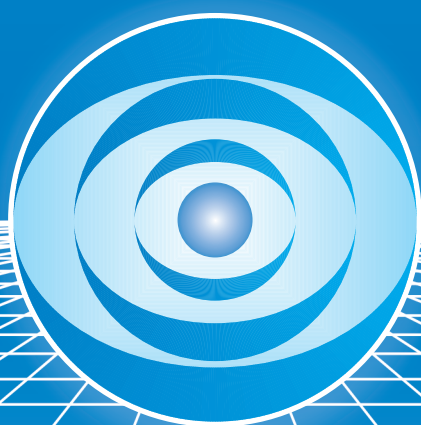

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RUSSIAN FEDERATION: STATISTICAL REVIEW FOR THE 1ST HALF OF 2019

The Federal State Statistics Service presents the 2018 statistical review of the socio-economic situation of the Russian Federation for the 1st half of 2019.

Population. According to preliminary estimates, the resident population of the Russian Federation as of July 1, 2019 was 146.7 million persons. In the 1st half of 2019, the number of residents of Russia decreased by 64.8 thousand persons, or 0.04% (in the corresponding period of 2018, the population decreased by 88.7 thousand persons, or 0.1%).

For the 1st half of 2019 the number of deaths exceeded the number of births by 27.6% and the natural decrease rate was 2.7‰.

Migration growth of 67.4% compensated the numerical loss of the population.

Employment and unemployment. The labor force at the age of 15 years and over in the Q II, 2019 was 75.1 million persons, or 51% of the total population of the country, including 71.6 million persons, or 95.4% of the total labor force were employed in the economy and 3.4 million persons (4.6%) were not employed, but were actively looking for a job (according to the methodology of the International Labor Organization, they are classified as unemployed). 746 thousand persons were registered as unemployed at the end of December in the employment services.

Living standards. The level of welfare of the population is determined primarily by the money income of the population. *Money income* per capita for the 1st half of 2019* reached 32246 roubles per month and increased compared with the corresponding period of 2018 by 4.7%, while money expenditures of the population per capita, respectively, 26901 roubles increased by 6.1%.

The real disposable money income of the population (income less mandatory payments, adjusted for the consumer price index) for the 1st half of 2019* decreased compared with the corresponding period of 2018 by 1.3%.

In the structure of money income of the population for the 1st half of 2019* compared with the corresponding period of 2018, the share of labor remuneration and social benefits increased, while entrepreneurial activity income, property income and other money receipts decreased.

In the structure of use of money income of population*, purchase of goods and payment for services accounted for 83.4%, expenditure on compulsory payments and contributions, other expenses – 14.6, savings - 2.0%.

For the 1st half of 2019**, 29.2% of the total volume of money income belonged to 10% of population *with the highest income*, and to the lowest income group of population only 2.1% (for the corresponding period of 2018*** – 29.6% and 2.1% respectively).

The gross average nominal monthly wages for the 1st half of 2019 was 46210 roubles and increased compared to the 1st half of 2018 by 7.1%, real wages increased by 1.9%.

For the 1st half of 2019 the average pension was 14128 roubles per month and increased compared to the 1st half of 2018 by 5.9%, the real pension for the 1st half of 2019 increased by 0.8% compared with the corresponding period of 2018.

For the 1st half of 2019 the **Gross Domestic Product** in current prices was 50675.1 billion roubles and its volume index relative to the 1st half of 2018 composed 100.7%.

Investments. Organizations of all types of ownership for the development of the economy and social sphere for the 1st half of 2019 used 6695.9 billion roubles of investment in fixed capital, 100.6% compared to the 1st half of 2018.

The share of investments (excluding small businesses) from own funds is 60.2%, raised funds – 39.8%, including 5.1% – funds of the federal budget, funds of population and legal entities raised by organizations - developers for joint construction – 3.8%.

The total volume of financial investments of organizations (excluding small businesses, banks, insurance organizations and state (municipal) institutions) for the 1st half of 2019 reached 123.4 trillion roubles, including long-term financial investments – 11.0 trillion roubles (8.9% of the total volume), short-term financial investments – 112.4 trillion roubles (91.1%).

For the 1st half of 2019 the **industrial production index** * compared to the corresponding period of 2018 was 102.6%.

For the 1st half of 2019 the **mining and quarrying production index** compared to the corresponding period of 2018 was 104.0%, including coal production – 101.5, crude oil and natural gas production – 103.8, mining of metal ores – 108.1, mining of other minerals – 99.0%.

For the 1st half of 2019 the **manufacturing production index** compared to the corresponding period in 2018 was 101.9%.

Production growth was observed for the following kinds of economic activity: Manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products and pharmaceutical preparations – 116.7%; Repair and installation of machinery and equipment – 110.1; Manufacture of wood and of products of wood and cork, except furniture; manufacture of articles of straw and plaiting materials – 108.3; Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – 107.1; Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment – 106.0; Manufacture of paper and paper products – 105.1; Manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – 104.6; Manufacture of food products – 103.8; Manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – 102.8; Manufacture of basic metals – 102.6; Manufacture of furniture – 102.0; Manufacture of beverages – 101.7; Manufacture of rubber and plastic products – 101.3; Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers – 100.8; Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – 100.2%.

Decrease in production was observed for the following kinds of economic activity: Manufacture of electrical equipment – 98.1%; Other manufacturing – 98.0; Manufacture of leather and related products – 97.6; Printing and reproduction of recorded media – 97.1; Manufacture of textiles – 96.7; Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c. – 96.3; Manufacture of wearing apparel – 95.5; Manufacture of tobacco products – 85.6; Manufacture of other transport equipment – 79.4%.

For the 1st half of 2019 **production index by economic activity “Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply”** compared with the corresponding period of 2018 was 100.0%.

For the 1st half of 2019 **production index by economic activity “Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities”** compared to the corresponding period of 2018 was 101.5%.

Agriculture. According to preliminary data, the volume of agricultural production of all agricultural producers (agricultural organizations, peasant (farm) households and individual entrepreneurs, households of citizens) for the 1st half of 2019 at current prices reached 1645.9 billion roubles, or 101.2% if to compare with the level of the corresponding period of 2018.

By the beginning of August 2019 agricultural enterprises harvested grains and grain-legumes in an area of 10.1 million hectares (that is 20.1% more than by the beginning of August of previous year) which is 35.7% of sowing of grain and grain-legumes. 36.1 million tonnes of grain in primary weight was threshed (which is 17.1 % more in comparison to this period of time of the last year). Average grain harvest per a hectare for Russia is lower than the level of last year and is 35.9 centners per hectare (36.8 centners per hectare was last year).

According to estimations, in the 1st half of 2019 enterprises of all types produced 6.8 million tonnes of cattle and poultry for slaughter (live weight) (101.0% to the level of the 1st half of 2018), 15.3 million tonnes of milk (101.4 %), 22.3 billion pieces (99.1%) of eggs.

Construction. The volume of works in construction activity in the 1st half of 2019 was 3542.8 billion roubles (100.1% compared of the 1st half of 2018).

For the 1st half of 2019 organizations of all types of ownership built 398.4 thousand new apartments of total area 30.1 million square meters.

Trade. For the 1st half of 2019 retail trade turnover reached 15687.6 billion roubles, which is 1.7% more than in the 1st half of 2018 in the commodity weights.

For the 1st half of 2019 in the structure of retail trade turnover, the share of non-food products was 51.5% (in the 1st half of 2018 – 51.7%).

Market services. For the 1st half of 2019, the volume of market services was 4912.5 billion roubles. Compared to the 1st half of 2018, the volume index reached 99.1%.

In the structure of market services in the 1st half of 2019, the biggest part had public utilities, which accounted for 22.9% of the total volume of market services.

Transport. The freight turnover of transport in the 1st half of 2019 was 2824.5 billion tonne-km (101.8% compared to the 1st half of 2018), including railway – 1307.6 (102.0%), road – 127.5 (107.6%), inland water – 26.1 (96.9%), maritime – 17.4 (93.7%), air – 3.5 (93.4%), pipeline – 1342.5 billion tonne-km (101.3%).

Passenger turnover of public transport in the 1st half of 2019 was 259.7 billion passenger-km (108.1% compared to the 1st half of 2018), of which railway 58.2 (103.8%), road – 55.5 (98.8%), air – 145.7 billion passenger-km (114.2%).

Information and communication technologies. In 2018, the share of organizations using the Internet increased by 2.2% compared to the previous year and reached 91.1%. At the same time, 73.1% of organizations used the Internet for commercial purposes. In 2018 organizations used the Internet for solving business problems more actively to communicate with suppliers (69.8%), rather than with consumers (51.7%).

86.5% of organizations used broadband Internet access in 2018.

The share of organizations that used specialized software in 2018 was 85.9%.

Finance. For the 1st half of 2019 the consolidated budget, including the budgets of state extra-budget funds, according to data of the Federal Treasury, was executed with a surplus of 2637.4 billion roubles. Expenditures amounted to 15946.2 billion roubles, revenues – 18583.5 billion roubles.

In the structure of revenues, the largest share was: corporate income tax – 2375.7 billion roubles, or 12.8%, individual income tax – 1776.2 billion roubles, or 9.6%, insurance contributions to compulsory social insurance – 3724.4 billion roubles, or 20.0%; value-added tax for goods (work, services) sold on the territory of the Russian Federation – 2059.7 billion roubles, or 11.1%, taxes, fees and regular payments for natural resources usage – 3232.1 billion roubles, or 17.4%, revenues from foreign economic activity – 1493.9 billion roubles, or 8.0%.

For the 1st half of 2019 in the structure of expenditures of the consolidated budget, 10088.6 billion roubles, or 63.3% of the total amount of expenditures, were allocated on social-cultural arrangements, respectively 927.5 billion roubles and 5.8% - on national matters, 1354.7 billion roubles and 8.5% - on national defense, 921.8 billion roubles and 5.8% - on national security and law enforcement, 1554.1 billion roubles and 9.7% - on national economy.

According to data of the Federal Treasury the federal budget for the 1st half of 2019 was executed with surplus of 1695.7 billion roubles. Revenues reached 9549.9 billion roubles, expenditures – 7854.1 billion roubles.

The money supply (M2), according to the data of the Bank of Russia, as of July 1, 2019, was 47348.2 billion roubles and increased compared to the beginning of 2019 by 0.5%.

Prices and tariffs. The consumer price index in the 1st half of 2019 (June to December 2018) was 102.5%, including 103.0% for food products, 101.7% for non-food products, and 102.7% for services.

The cost of a fixed set of consumer goods and services for interregional comparing the purchasing power of the population on average in Russia at the end of June 2019 was 16064.4 roubles per month. Compared to the end of May, its value has not changed (since the beginning of the year it increased by 3.2%).

Producer price indices in certain sectors of the economy in the 1st half of 2019 (June to December 2018) reached: industrial goods – 100.6%, agricultural products – 97.2%, investment goods – 103.1%, freight producer price index was 102.8%.

The producer price index for mining and quarrying in the 1st half of 2019 compared with December 2018 was 103.1%, including coal mining – 93.4, crude oil and natural gas production – 103.6, mining of metal ores – 110.0, other mining and quarrying – 105.3%.

The producer price index for manufacturing in the 1st half of 2019 compared to December 2018 was 99.6%, including manufacture of food products – 98.9, manufacture of beverages – 103.4, manufacture of tobacco products – 99.9, manufactures of textiles – 100.8, manufacture of wearing apparel – 101.0, manufacture of leather and related products – 99.3, manufacture of wood and of products of wood and cork, except furniture; manufacture of articles of straw and plaiting materials – 99.8, manufacture of paper and paper products – 99.9, printing and reproduction of recorded media – 99.9, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – 94.8, of which manufacture of coke oven products – 98.7, manufacture of refined petroleum products – 94.7, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – 98.2, manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products and pharmaceutical preparations – 101.4, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – 101.3, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – 104.0, manufacture of basic metals – 100.4, manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment - 100.8, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products - 101.9, manufacture of electrical equipment – 102.0, manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c. – 101.9, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – 103.4, manufacture of other transport equipment – 100.9, manufacture of furniture – 103.7, other manufacturing – 103.3, repair and installation of machinery and equipment – 102.2%.

Producer price index by economic activity “Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply” in the 1st half of 2019 compared to December 2018 was 100.8%, including electric power generation, transmission and distribution – 101.1, manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains – 99.8, steam and air conditioning supply – 100.1%.

Producer price index by economic activity “Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities” in the 1st half of 2019 compared to December 2018 was 101.6%.

Foreign trade*. Foreign trade turnover in the 1st half of 2019 reached 318 billion US dollars, including the export of goods – 205 billion US dollars, imports – 113 billion US dollars. The trade balance was positive – 93 billion US dollars.

Compared to the 1st half of 2018, the foreign trade turnover decreased by 3.3%, exports decreased by 3.6%, imports decreased by 2.8%.

The share of non-CIS countries accounts for 87.9% of the total foreign trade turnover.

