Debbie Robley

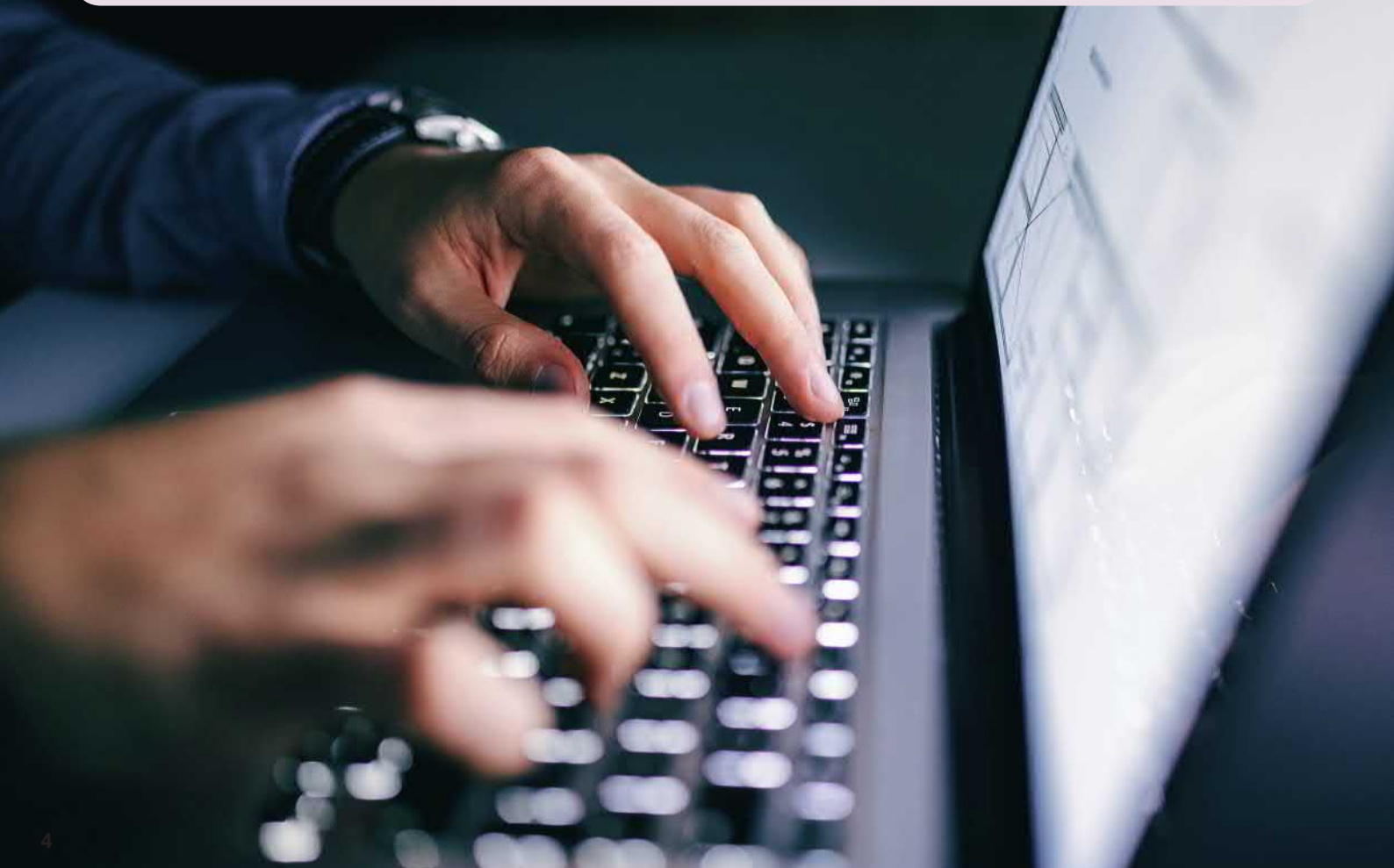
