
4th Grade Lessons



- 2. Discuss who the characters (people and animals in the story) are in the story. Compare the characters What are their similarities? Differences?
- 3. Discuss the setting (Where does the story takes place?)
- 4. Discuss what happened in the beginning, middle and end of the story.
- 5. Discuss the problem and solution in the story.
- 6. Did the character(s) change over the course of the story?
- 7. Were there any good vocabulary words in the story?
- 8. What about adjectives? Can you spot any adjectives?
- 9. What was the author's purpose for writing this story?
- 10. Did you notice any figurative language? What type was it?