Fuel and energy products dominated in the export structure (64.8%). The leaders in imports were machinery, equipment and vehicles (45.9%)

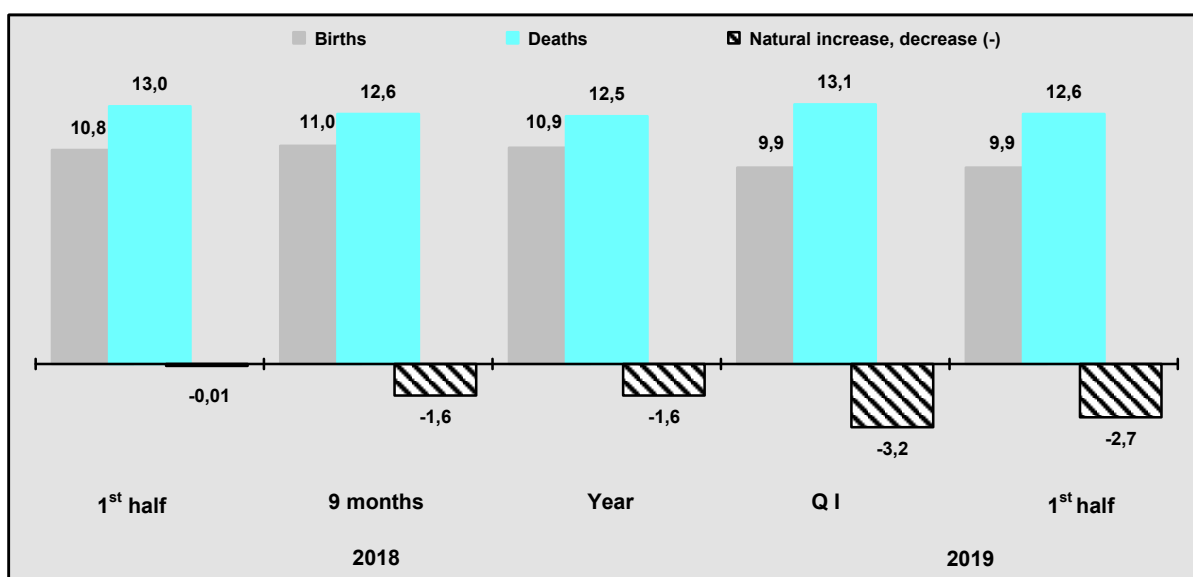

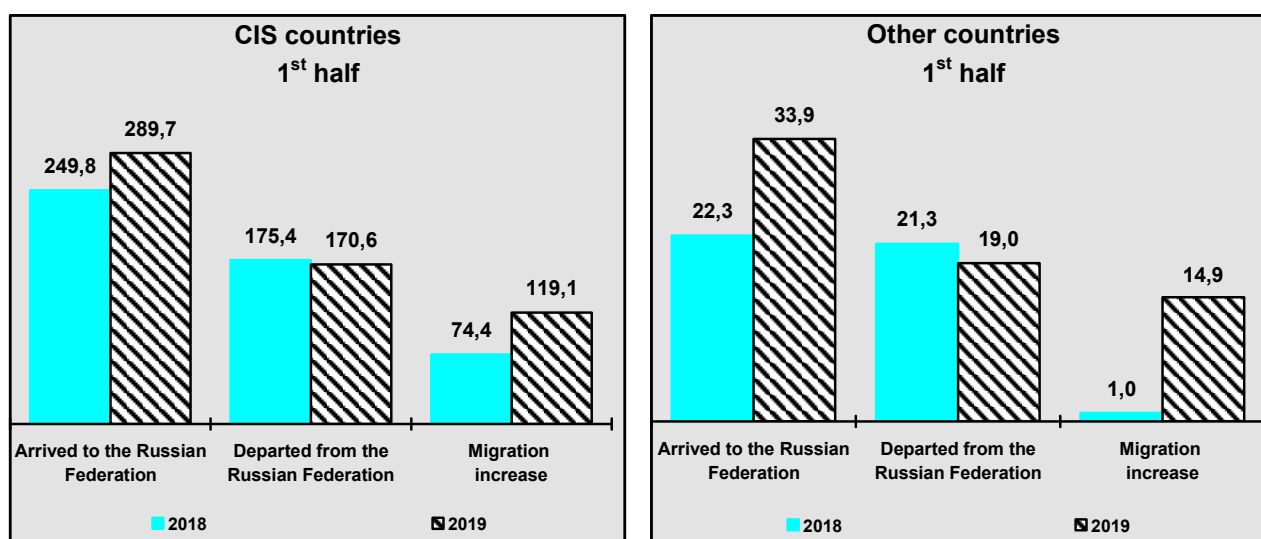

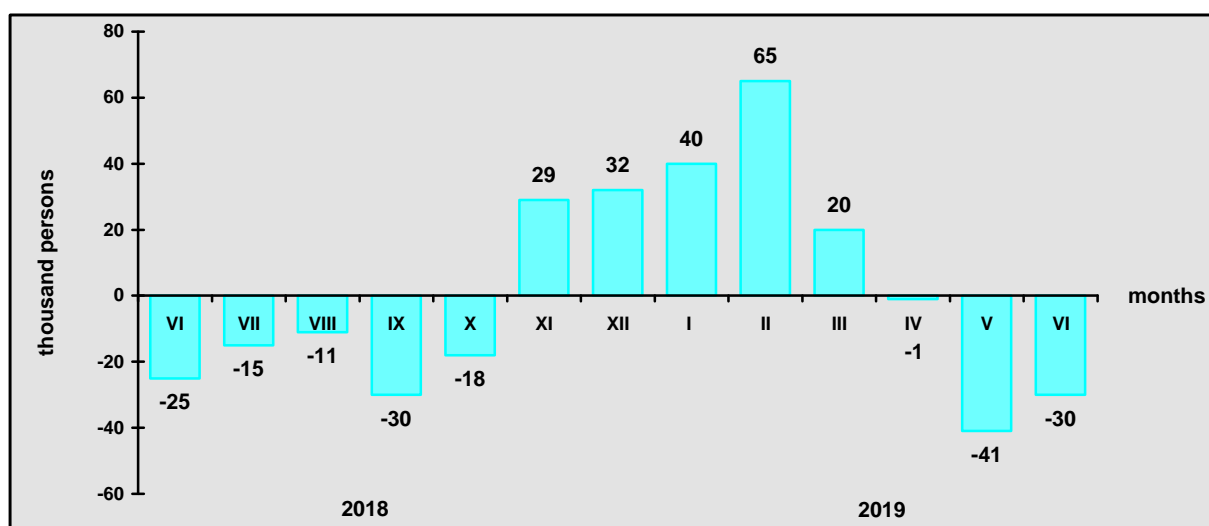

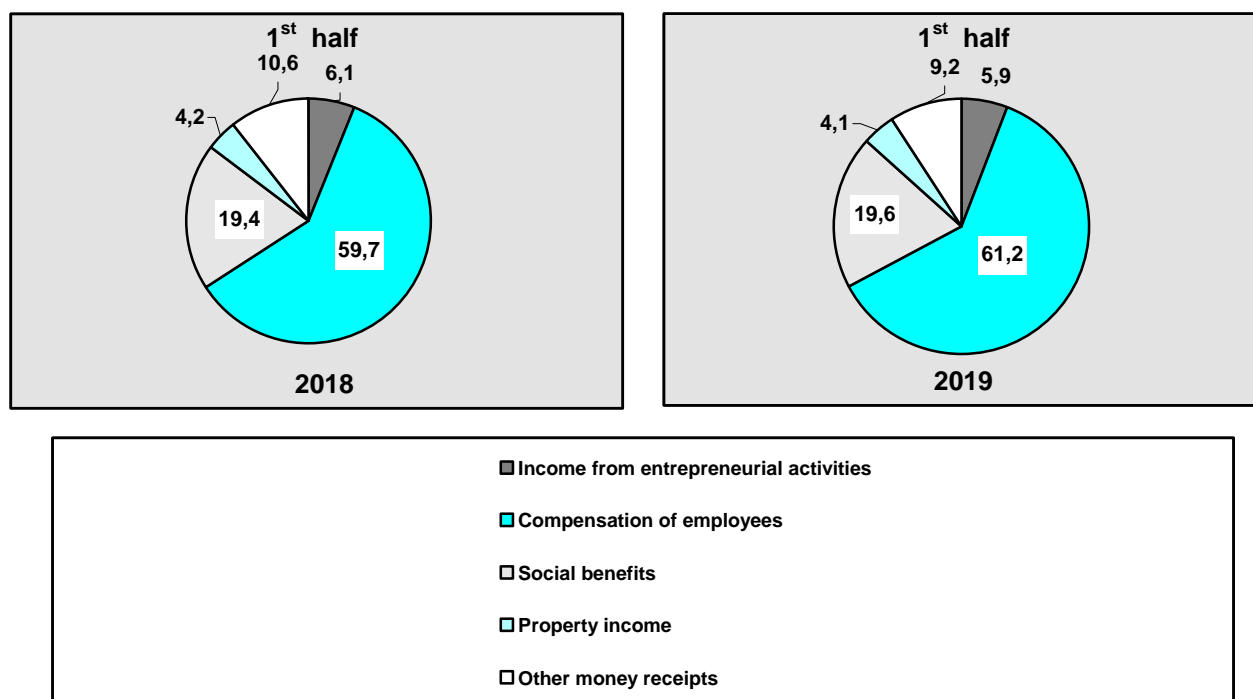

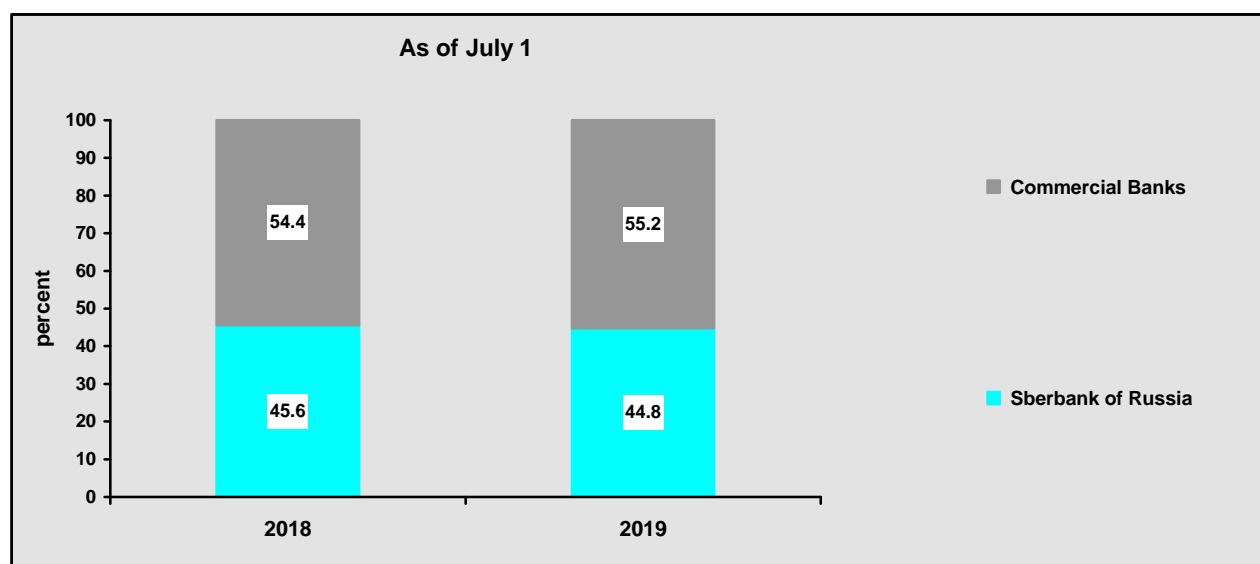

