Theme

The theme this year is <u>'Frontier Explorer'</u> from *Hebrews 11:16* with a focus on support for one another. We plan to have many outdoor activities featuring games, classes and competition. We want to encourage all boys and men to wear their warm outdoor gear for this great weekend. In addition we will have the special activities that make D-A Ranch a special place – sledding, ice-skating, shooting ranges and horseback riding.

Our event speaker for Avalanche 2018 is *Rick Dostal* of Marietta, Ohio. Rick started in Royal Rangers since 1978 in Northern California. He moved to Springfield, MO in 2000 to serve on National RR staff and later moved to Ohio. He currently works as a structural building inspector and serves an Outpost Coordinator and National FCF Field Advisor. Rick has a passion for FCF (Frontier Camping Fellowship) and leading boys to find Jesus. He brings great frontier adventure stories and a message to challenge all boys and men.

Who can Come?

This event is open to boys (ages 9 and older), fathers, grandfathers, pastors and leaders. Younger boys may attend with their fathers but may be unable to ride horses. Each church is responsible for permission forms and direct supervision of their boys at all times during this event. Forms need to be filled out and brought to registration on Feb 16th.

Location and Facilities

The <u>D-A Ranch</u> is located in Metamora, Michigan, which is south of Lapeer and north of Oxford. It is a huge ranch facility full of activities, trails, lakes and cabins. The cabins are heated and modern shower/bathroom complexes are available. All the meals will be provided during this weekend event.

Activities and Agenda

Avalanche includes many activities: trail hiking, archery, rifle range, sledding, ice fishing and horseback riding. Special activities include an indoor gaga pit and the father/son snowshoe competition. The rifle range is available for all ages: bb rifles for younger boys, 22 rifles and skeet shotgun for older boys and adults. Horseback riding is also available for ages 9 and older (saddle sizing required) with a limited quantity of tickets and riding times. For younger riders, Horseback Corral rides (escorted riding) will be available. We also encourage groups to bring sleds, skates and ice-fishing equipment. Fire pits are available at each cabin site.

This event begins on February 16th, Friday night at 7pm at the Main Lodge. A <u>detailed agenda</u> with all scheduled activities, meals and events will be posted on the website and distributed at Registration. Avalanche 2018 ends on February18th, Sunday after lunch about 2pm.

<u>Cost</u>

The cost is **<u>\$58 per person</u>** which includes all meals, event patch, activities and 2 nights of cabin lodging. A \$20 per person pre-registration is required to reserve cabin space and meals commitment. Cabin size and selection preferences will be made on a first request basis. Pastors are invited to attend at a half-cost rate.


What to Bring

The cabins are heated and equipped with bunks and mattresses, so you will need to bring a sleeping bag or blankets. Personal items should include warm clothing, boots, hat, toothbrush and accessories. Shower and indoor bathroom facilities are available. Groups may want to bring snacks, bottled water, hot chocolate and coffee as each cabin has a kitchen and stove. Do **NOT** bring radios, TVs or electronic games. Optional: cameras, sleds, fishing gear and skates.

Avalanche Winter Camp Map

From Detroit Area & Southeast Michigan: From I-75 exit north onto M-24 (Lapeer Rd.) Proceed north thru the towns of Lake Orion and Oxford. Continue on M-24 North of Oxford for 9 miles. Turn right on Dryden Rd. and proceed to traffic signal in Metamora. **Observe the 25 MPH speed limit in Metamora - it is strictly enforced!** Turn left and continue for 2 miles to Sutton Rd. Turn right on Sutton Road and continue to main entrance of the Ranch. Turn right and proceed to the Administration Building to register.

From Flint Area & Northern Michigan: Proceed to I-69 and exit south onto M-24 (Lapeer Rd.) Proceed south approximately 5 miles and turn left (east) onto Dryden Rd. Follow the Detroit Area directions to the D-A Ranch.
