

# **Dealing with Pop-Ups on USDA Web Sites**

Below are step-by-step Instructions for allowing pop-ups on USDA web sites. You may click on the link below to access the instructions for the browser you are using.

### Internet Explorer (Version 11) to allow Pop-ups on USDA websites

This option is used if you wish to continue to block pop-ups but allow pop-ups on all USDA websites.

1. Open Internet Explorer. Click on Tools/Pop-up Blocker/Pop-up Blocker Settings (You will need to enable Pop-up Blocker before you can change the settings)



2. In the 'Address of Web site to allow' box type \*.usda.gov and click Add.

# Internet Explorer (Version 11) to turn off Pop-up blocker

1. Open Internet Explorer. Click on Tools/Pop-up Blocker/Turn Off Pop-up Blocker



## Edge (44.17763.831.0) to Block/allow Popups

1. Open Edge. Click the 3 dots in the far right corner of the screen. Click Settings.



2. Click the lock symbol and slide block pop-ups to off/on per your choice. Click off the screen to close.

1. Open Chrome. Click the 3 dots in the far right corner of the screen. Click Settings.



2. Click Privacy and Settings. Then click Site Settings

4. Slide blocked bar to blue if you wish to block pop-ups and allow only certin website pop-ups. Click Add next to allow and enter \*.usda.gov. If you wish to allow all pop-ups, make sure the (Blocked) slider is gray so no pop-ups will be blocked.

# Firefox (78.0.2) to allow Pop-ups on USDA websites

1. Open Firefox. Click the 3 lines in the far right corner of the screen. Click Options.



2. Click Privacy & Security and scroll to the Permissions section. Click Exceptions by Block pop-up windows (place a check mark in the box if exceptons is greyed out)

# Firefox (78.0.2) to unblock all Popups

1. Open Firefox. Click the 3 lines in the far right corner of the screen. Click Options.



2. Click Privacy & Security and scroll to Permissions. Uncheck Block pop-up windows