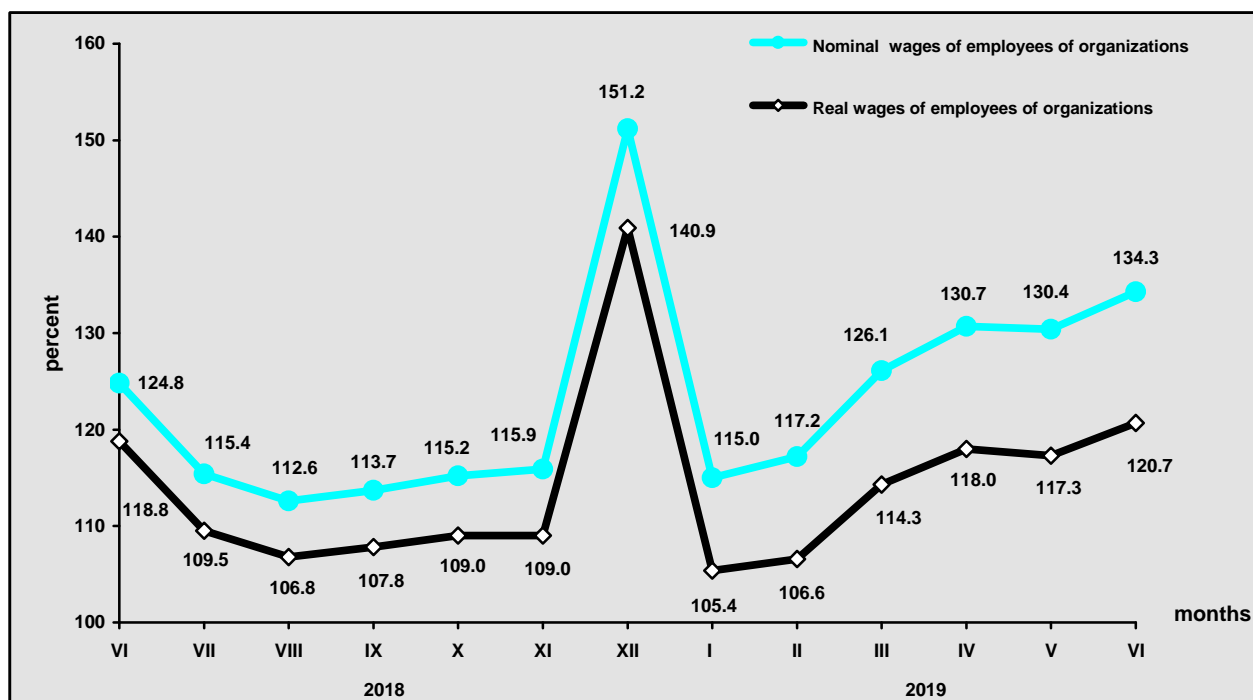

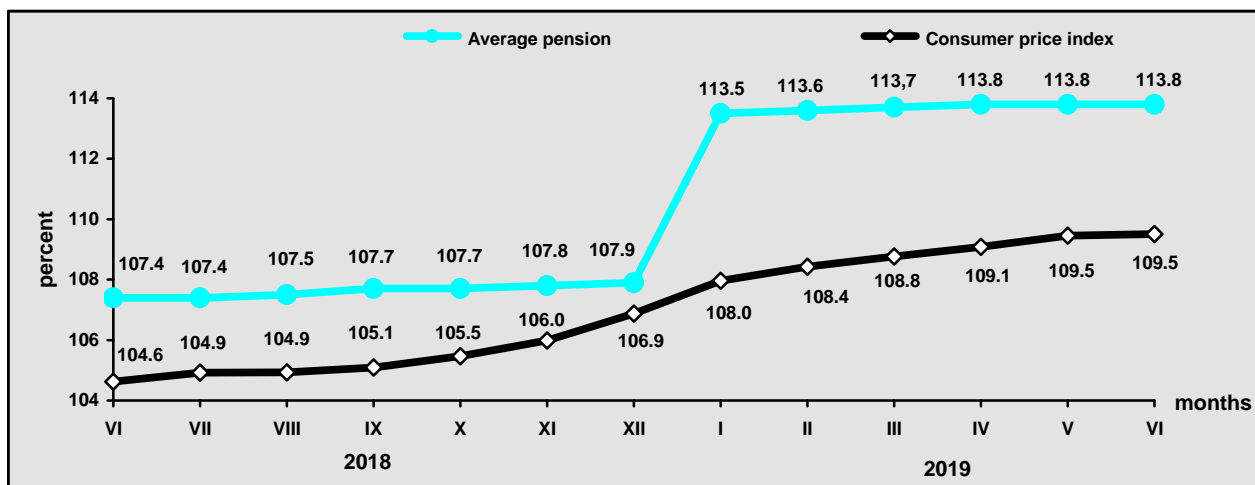

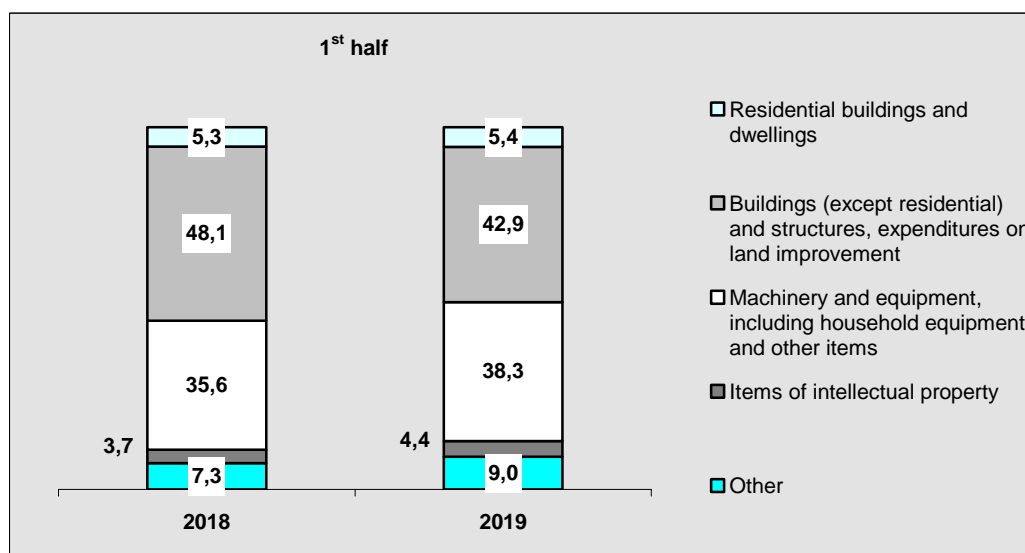

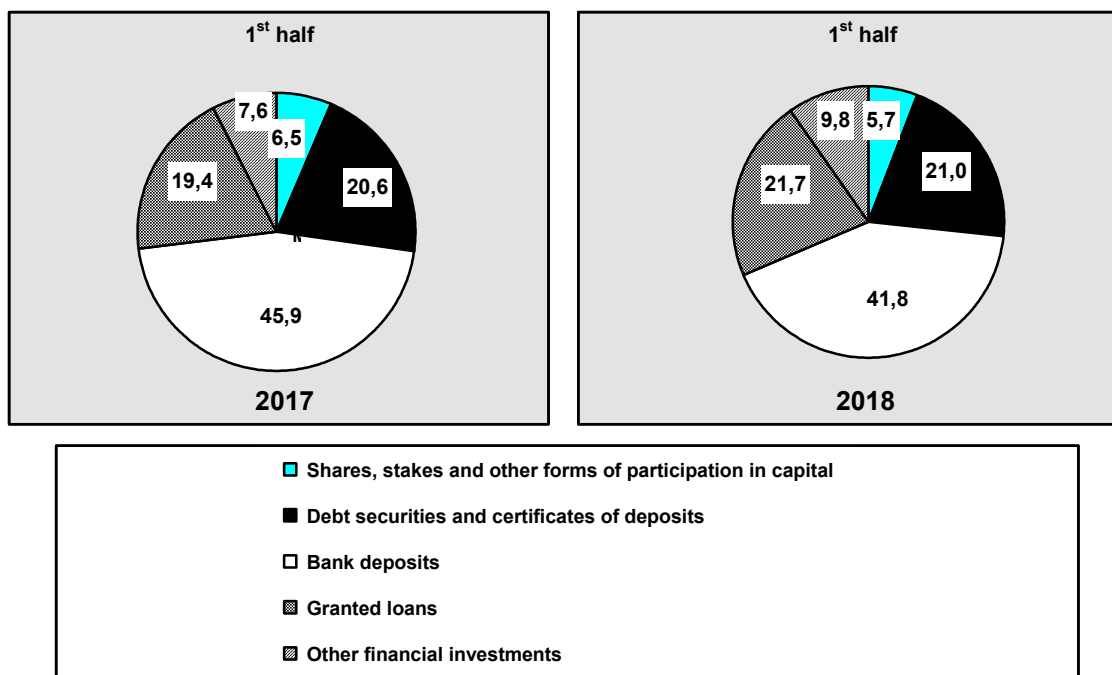

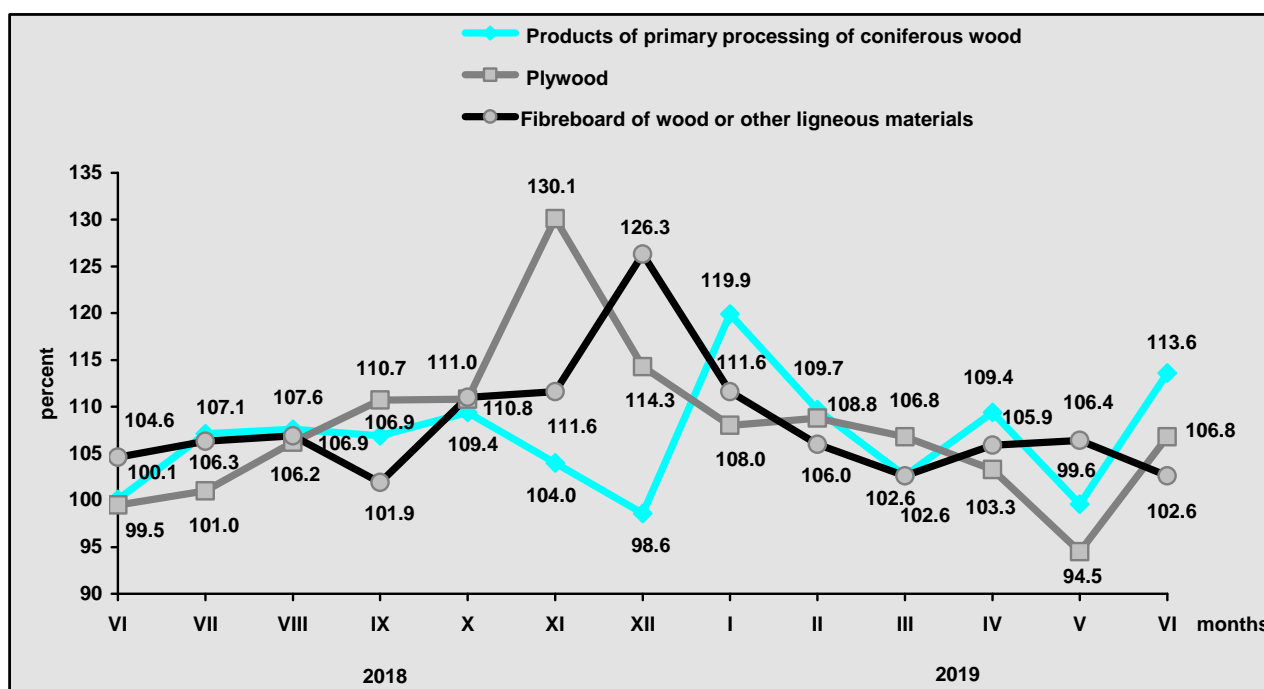

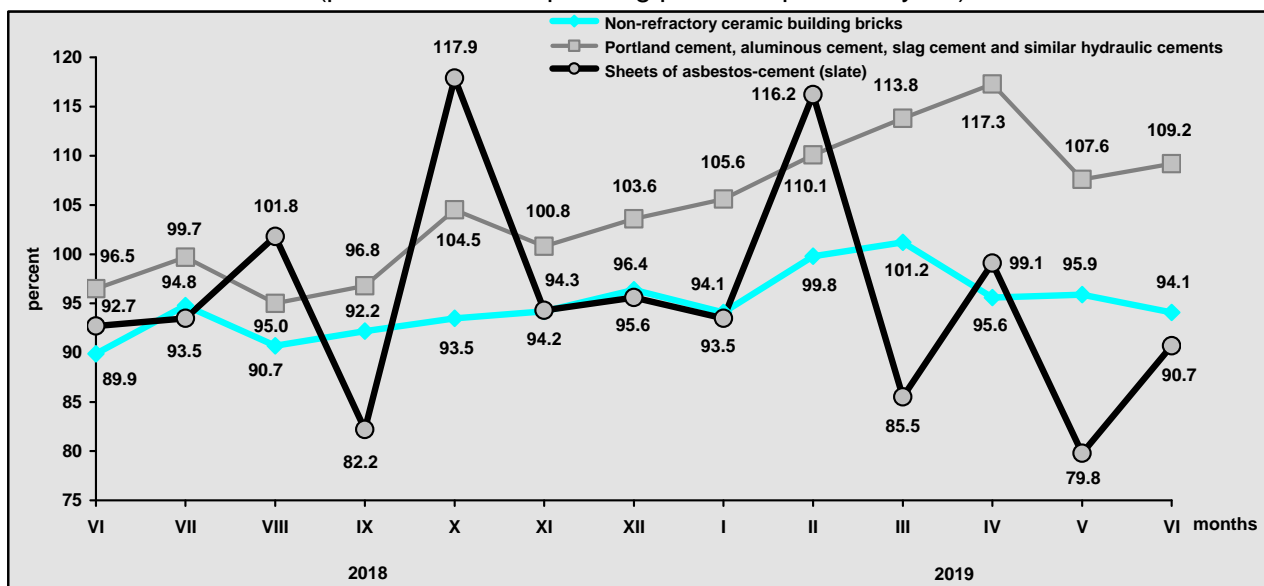

Manufacture of Certain Other Non-metallic Mineral Products (percent of corresponding period of previous year)



