Summary Findings of the ICP 2005 Software Suite Evaluation




Evaluation methodology:


- Checking the relevance, operation, and user-friendliness of the ICP 2005

- Interviews with staff/ consultants from the ICP Global Office and IT specialists from DECDG


Responses:


- Responses were received from five regional coordinators from four regions: Asia, Africa,

- Out of fifty countries, responses were received from twenty-eight countries, eleven from Asia, eight from Africa, two from South America, and seven from Western Asia.










































Main changes from 2005:

- Data submission of Core List data from all ICP regions as well as Eurostat-OECD
- Archive of Core List specifications, data, and metadata
- Access to Core List data
- Increased focus on the submission and archive of metadata (country-specific and region-specific)
