't have to sing, Theo. We know lots of ways to praise God. Friends,

what are other ways to praise God? (Allow time.)

Friends, let's tell Theo our Bible Point. (Lead children in saying the Bible Point for Theo:

**▶** WE PRAISE JESUS.)

**Teacher:** Praising Jesus is something we can do every day. We can sing, pray, shout,

and clap our hands to celebrate Jesus' love!

**Theo:** That's so neat! Thanks so much for showing me how you praise Jesus! **Teacher:** And thanks for bringing this CD to me. Let's say goodbye to Theo.

Encourage the children to wave or say goodbye to Theo. Then put Theo away in a safe place for next week's use.

#### Talk With Kids

Lead children in this discussion.

#### Ask:

- What are some ways you praise Jesus?
- How can you praise him this week?

Say: We can worship Jesus every day, whether or not we have a CD to sing with.

▶ WE PRAISE JESUS in many different ways.



# Bible Time: Hosanna Praises

### What You'll Do

Have kids sit in a circle. Open your Bible to Matthew 21, and show the children the words. Tell children that the Bible is God's special book.

Give each child a paper palm branch. Say: In the Bible today, people praised Jesus. Let's hear how.

The people were excited; a parade was coming! This wasn't just any parade—the celebration was for Jesus! Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. As Jesus passed by, the people shouted "Hosanna!" and they waved palm branches. Lead children to jump up and wave their palm branches and then sit back down.

Say: Many of the people knew that Jesus was a very special person. They thought he was special because he did so many good things. They'd been waiting a long time for him to come. The people took off their coats and spread them on the ground for the donkey to walk on. And they shouted "Hosanna!" as they waved their palm branches. Have children jump up and wave the palms and then sit back down.

Say: Someone asked, "Who is that?" The people answered, "This is Jesus, who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna!" Have children jump up and wave the palms and then sit back down.

### Talk With Kids

Lead children in this discussion.

#### Ask:

- What do you think about the parade for Jesus?
- How could you praise Jesus if he was in a parade in our town today?

Say: The parade we heard about in the Bible today was one of the most special parades ever. The people celebrated and praised Jesus because he is God. ▶ WE PRAISE JESUS, too, to show him we know how special he is.



#### **INTO LIFE**

Choose at least two of the learning centers to help reinforce today's Bible lesson. Gather the needed materials, and put the supplies in an out-of-sight area until you're ready for them. Allow the children to choose which center they'd like to explore first. Then circulate among the children as they create and explore. Encourage them to make connections between their activities and the Bible by asking them the questions included with each center's description.

#### **CENTER 1:**

# Prepare the Way for Jesus

### What You'll Do

Give each child a My Bible Hugs page. Say: When people heard Jesus was coming, they were very excited. They laid their coats in the road for his donkey to walk on. Encourage kids to prepare the road in the picture for Jesus and the donkey to walk down by gluing cloth scraps to it. Then say: The people also waved palm branches as he passed by and they praised him! Have kids glue the palm branch pieces to the side of the road, as well. The people shouted "Hosanna!" as Jesus passed by.

#### Talk With Kids

Lead children in this discussion.

#### Ask:

- What can you say to Jesus to show him you love him?
- What can you do to show Jesus you love him?

Say: The people knew that Jesus was very special, so they celebrated and praised him by laying their coats and palm branches in the road for his donkey to walk on. They also shouted praises to him. WE PRAISE JESUS, too, by singing to him, telling him in prayer that we love him, and in many other ways.

#### CENTER 2:

# "Praise the Lord" Snacks

#### What You'll Do

Have children clean their hands and then sit down for the snack. Give each child a graham cracker on a napkin. Then set out soft cream cheese and plastic spoons, and let kids spread the cream cheese on their crackers.

Say: One way people celebrate is by throwing confetti. Let's decorate our crackers with candy "confetti." Let kids have fun decorating their crackers with candy sprinkles. Then ask a child to thank God for the snack before children enjoy their snack. As kids eat, review all the ways the people praised Jesus in the Bible.

### Talk With Kids

Lead children in this discussion.

#### Ask:

- Think of all the ways the people praised Jesus, and explain which is your favorite way.
- What are some things people in our church do to praise God?

Say: Celebrating someone or something can be a lot of fun. And people like to do it in different ways. When ▶ WE PRAISE JESUS, we can do it in different ways, and we can have fun while doing it!

#### CENTER 3:

# Hosanna Hop

# What You'll Do

Encourage children to take turns trotting or galloping down the road. Each time they go down the road, have them do something different, for example: walking backward, hopping, or skipping. While one child is taking a turn going down the road, have the rest of the kids line up beside the road with palm branches. Have kids wave their palm branches and shout "Hosanna!"

#### Talk With Kids

Lead children in this discussion.

#### Ask:

- What was this game like for you?
- Tell about something that you like to do more than anything in the world.
- When you're doing that thing, what could you do to praise Jesus?

Say: Jesus is God, and he loves us so much. WE PRAISE JESUS to show him we love him and believe in him.

#### CENTER 4:

# Modern Palms

#### What You'll Do

Give each child a piece of green tissue paper. Have kids fold the paper in half. Then have them fold the paper in half again. Help each child slide a plastic straw inside the fold, leaving about three inches of the straw showing below the paper. (The straw will not reach to the top of the folded paper.) Use a stapler to attach the paper around the straw. Staple it all the way up to the top of the fold. Use the scissors to cut the tissue into strips, like a pompom. Then say: The people praised Jesus with palm branches. Today, people wave things to show excitement, too—like cheerleaders at a game. Shake your pompom to show you're excited about Jesus. Allow time. Jesus is happy when we praise him. Let's shake our pompoms we made as we chant praise to him!

Chant the following verse:

# **Daily Challenges**

### What You'll Do

After the children have cleaned up their centers, bring everyone back to a circle area on the floor. Review the lesson activities and the Bible Point, and then encourage the children to share what they remember about what they learned from the Bible today.

Also use this time to challenge kids in their faith. Encourage them to choose a Daily Challenge for applying today's lesson to their lives this week. Use this challenge for encouraging your children's growing relationships with Jesus.

## Talk With Kids

Say: Today we learned that **WE PRAISE JESUS.** I would like each of you to choose a way that you can praise Jesus this week.

Read the three Daily Challenge ideas for children to choose from:

- Ask your mom or dad to take you on a walk. Each time you see something you like, praise Jesus and thank him for making it.
- Make up new actions to your favorite song about Jesus. Show your family the new actions, and ask them to sing with you.
- When you put on your clothes this week, remember that the people in the Bible laid their coats on the ground to praise Jesus. Sing a quick song or say a little prayer to praise Jesus.

Have kids each whisper in your ear or tell you which idea they've chosen, and then circle it on each child's My Bible Hugs page. Make sure you tell kids the challenge you choose. Your commitment will inspire children and will give them an opportunity to see God at work in your life as well as in theirs!



# **Action Prayer**

#### What You'll Do

Line kids up at the start of the "road" from the "Hosanna Hop" activity.

Have kids join you in singing the prayer "Praise, Praise, Praise You, Lord" (track 6 on the CD) to the tune of "Row, Row, Row Your Boat." Encourage children to walk down the road as they sing a prayer of praise to their Lord Jesus.

Praise, praise, praise you, Lord. How wonderful you are! And we want to give you praise. We pray in Jesus' name. (Repeat.)

#### Talk With Kids

Say: ► WE PRAISE JESUS because he's our God. Let's praise him this week as often as we can!