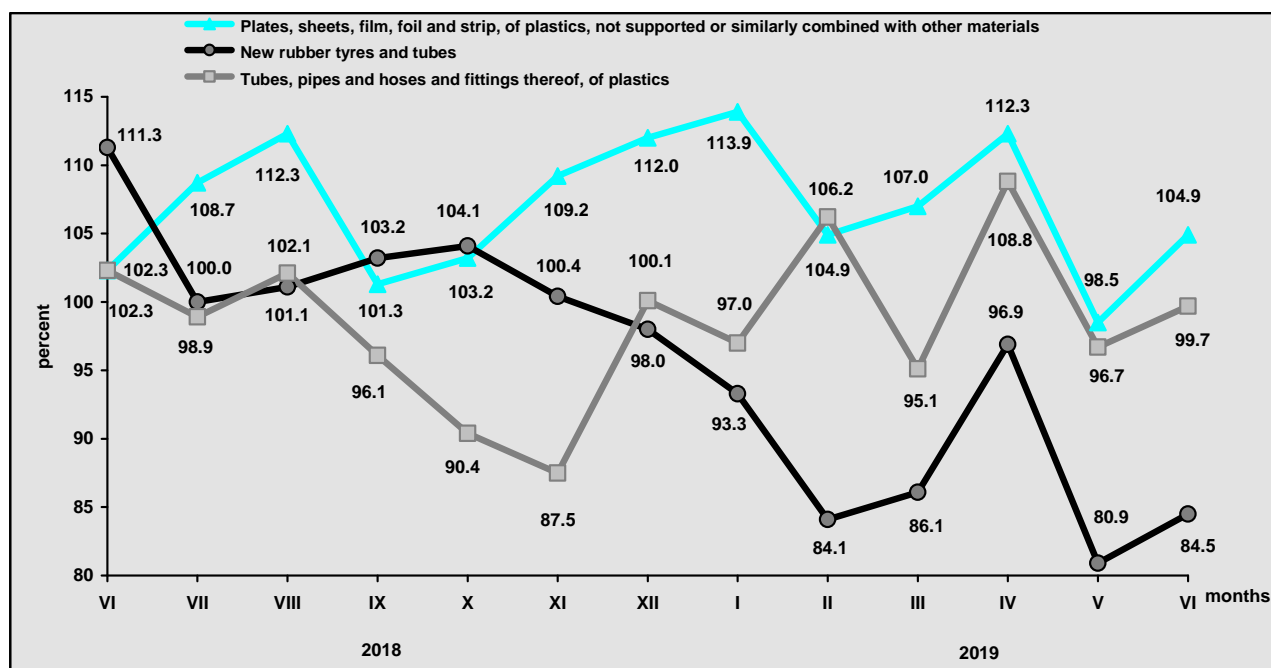

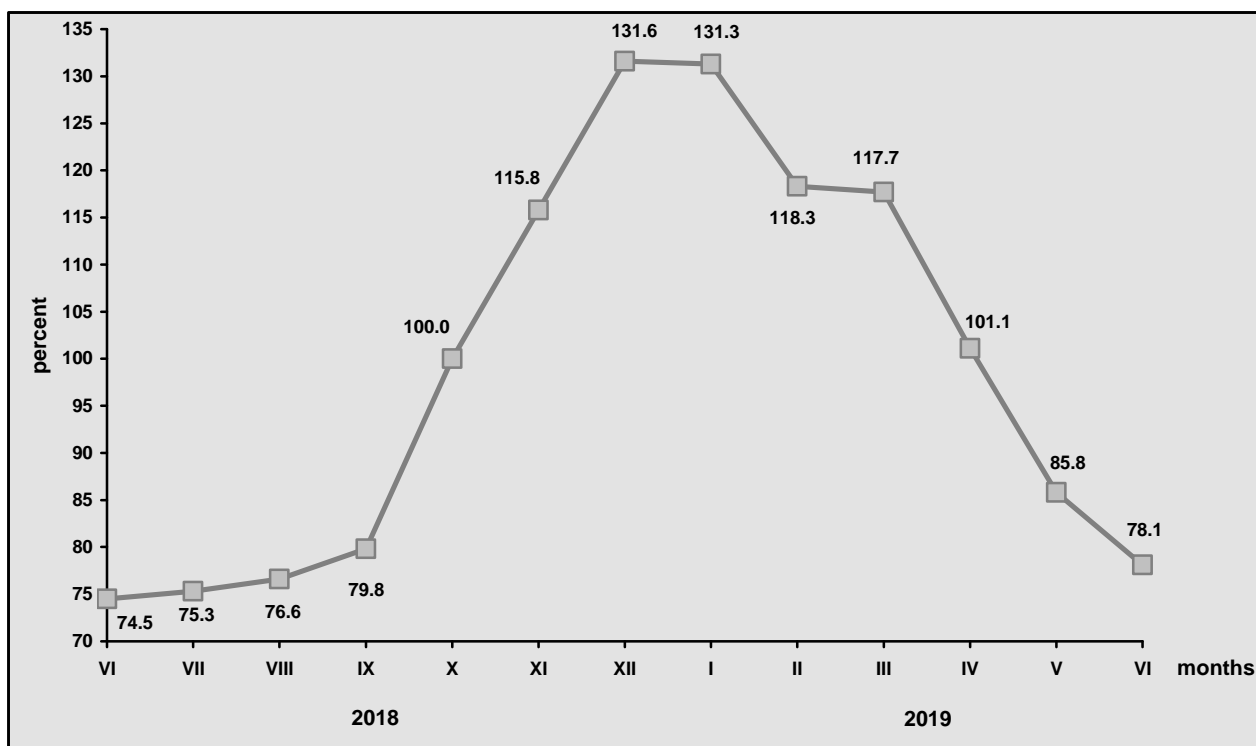

Production Index by Economic Activity «Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply» (percent of monthly average 2016)

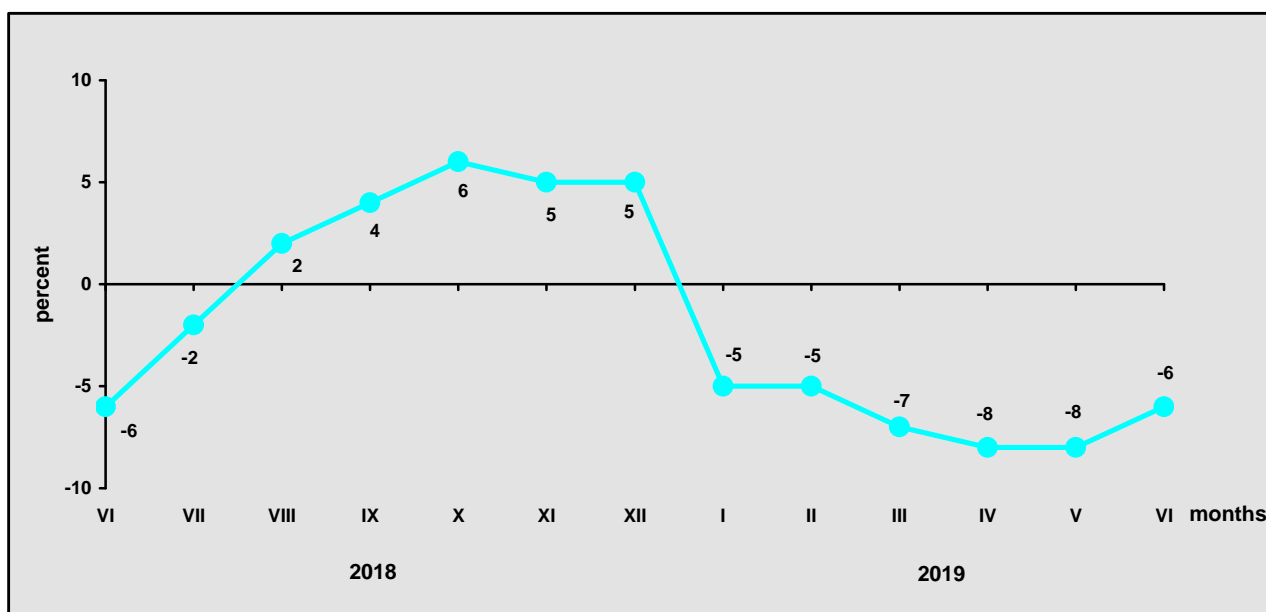

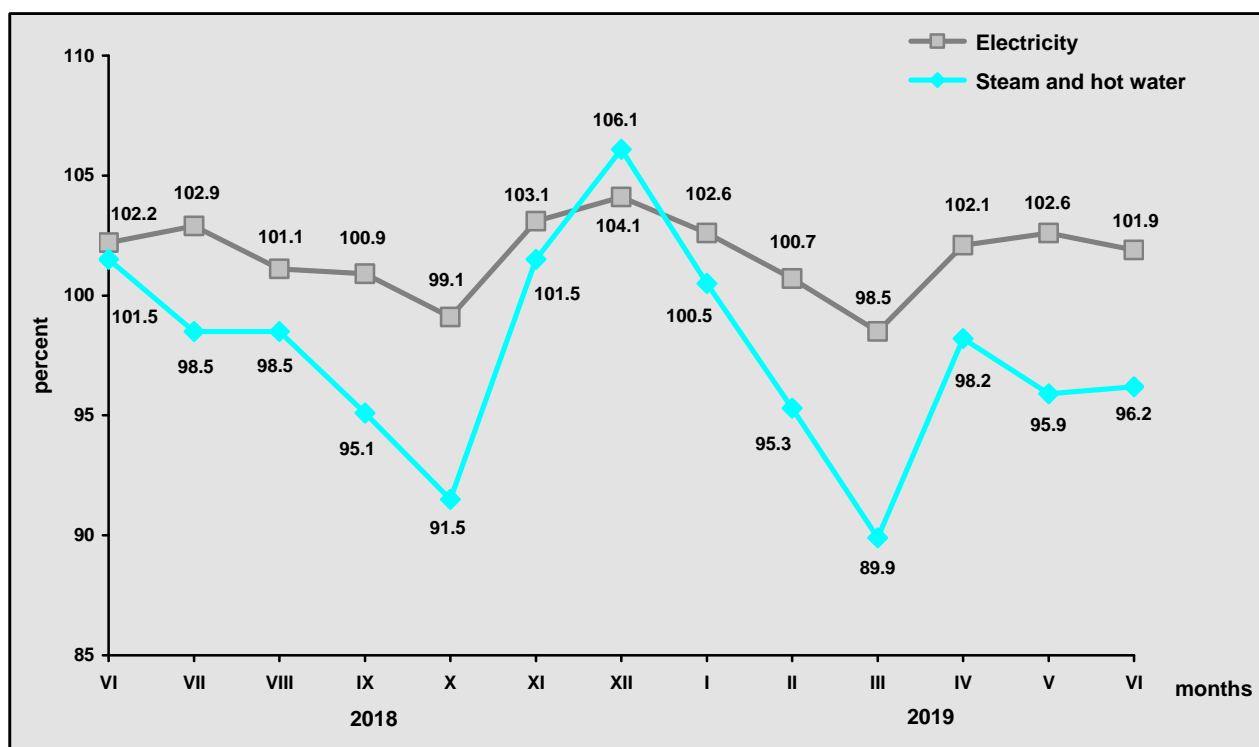

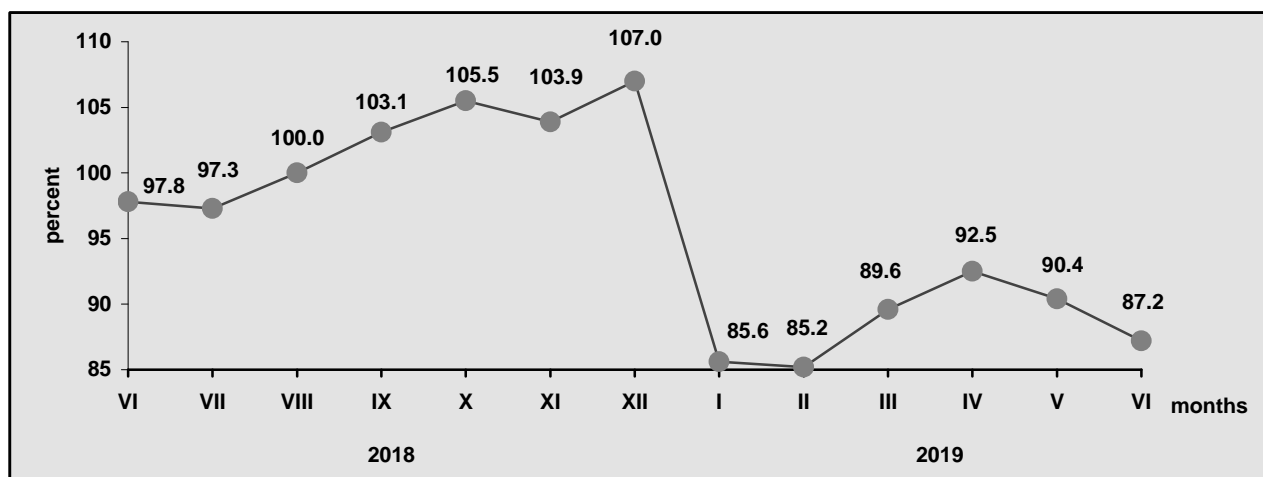
Production of Electricity, Steam and Hot Water (percent of corresponding period of previous year)

