

Waugh's 36. Bryce Ward added a 47 and Danny Harker a 48 to complete the team score. The boys golf team also took first place in the Ottawa Invite on Monday, September 14th. Jonathan Waugh placed 3rd and Ryan Waugh 4th with 76's. Cole Yearsley placed with 15th and Evan Stribiak rounded out the scoring for the Foxes!

9/23 - Seniors take the SAT!

12th grade students will be taking the SAT with Essay. Regardless of your learning model or team, all 12th grade students will report to the YHS campus with No. 2 pencils and their calculator.



All 9th, 10th and 11th grade students will be learning remotely on Wednesday, September 23rd regardless of their learning model or team.

Forgot your Chromebook at home?



If a student arrives at school without their Chromebook, we now have a limited number of Chromebooks available through a loaner program in the libraries at YHS and YHSA. 
Hey Seniors - Reserve your Cap & Gown!

Free Meal Program for All Children



On Tuesday, the district hosted its first community-wide weekly free meal distribution for all children age 18 and under who reside within in the district's boundaries. The need within the Yorkville CUSD 115 community was greater than anticipated, and those staffing the distribution process appreciated the patience and understanding of those who waited in the drive through line to pick up the meals. District administration has reviewed the preparation and distribution processes and implemented changes to make next Tuesday's distribution more efficient for families.

As a reminder:

- Families do not need to sign up in order to participate in the program.
- Students who attend school full day on-site will receive their meals at school. All other students can pick up their meals during the Tuesday meal distribution from 4-6 p.m. at Yorkville High School, 797 Game Farm Road.
- The free meal program for all children is in effect until December 31, 2020.

Map My Next Move Update - College & Career Center

Each year, the Counseling Department requires that all students

complete the Map My Next Move survey, detailing their individual post-secondary plans. This survey allows Counselors to collaborate with students and families to support the college and career aspirations for all students.

Post-secondary planning involves evaluating all options for students to pursue after high school graduation. These plans may include: entering the military, going straight into the workforce, attending a trade and/or vocational school, and attending a 4 year college or



university. As a Counseling Department we strive to ensure that all students have identified a post-secondary plan, and have the tools to help that plan turn into a reality.

Post-secondary plans should be attainable, researched and have a "back-up" plan. In the event that your student is planning on attending college, that means that they should have an identified "safety" school to apply to. Safety schools are defined as those which a particular student has a 75% chance or better of being accepted.

As of Monday, September 14, 2020, the Map My Next Move survey completion rate is as follows:

Class of 2021 (Seniors): 206 Class of 2022 (Juniors): 196 Class of 2023 (Sophomores): 171 Class of 2024 (Freshmen): 102

The total number of students who have completed the survey is 675, for an overall completion rate of 34%! 125 more students need to complete the survey for a 40% overall completion rate! Lets get it done, Foxes!
