- 1. ADVENT WREATH (EVERGREEN WREATH FOR ETERNITY/LIFE, 3 X PURPLE CANDLES FOR ROYALTY/PENITENCE, 1 X ROSE CANDLE FOR JOY, 1 X LARGE WHITE CHRIST CANDLE IN THE CENTRE)
- 2. TREE RAISING/DECORATING
- 3. O Antiphons (7 prayers sung as vespers at night or recited; response to *magnificat*)
- 4. ADVENT CALENDAR

IMPROVISING: CELEBRATING LIGHT AS HOPE, GATHER AROUND A CAMPFIRE; USE A BLUE OR PURPLE COLOURED LIGHT IN A STRATEGIC LOCATION AROUND YOUR HOME; CANDLELIGHT DINNERS.