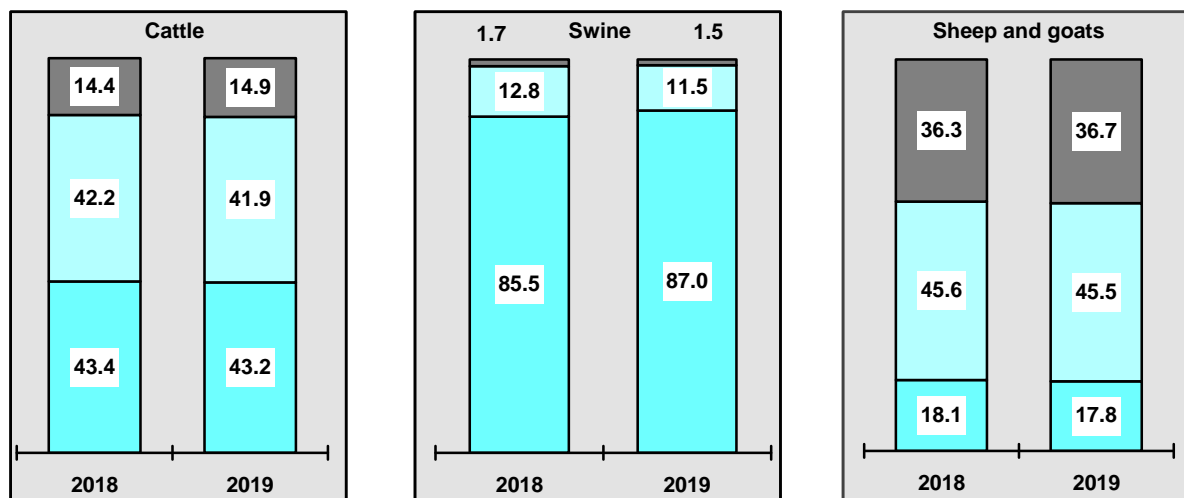

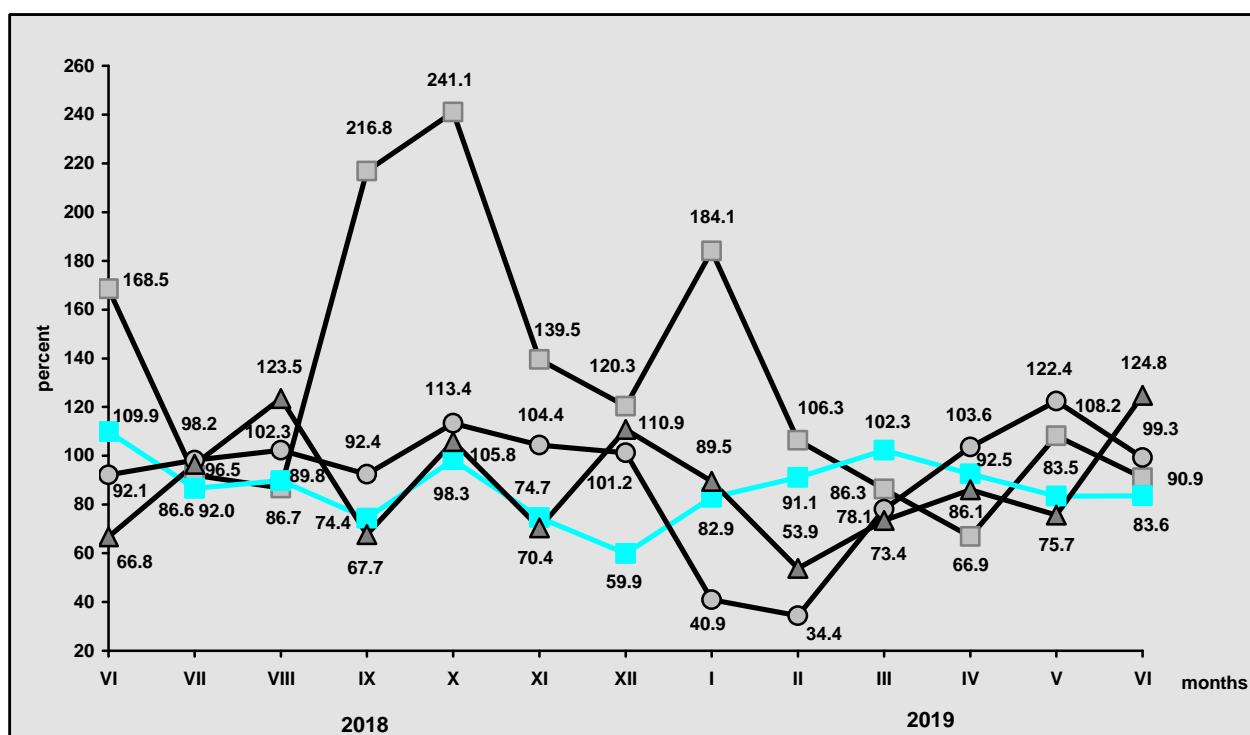

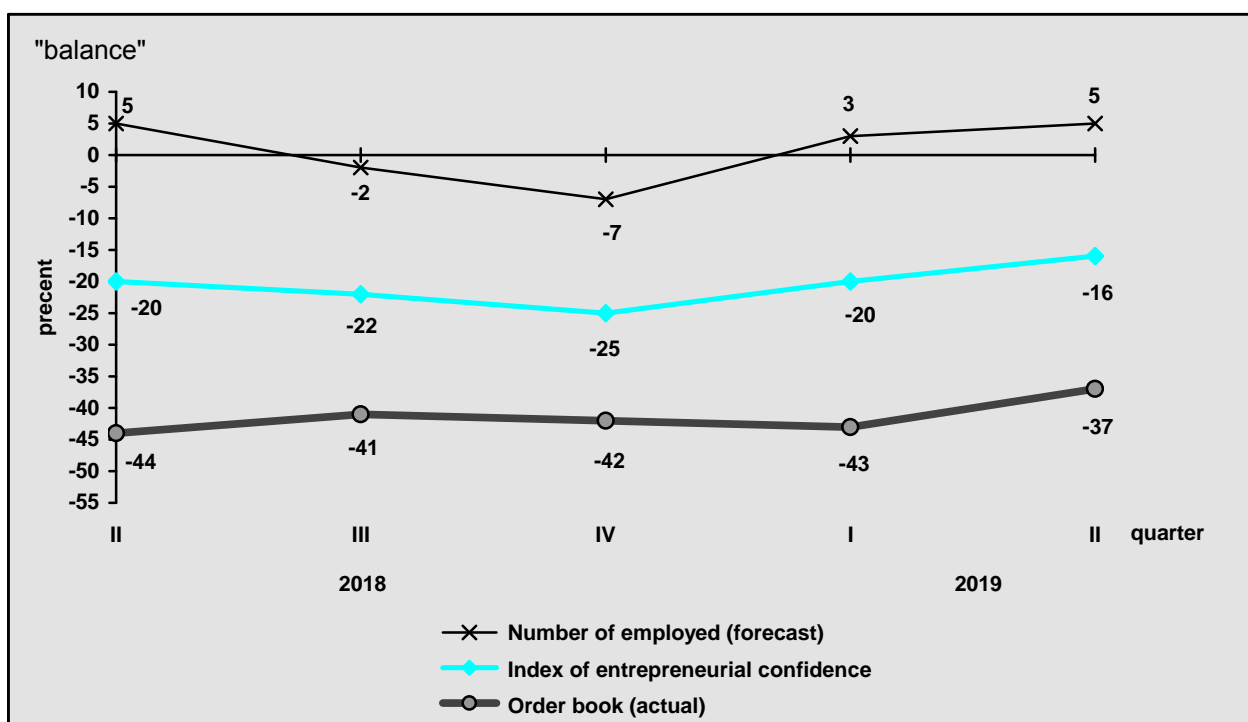
Catch (Production) of Fish and Other Fishery Products (percent of corresponding period of previous year)

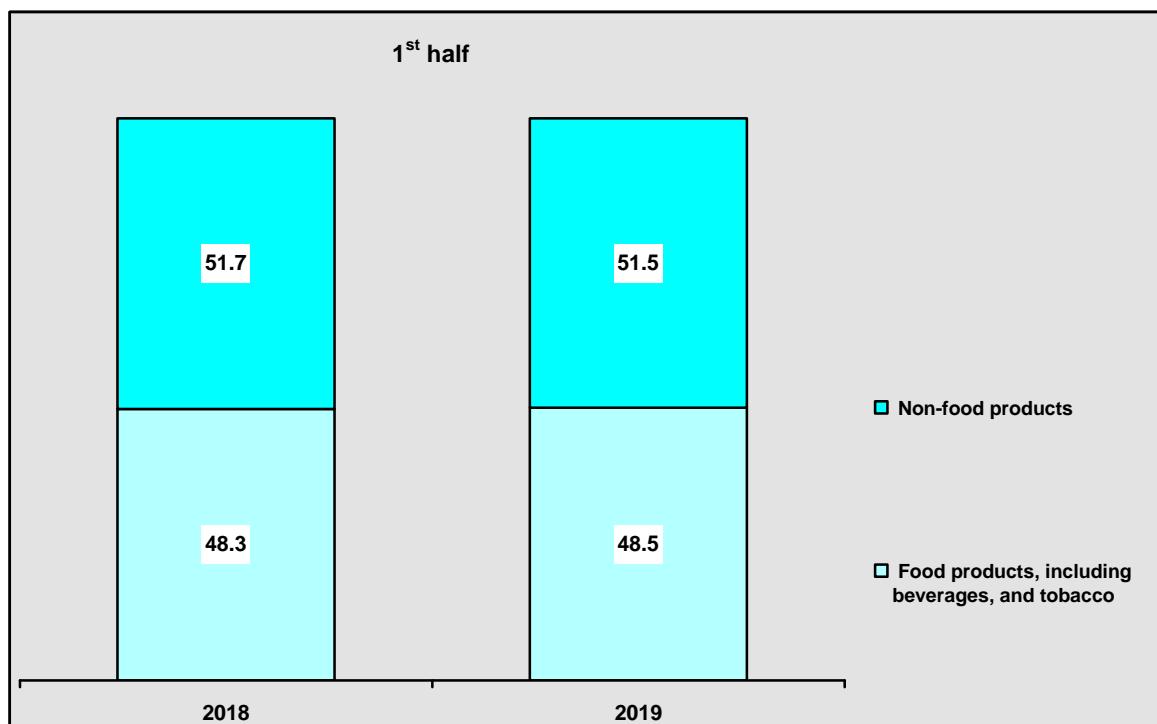


Business Confidence Index of Retail Trade Organizations



Structure of Retail Trade Turnover

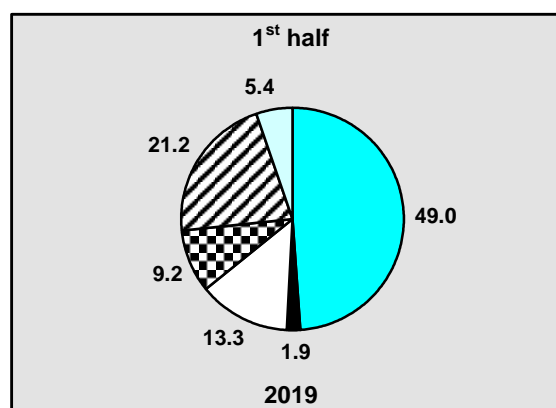
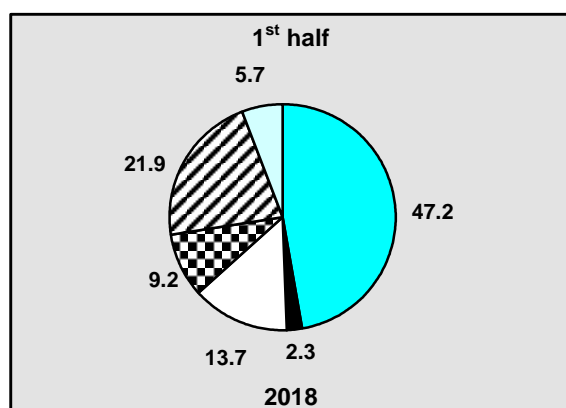

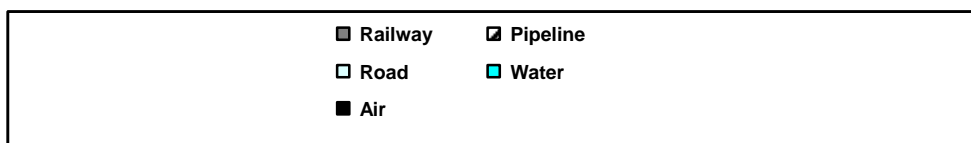

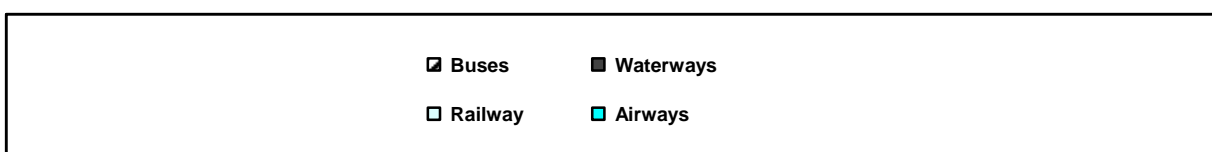
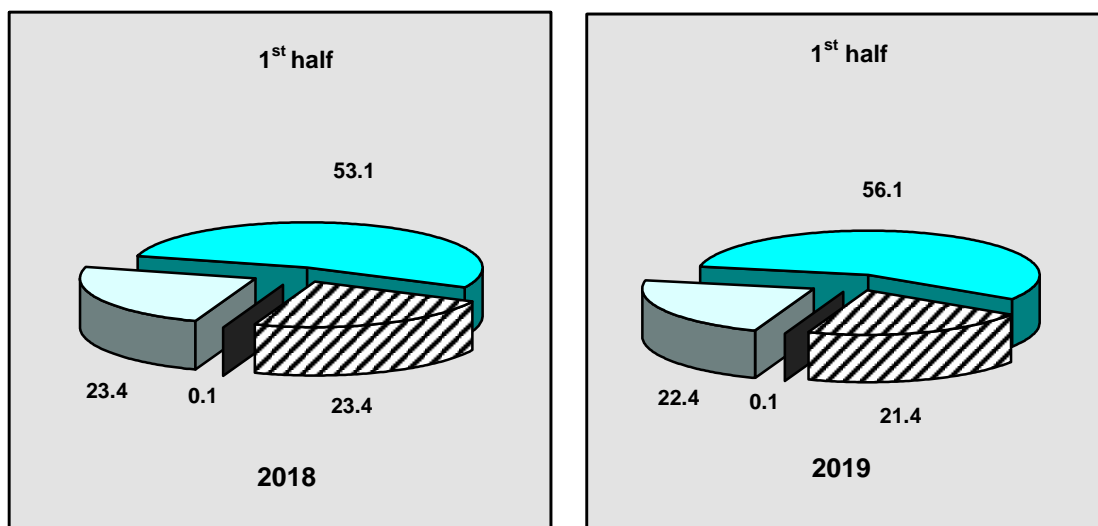

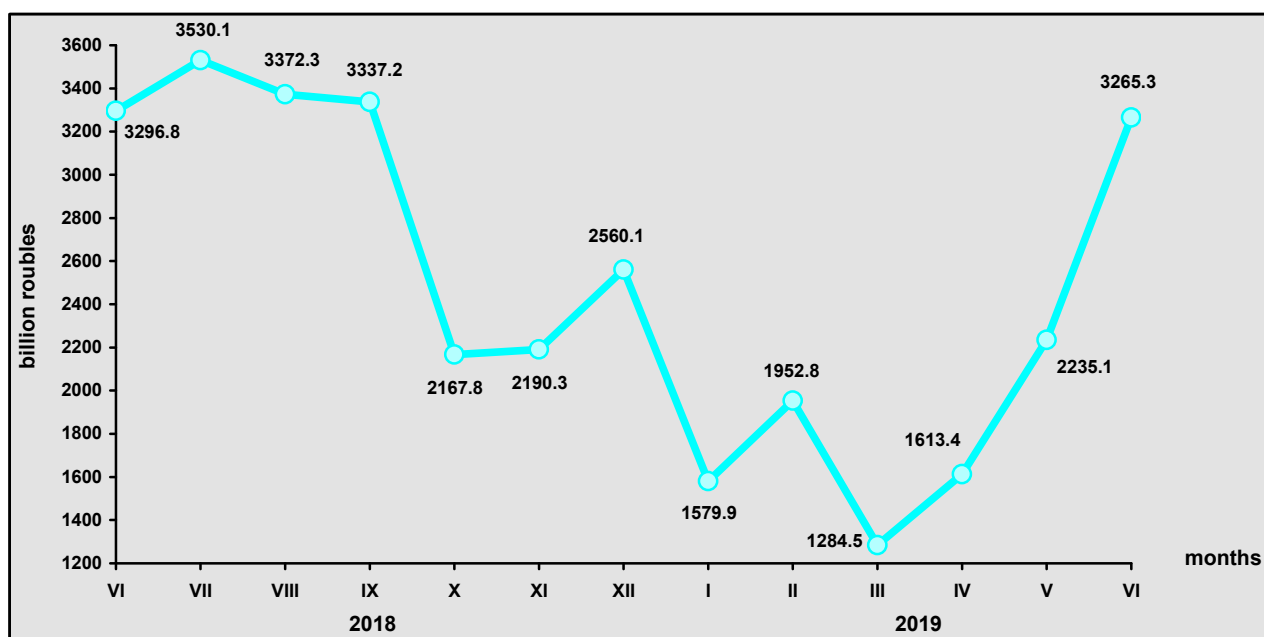

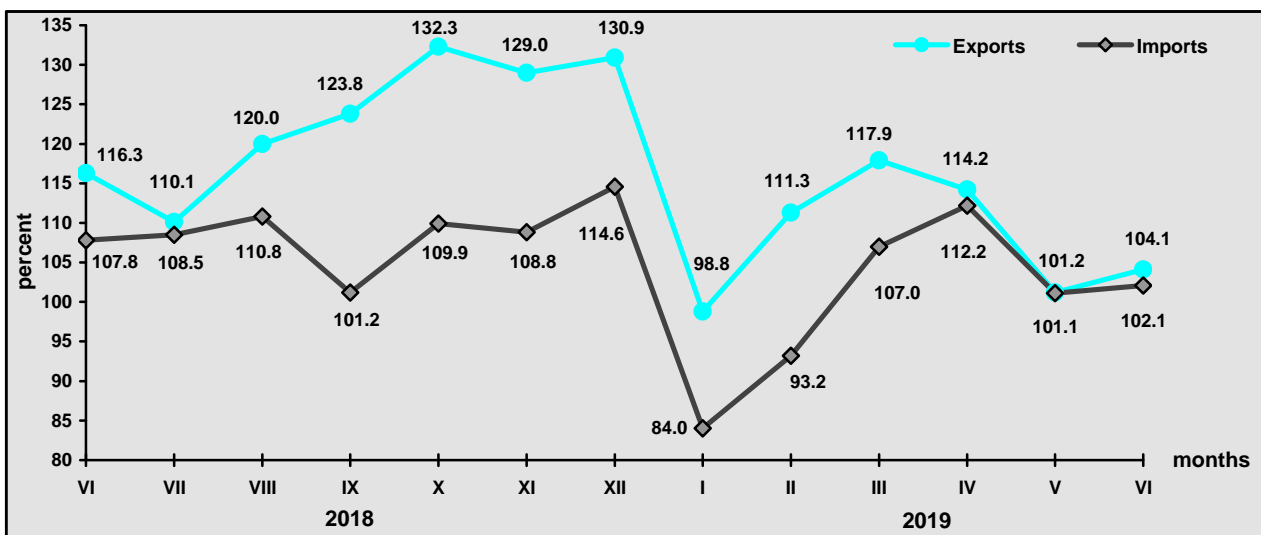

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

POPULATION

Vital statistics is the generalized name of the universe of births and death which change the size of population by so called natural manner. Marriages and divorces are also referred to vital statistics though they do not change population size but are being accounted in the same order as births and deaths.

Natural increase rate is the absolute value of the difference between numbers of birth and death for the definite period. Its value can be positive and negative.

Migration increase of population is absolute value and presents the difference between the numbers of arrivals to the given territory and departures from this territory for the definite period of time. Its value can be positive and also negative.

LABOUR

Labour force comprises all persons aged 15 years and over, who during the reference period were either employed or unemployed. The size of labour force includes data on employed and unemployed population based on the results of sample labour force survey.

Persons in **employment (employed)** are all persons aged 15 years and over, who during the reference week performed any activity (at least one hour per week) to produce goods or services for pay or profit. The employed comprise persons, who were temporarily absent from their job (place of employment) and who maintained connection to their workplace during the time of their absence.

According to the standards of the International Labour Organization (ILO), **unemployed** persons comprise all persons aged 15 years and over who during the reference period met the following criteria:

had no job (profitable occupation);

had actively sought employment at some time during the previous four weeks, using any means possible;

were ready to start working during the reference week.

Pupils, students, pensioners and invalids are referred to the category of unemployed, if they didn't have a job, have been seeking for a job and were ready to start working.

Information on foreign citizens performing labour activities on the basis of issued work permits or patents is given according to the data of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation.

Number of foreign citizens who received work permits include the number of foreign citizens, who entered Russian Federation in accordance with the procedure requiring the receipt of visa, within the framework of the quota; skilled professionals, foreign citizens, studying in Russian Federation in a day-time professional educational institution or educational institution of higher education in basic professional educational programs, having state accreditation; foreign citizens arriving to work in organizations registered in WTO member-countries and those who obtained work permits.

Number of foreign citizens who received licenses includes the number of foreign citizens, arriving in the Russian Federation on a visa-free basis and who received licenses giving them right to temporarily perform labour activities on the territory of a constituent entity of the Russian Federation for private persons and legal entities, individual entrepreneurs or other individuals whose work require a registration. The number of foreign citizens who received licenses includes those foreign citizens whose licenses were reconfirmed.

LIVING STANDARDS

The indicators of money incomes and expenditures of population are developed in accordance with the Methodological Provisions for calculation of indicators of money incomes and expenditures of population, approved by Order of Rosstat dated July 2, 2014 No. 465, as amended of November 20, 2018.

Real money income of population, accrued wages and salary, pensions - relative indicators calculated by dividing the indices of nominal size (actual for the reporting period) of money income of population, accrued wages, pensions by a consumer price index for the respective period.

Money incomes of population include gains of persons engaged in individual business activity, accrued remuneration of employees, pensions, benefits, grants and other social transfers, property income (as interest on deposits, securities, dividends), and other money receipts. Money income in the current period less compulsory payments and dues are disposable money income of population.

Average per capita money income is calculated by dividing the total sum of money income by population size.

Money expenditures of population include expenses on purchasing of goods and services, compulsory payments and various fees (taxes and dues, insurance payments, fees in public and cooperative organizations, interest on loans, etc.), other expenditures.

Savings of population are: increase (decrease) of savings on rouble and foreign currency accounts in banks of the Russian Federation and abroad; increase (decrease) of funds as credits and loans from foreign counterparts; increase

(decrease) of savings in securities (including promissory notes and debt liabilities); expenditures on acquisition of real estate (including balance of operations with instruments of participation in capital and real estate abroad); increase (decrease) of currency in hands in roubles and foreign currency in rouble equivalent; increase (decrease) of other savings. The total volume of savings of population is adjusted on the volume of financial liabilities (credits, loans) and on the volume of sale of financial assets (funds from the sale and redemption of investment shares, from the sale of participatory interests in the charter capital of organizations, etc).

Gross average nominal monthly wages of employees of organizations are calculated by dividing gross wages fund of the employees by average annual number of employees and a number of months in the period. Benefits granted to the employed from the state extra-budget funds are not included in the wages and salaries fund and in average wages and salaries.

Real accrued wages of employees of organizations characterizes purchasing power of salary in reference period under conditions of changes of prices for consumer goods and services compared to base period. Index of real wages is calculated for this purpose by dividing of nominal wages index to the consumer price index for the same period.

Average pension is determined by dividing the total sum of pensions by the number of pensioners (data of Pension Fund of the Russian Federation).

Deposits of individuals – deposits and other funds of individuals raised by crediting organizations (including saving certificates), non-settled liabilities of agreements for raising funds on deposits and other raised funds as well as money on other individual's bank accounts. Funds of individual entrepreneurs, electing funds of individuals and remittances from the Russian Federation to abroad and to the Russian Federation are not included for the calculation of this indicator.

Distribution of total money incomes by various population groups is expressed by the share of total money income allotted to each of 20 percent population groups ranged by the extent of per capita money income increase.

Coefficient Gini (index of income concentration) characterizes the level of deviation of the actual volume of incomes distribution of population from the line of their even distribution. The value of coefficient may vary from 0 to 1, and the higher the value of this indicator, the less even is the distribution of income in the society.

Distribution of population by per capita money income characterizes the differentiation of population by welfare level and presents the resident population size (or its shares) grouped in given intervals by the level of per capita money income.

Distribution of population by per capita money income is computed in accordance with the methodology approved by the Resolution of Goskomstat of Russia № 61 of July 16, 1996 which was conformed to related ministries and agencies. Statistical time series are compiled using the method of imitation modeling by transformation of the empiric distribution, based on the sample survey on household budgets, into the time series which corresponds to the value of grouping indication of the general population (per capita money income based on data of the balance of money income and expenditure of population).

Survey of consumer expectation of population, which is the information base to calculate opinions of customers (individual and aggregated indices), has been conducted since Q IV, 1998. The collection of primary information is carried out using the personal interview in the second month of every quarter in all constituent entities of the Russian Federation. The used stratified multi-level sampling in 2015 amounts to 5100 respondents and is representative for main social and demographic indicators of population of Russia aged 16 years and over.

Individual indicators of consumer expectations of population, which reflect subjective estimates of population on selected social and economic aspects of public life, are calculated as percent balance on the basis of the distribution of responses to respective questions of the questionnaire, containing five variants of response. The percent balance is defined as the difference between percent of positive and negative responses using double weights for "extreme" and "neutral" responses.

Aggregated indicator (consumer confidence index) reflecting aggregated consumer expectations and intentions based on subjective estimates of population is compiled as the arithmetic mean of percent balance of five questions: passed and expecting changes in personal tangible welfare, passed and expecting changes in the economic situation in Russia, conditions favorable for large purchases.

Individual and aggregated indices are subjects of variation from –100 to +100: a negative value implies the predominance of negative evaluations in the society, a positive value – positive evaluations. The increase of the index implies the growing optimism of population, its decrease – growing pessimism.

GDP

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) – is generalized indicator of economic activity of the country. GDP at the production stage presents a sum of value added of kinds of economic activity in basic prices plus net taxes on products and at the stage of use – the costs of goods and services intended for the final consumption, accumulation and net exports. GDP is computed at current and constant prices (real GDP).

Market price of a final customer includes trade and transport markup, taxes on products and does not include subsidies on products.

To avoid the influence of different rates of taxes and subsidies for different kinds of economic activity on the structure of production the gross value added indicators are estimated at basic prices.

Basic price is a price which is gained by a producer for a unit of good or services excluding taxes on production but including subsidies on products.

Gross Domestic Product at the stage of use is the sum of expenditures on final consumption of households, general government and non-profit institutions serving households, gross fixed capital formation, changes in inventories, acquisition less disposals of valuables and net exports (excluding imports).

Final consumption expenditures of households include expenditure of households on acquisition of consumer goods and services as well as the consumption of goods and services obtained in kind.

Final consumption expenditures of general administration and non-profit institutions serving households include expenditures of these sectors on goods and services for individual consumption as well as expenditures of general government sector on collective consumption.

Gross capital formation shows the net acquisition of goods and services produced by resident units in the current period or obtained by imports but not consumed during a/m period.

Net exports are defined as a difference between exports and imports of goods and services.

INVESTMENTS

Investments in fixed capital - universe of costs directed on construction, reconstruction (including extension and modernization) of units which lead to increase the original cost of objects and refers to the value added capital of organizations, purchase of buildings, structures, machines, equipment, tools and implements, accounting records of which are maintained according to the procedure established for recording investments in noncurrent assets, investments in intellectual property; cultivated bioresources.

Investments in fixed capital include consumed costs at the expense of funds of citizens and legal entities obtained by developer organizations for equity construction.

Indices of physical volume of investments in fixed capital are computed at constant prices. Average annual prices of the previous year are taken as constant prices.

Data relating to **economic activities** are given in line with the OKVED2 classification according to the purposes of fixed assets, i.e. for the field of activity where they will operate.

Financial investments – investments of an organization in state and municipal securities, securities of other institutions, including debt securities, in which data and redemption cost are determined (bonds, promissory notes); deposits in charter (contributed) capitals of other organizations (including subsidiaries and dependent economic societies); deposits (contributions) of partner institutions under a simple partnership agreement; loans to other institutions; deposits in credit institutions, debtor receivables acquired by assignment of right of demand, contributions of the organization-comrades under a simple partnership agreement, etc.

Financial investments of organizations, depending on the maturity of the loans and credits can be long-term and short-term ones.

Long-term financial investments - investments for a period exceeding one year, carried out with the intention to get income (dividends): investments of companies in profitable assets (securities) of other institutions, charter capital (share fund) of other enterprises established on the territory of the Russian Federation or abroad, state securities (bonds and other debt securities), and the like, as well as loans given by organizations (companies) to other organizations.

Short term financial investments - investments for a period not exceeding one year, carried out with the intention to get income (dividends): in subsidiaries and dependent companies, company's investments in the securities of other institutions (companies), state securities, etc., as well as loans to other entities for a period not exceeding one year, etc.

ENTERPRISES AND ORGANIZATIONS

Data on enterprises and organizations in the Russian Federation are obtained from records of state registration of legal entities.

Grouping of business enterprises is performed by the code of respective actual economic activity according to the Russian Classification of Economic Activities (OKVED) declared by the organizations at the state registration as their main activity.

Small and medium-sized enterprises. Small and medium-sized enterprises are classified as such according to Article 4 of the Federal law of July 24, 2007 № 209-FZ "On development of small and medium entrepreneurship in the Russian Federation".

Statistical information on activities of small businesses (less micro enterprises) is presented according to data from quarterly sample statistical surveys on the basis of the representative sample. The order how to conduct sample observations of small businesses is established by the Decision of the Government of the Russian Federation of February 16, 2008 № 79 "On the order to conduct sample statistical surveys of subjects of small and medium entrepreneurship's activities".

INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION

Production index is a relative indicator characterising changes in the volume of production over comparable periods. There are individual and aggregate indices of production. The individual index reflects changes of one product output and is calculated as a ratio of production volume of this type of product in quantity terms in the comparable periods. The aggregate index of production characterises integrated changes in production of all kind of products and reflects changes in the value generated in the process of industrial production as a result of only quantitative changes of volume produced. To calculate the aggregate index of production, individual indices for definite types of industrial products are aggregated step by step into indices by kinds of activity, subgroups, groups, sub-classes, classes, subsections and sections of the Russian Classification of Economic Activities (OKVED2).

Industrial production index – the aggregated production index by kinds of economic activity “Mining and quarrying of natural minerals”, “Manufacturing”, “Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply”, “Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities”.

Data for industrial production index and production indices for economic activities “Mining and quarrying”, “Manufacturing”, “Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply”, “Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities” for the Russian Federation are presented with due regard to informal activities.

Volume of shipped own produced goods, works performed and services rendered is the value of own production of all goods, works performed and service rendered shipped or sold or exchanged directly (according to the agreement of barter). Amount of goods shipped is the value of the goods produced by a legal entity and actually shipped outside in the reference period (to other legal entities or individuals), including goods handed with official documents to the customer on the spot irrespectively either money transfer was received on the account of seller or not.

Volume of own works and service is the value of works and service rendered (performed) to other legal entities and individuals.

Data are presented at current wholesale factory prices without value added tax, excises and similar compulsory payments.

Entrepreneurial confidence index is a qualitative indicator which permits on the basis of manager’s responses to make a forecast of production output, stock and demand for products (order book) and thus to characterize economic activity of organizations engaged in “Mining and quarrying”, “Manufacturing”, “Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply” (except small businesses) and compile a prognostication of changes in economic variables. The index is an arithmetic mean of “balance” of responses on the expecting production output, the actual demand (order book) and the current stock of finished produce (the latter with opposite sign).

The “balance” of the expecting production output is identified as the difference between shares of respondents noted “increase” and “decrease” evaluating the perspectives of production output.

The “balances” of the demand (order book) and stock of finished produce are defined as the difference between shares of respondents whose estimations of their positions were “more than enough” and “not enough”.

More than 4.1 thousand organizations (excluding small businesses) of “Mining and quarrying”, “Manufacturing”, “Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply” kinds of activities are covered by monthly business activity surveys.

AGRICULTURE

Production of agriculture is the sum of plant-growing and animal husbandry outputs of all agricultural organizations including households of private sector (private households farming, peasant farms and individual entrepreneurs) in value terms at current actual prices.

The production of plant-growing includes the cost of raw products from the harvest gathered in the reporting year - grains and legumes, potatoes, vegetables, oil seeds and oleaginous fruits, tobacco unprocessed and home-grown brands, sugar beets, straw and forage crops, vegetable raw materials, used in manufacture of textiles, plants for perfumery, pharmaceuticals and the like, sugar beet seeds, seeds of forage crops, live plants, flowers and cut flower buds, seeds of flowers, fruit trees, seeds of vegetables, grapes, fruit, berries and nuts, plants for the manufacture of drink, spices, not processed, and the change in the cost of production in progress of plant growing from the beginning to the end of year (planting and growing up to ripening of agricultural crops and perennial plantations).

Production of animal husbandry includes the cost of raw products obtained as the result of growing and making use of agricultural livestock and poultry (milk, wool, eggs etc.), the cost of breeding (offspring, increase, gain in weight) of cattle and poultry in the reference year, the cost of bee-keeping, etc.

Agricultural production index is a relative indicator characterising changes in the volume of planting and cattle breeding production over comparable periods. The indicator of the agriculture production volume at constant prices of previous period is used to calculate the agricultural production index.

Livestock population includes the livestock covering all age groups of a respective nature of livestock.

Production of cattle and poultry for slaughter is the indicator characterising the result of use of meat and poultry for slaughter. Total volume of production of cattle and poultry for slaughter includes both livestock and poultry sold for

slaughter and also slaughtered at agricultural organizations, private (peasant) farms, individual entrepreneurs and households of citizens.

Milk production is characterised by actually produced milk of cows, goats and horses irrespective of the fact whether it was sold or used at the farm for feeding calves or piglets. Milk sucked by calves being kept sucking is not included in the production output.

Eggs production includes all eggs collected during the year from all types of agricultural poultry including eggs used for poultry reproduction (incubation, etc.).

CONSTRUCTION

Cost of work performed by kind of economic activity “**Construction**” is construction works performed by organizations with own resources on the basis of agreements (contracts) signed with customers. The cost of these works includes building of new constructions, capital and current repair and overhaul, reconstruction, modernization of residential and non-residential building and engineering structures.

Indices of physical volume (volume indices) of works by the kind of economic activity “Construction” are calculated at constant prices. Average annual prices of the previous year are assumed as constant prices.

Index of entrepreneurial confidence in construction is an arithmetic mean of “balances” of assessments of the portfolio of orders and expecting changes in the number of employees.

Buildings refer to the construction system consisting of supporting and guarding or combined (both supporting and guarding) structures forming a ground closed volume intended for people dwelling or staying therein, depending on functional purpose and for a performance of various production processes.

Total volume of buildings is identified as the sum of construction volume above the mark plus-minus 0.00 (the ground part) and below this mark (the underground part). The construction volume of the ground and underground portions of the building is determined within the bordering surfaces of ventilated cellar floors under buildings designed for construction on permafrost grounds

Total area of building is determined as the sum of floor space of all building floors (including technical, attic, socle, and basement) measured within inward surfaces of external walls, as well as the floor of balconies and loggias. The floor of the premises shall be determined by their sizes between finished surfaces of the walls and partitions at the floor level.

Total volume of buildings and total area of dwellings is determined according to national construction regulation SNiP 31-01-2003.

Total area of dwellings in commissioned residential and non-residential buildings, dwellings is determined as the sum of all living parts and subsidiary floor space of apartments earmarked to meet consumer and other needs of citizens and also square of loggias, balconies, verandahs, terraces, calculated using corresponding decreasing coefficients in apartment-type and hotel-type buildings, individual houses, hostels of constant type and other residential buildings (houses for aged persons and invalids, bedroom premises of children's homes and boarding schools). Subsidiary premises include kitchens, halls, intra-flat corridors, bathrooms or shower-rooms, lavatories, store-rooms or fitted cupboards. Apart from above, subsidiary premises of houses for aged persons and invalids, veterans, of children's homes, hostels, boarding schools also refer dining rooms, canteens, clubs, reading rooms, sports halls, consumer services and medical services reception centers.

Total area of dwellings does not include the area of vestibules, lobbies, staircases, common corridors, as well as the floor in residential houses designed for built-in and attached non-residential premises.

Commissioning of objects and capacities of social sphere and motor roads is the capacity indicator (productivity, building capacity, visitor capacity, floor space, length, etc.) resulting from investments in fixed capital. In statistical questionnaires commissioning of objects is recorded in the size given in the permission to put object (capacity) into operation, executed in accordance with established procedure in line with the existing Law of the Russian Federation governing urban development.

TRADE AND SERVICES

Retail trade turnover – a revenue from goods sold to population for own consumption or for use in households and paid by cash or credit cards, by bank cheques, from bank accounts of individual by bank transfer or by payment cards (electronic money).

The value of goods sold with discount to certain categories of population or paid completely by social security bodies is to be included in the total retail trade turnover with nominal prices. Retail trade turnover does not include cost of goods, sold by retail trade network to legal entities (including bodies of social security, special customers etc.) and individual entrepreneurs and catering turnover.

Retail trade turnover includes data both on organizations where retail trade is their main activity, and organizations of other kinds of activity that sell goods to population. Retail trade turnover also includes the value of goods sold to public by individual entrepreneurs and private persons at retail trade markets and fairs.

Retail trade turnover is compiled on the basis of the monthly full-scale federal statistical observation on organizations, which do not belong to small businesses, on quarterly sample surveys of retail trade small businesses (except micro-enterprises), retail markets and fairs, as well as on the annual sample surveys of individual entrepreneurs and micro-enterprises is conducted with the spread of the data to the general universe.

In accordance with SNA requirements the retail trade turnover is revised with due regard to a volume of activity, which is not observed by direct statistical methods.

Retail trade turnover is given at current sale prices including trade margin, VAT and similar compulsory payments.

Changes in retail trade turnover are defined by comparing the turnover for respective periods at constant prices.

Entrepreneurial confidence index for retail trade is computed as an arithmetic mean of "balance" of assessments (in percent) of the actual business condition of an enterprise, storage stock (with the opposite sign) and the expected business condition.

Volume of market services represents money equivalent of the volume of services provided by residents of the Russian Federation (legal bodies, and private persons engaged in entrepreneurial activities without a status of legal entity (individual entrepreneurs) using different services on the territory of the Russian Federation. This indicator is based on methodology for compiling official statistical information on the volume of market services rendered to population, approved by the Order of the Federal State Statistics Service № 643 from September 29, 2017 on the basis of estimation of the non-observed activities in the services market.

TRANSPORT

Volume of goods carried – the quantity of goods in ton carried by transport of all kinds of economic activities.

Freight turnover is the volume of transport works of all kinds of economic activities for freight transportation. The unit of its measurement is ton-kilometers. It is calculated as a sum produced by multiplying the weight of shipped freight in ton by the length of its shipping in kilometers.

Passenger turnover is the volume of transport work of passenger transportation (including passengers enjoying the right of free and subsidy fare. The unit of the measurement is a passenger-kilometer. It is determined as a sum produced by multiplying the number of passengers for each position of transportation by the length of distance covered in kilometers.

INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES

Information and communication technologies (ICT) are technologies which use microelectronic facilities to collect, store, process, search, transmit and represent data, texts, images and sound.

Internet is global (worldwide) set of independent computer networks connected to each other for the exchange of information by standard open protocols.

Broadband access to the Internet network is access to the Internet that operated at 256 kbit /s and above.

Specific software is software used to solve a particular class of problems regardless of whether this software was developed by the organization's own resources, purchased from other developers, was custom-made by a third-party firms or specialists, or was received to be used on other terms. They do not include general-purpose software, such as operating systems, compilers, standard software used to solve a specific class of tasks (for example, text or graphic editors, spreadsheets, database management systems), if a special application, antivirus software, email programs, etc. have not been developed on their basis.

CRM system - customer relationship management system, which helps an organization to collect and accumulate data regarding various aspects of its customers' activities, e.g. the availability of goods (services), needs for them, sales cycles, product prices.

ERP system – is an information system for identification and planning of all those resources of an organization, which are necessary for sales, production, procurement and accounting during processing customers' orders.

SCM system – is a supply chain management system intended to automate and manage the procurement/supply of an organization, to control product distribution.

FINANCES

Budget is a form of generation and expenditure of money funds intended for financial support of tasks and functions of the state and local self-government bodies.

Consolidated budget of the Russian Federation comprises the federal budget and the aggregate of consolidate budgets of the Russian Federation (except inter-budget transfers between these budgets).

Federal budget is intended for the execution of liabilities of the Russian Federation.

Consolidated budget of a political (constituent) entity of the Russian Federation – is formed by the budget of this political entity of the Russian Federation and the aggregate of budgets of municipalities included in the composition of the political entity of the Russian Federation (except inter-budget transfers between these budgets).

The budget of a political entity of the Russian Federation (regional budget) is intended for the execution of liabilities of the political entity of the Russian Federation.

Budget of municipal unit (local budget) – intended for the execution of liabilities of the respective municipality.

The revenue of the budget - money resources coming to the budget excepting resources which according to the Budget Code of the Russian Federation are the source to cover budget deficit.

Tax revenue, non-tax revenue and gratis payments are included in the revenue of budget.

Expenditures of budget – money resources paid from the budget fund excepting resources which according to the Budget Code of the Russian Federation are the source to cover budget deficit. Formation of expenditures of budgets of all levels of the budget system of the Russian Federation is carried out in accordance with liabilities approved by the legislation of the Russian Federation for the selection of plenary powers of the federal state power, state power of subjects of the Russian Federation and the local self-government bodies the execution of which according to the legislation of the Russian Federation, international and other agreements must be carried out at the expense of corresponding budgets in the coming financial year (coming financial year and planning period).

Budget deficit - the excess of budgetary expenditures over revenues.

Budget profit - the excess of budgetary revenues over expenditures.

Money supply (aggregate) M2 – the sum of cash money in circulation and balance of funds of non-financial and financial (except credit institutions) organizations-residents of the Russian Federation and individuals-residents of the Russian Federation on current, deposit and other non-demand accounts (including accounts for payment by plastic bank cards), term deposits and other obtained funds for the period, thrift accounts opened at banking system in the currency of the Russian Federation as well as the accumulated interest charged. Non-cash money is subdivided into transferable deposits and other deposits. Therefore, the aggregate MO includes cash money in circulation and non-cash money.

Cash money in circulation (the aggregate MO) – most liquid part of money supply available for quick use as payment instrument. It includes banknotes and coins in circulation.

Non-cash money, that is included in the aggregate M2, is subdivided into transferable deposits and other deposits.

Transferable deposits include balance of funds of non-financial and financial (except credit institutions) organizations-residents of the Russian Federation and individuals-residents of the Russian Federation on current, deposit and other non-demand accounts (including accounts for payment by plastic bank cards) opened at banking system in the currency of the Russian Federation as well as the accumulated interest charged.

Other deposits include balance of funds of non-financial and financial (except credit institutions) organizations and individuals, term deposits and other obtained funds for the period, thrift accounts opened at banking system in the currency of the Russian Federation as well as the accumulated interest charged.

International reserve assets (international reserves) of the Russian Federation are foreign financial assets of a high level of liquidity (currency reserves) at disposal of the Bank of Russia and the Government of the Russian Federation as of reporting data.

International reserve assets consist of foreign currency funds, special drawing rights (SDR), reserve position in the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and monetary gold.

Credits, deposits and other resources extended to organizations (less state government body, local self-government bodies, extra-budget funds), physical persons (individuals) and credit institutions – total - indebtedness of clients (including the overdue indebtedness) to credit institutions for all granted credits. Total indebtedness on credits, besides correspondent sums allocated from the total sum (credits to individuals, to organizations, credit institutions), also includes credits extended to foreign countries and - indebtedness (including overdue) for transactions with precious metals (except transactions with credit institutions).

Creditor liability (payables) includes indebtedness to suppliers and contractors for tangible values received, work performed and services rendered, including indebtedness supported by promissory notes issued; indebtedness in payments with associated companies and branch establishments according to all forms of transactions; indebtedness to the workers and employees on fixed but unpaid labour remuneration; indebtedness in allocations for state social insurance, pension security and medical insurance of employees; indebtedness towards all forms of payments with regard to budgetary funds and extra-budget funds; indebtedness of organizations towards the payments relating to compulsory and voluntary insurance of the property and employees of the organization as well as to other types of insurance in which the organization is the insurer; advances received including sums paid by other organizations on coming payments under concluded agreements, as well as penalties, fines, default interests and forfeits admitted by entitled by the law of the Russian Federation with the right of organizations or determined by court (arbitrage) or another body confiscating the sums to be paid or referring them to the financial results of the organizations, unpaid sums of borrowed loans to be settled in accordance with the signed agreements.

Debtor receivable (receivables) includes indebtedness of settlements with buyers and customers for goods (works, services) including indebtedness covered with promissory notes; indebtedness to associated companies and branch establishments; advances payable to other organizations in accordance with agreements concluded; indebtedness payable to other debtors including indebtedness of financial and tax bodies (including overpayment of taxes, dues and

other payments to the budget); indebtedness of employees of the organizations against loans received from funds of this organizations or banking credit (loans for individual and cooperative housing construction, acquisition of private garden plots, interest-less loans to young families for promotion of living conditions or purchase of personal property, etc.); indebtedness against liabilities of suppliers, loss of commodities and tangible values; indebtedness of state customers, the federal programs for supplied goods(work, services) as well as penalties, fine, default interests admitted by the debtor or determined by court (arbitration court) or another body entitled by the law of the Russian Federation with the right of confiscating the sums to be paid or referring them to the financial results of organizations.

Overdue indebtedness on labour reimbursement comprises actually accrued wages (including income tax of individuals and other dues) of employees but not paid in due time specified by the collective agreements or by agreements on payments signed with banks. Number of delay days starting from the next day after a day specified in the agreement.

PRICES AND TARIFFS

Consumer price index for goods and tariffs (CPI) for goods and services shows within a specified period of time fluctuations of prices for goods and services purchased by population for non-production consumption. It measures a ratio of the value of a fixed basket of main goods and services at prices of the current period as related to its value at prices of the previous period.

In 2019 the fixed basket of goods and services includes 510 items of goods (service)-representatives. Observation of prices and tariffs is carried out in the capitals of republics, central cities, territories, regions, autonomous region, autonomous districts (okrug), cities of the federal subordination and by sampling – in centers of districts (rayon) selected with due regard to their representativeness to reflect socio-economic and geographical situation of political entities of the Russian Federation.

Cost of fixed basket of consumer goods and services for interregional comparison of purchasing power of population of the Russian Federation and its legal subjects is computed on the basis of unified level of consumption and average prices for Russia and its subjects. The basket includes 83 types of goods and services including 30 food products, 41 non-food products and 12 types of service.

Producer price index for industrial production is compiled on the basis of prices recorded for representative commodities in base organizations. Observation of producer prices is carried out in more than 10 thousand organizations. Calculation of average prices and price indices is carried out for more than 1100 goods-representatives. Producer prices are actual prices for the goods produced and shipped (services rendered) by organizations for sale in the domestic market (less indirect taxes - value added tax, excise taxes, etc.) which were fixed at the moment of registration.

Producer price indices calculated by goods-representatives are gradually aggregated into prices indices of corresponding kinds, groups, classes and sections of economic activity. Data on the volume of shipment for the basic period in value terms are used as a weight factor.

Aggregate price index for investment purpose products (expenditures, services) is calculated as aggregated indicator of production price index for construction products, purchasing machinery and equipment for investment purpose and other investment purpose products (expenditures, services) weighted by the share of these elements in the total volume of investments in fixed capital.

Producer price index for agricultural production is computed on the basis of prices of agricultural organizations selected for observation registered for main types of goods-representatives sold to purchasing organizations, processing companies, in market, through own trade outlets, at fairs, to households directly from transport means, in exchanges and auctions, to organizations, commercial structures, etc. Prices for sold agricultural produce are given considering increments and discounts for the quality of sold produce excluding the expenses connected with transportation, delivery, loading and unloading of products and excepting the value added tax and subsidies.

Tariff index for freight shipment characterizes current changes in freight shipping tariffs for the reference period, irrespective of the changes in the structure of cargo shipped considering multilateral properties such as consignment type, size of deliveries, speed of delivery, distances for the freight shipments to be covered by carriers, territory of transportation, rolling stock type, freight carrying capacity and its use.

The aggregate tariff index of freight shipment is compiled on the basis of tariff index of freight shipping by different modes of transport (rail, pipelines, marine, inland water, motor vehicle and air transport) weighted by the revenue from freight shipped by each mode of transport for the basic period. A tariff of a service-representative is registered for each mode of transport. The service-representative is determined by the cost of one ton of bulk cargo shipping by the definite mode of transport over a specified distance. Recording of tariffs is conducted by a sample population of transport organizations.

FOREIGN ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES

Information on the foreign trade in goods is based on data from the Bank of Russia and the Federal Customs Service of Russia.

Information of the **Bank of Russia** on foreign trade of the Russian Federation is represented **according to the Balance of Payments methodology** and includes:

data of the Federal Customs Service obtained from customs freight declarations of participants of foreign trade activity including data on mutual trade with the member-states of the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) obtained from statistical reports on transferring of goods;

data on the exports (imports) of commodities, which do not cross the customs border of the Russian Federation (fish and sea products, caught and sold outside the customs territory; fuel and goods, purchased by Russian (foreign) sea transport in foreign (Russian) ports)), obtained on the basis of federal statistical observation of the Federal State Statistics Service;

additional computations of the Bank of Russia to foreign trade statistics which are compiled according to the Balance of Payments methodology and include estimates of value of imported (exported) goods by individuals within the approved duty-free quote and simplified (privilege) manner and other elements of additional computations.

Foreign trade in goods is also presented according to **data of the Federal Customs Service of the Russian Federation**.

Data on the foreign trade turnover includes mutual trade with the member-states of the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU).

Customs statistics of foreign and mutual trade is formed on all commodities (including values, but excluding currency values in circulation) exports and imports of which increase or decrease material resources of the country and do not include goods which do not cross the customs border of the Russian Federation (fish and sea products, caught and sold outside of the customs territory, fuel and goods, purchased by Russian (foreign) transportation means in foreign (Russian) ports as well as imports (exports) of goods by individuals within approved a duty free quote, or which cross the customs border in privilege manner.

The member-states of the **Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU)** are the Republic of Armenia, the Republic of Belarus, the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Kyrgyz Republic and the Russian Federation.

Foreign trade turnover is a sum of export and import of goods.

Exports – removal of commodities from the territory of the Russian Federation without guarantee of the return them back. Export includes removal from a country of domestically produced commodities and re-export of commodities. Domestically produced commodities include also those of foreign origin imported to a country and significantly reprocessed and as a result changed their qualitative and technical characteristics. Goods imported to the territory of the Russian Federation and then removed from its territory without payment of customs dues, taxes and application of embargo or economic restrictions, are related as re-exported commodities.

Imports – taking of commodities to the territory of the Russian Federation without guarantee of the return them removed back. Import includes commodities run for consumption in the economy of a country, brought in the territory of a state according to a re-import regime. Re-imported commodities are those moved out from the territory of the Russian Federation and then moved in this territory without payment of customs dues, taxes and application of embargo or economic restrictions.

International trade in services – rendering services (performing works) by the market participants which include production, distribution, marketing and service delivery.

Information on exports (imports) of services is presented according to the IMF's sixth edition of the Balance of Payments and International Investment Position Manual (BPM6).

Service is a useful result of activity, which meets definite needs, but can't be embodied in material form

Exports of services – services rendered to non-residents by residents of national economic.

Imports of services – services, rendered to residents of national economic by non-residents.
