Phonics


Today, we will be recapping our Phase 3 sounds and writing sentences.

- Let's recap our Phase 3 sounds. Say them out loud:
 s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, f, l, ll, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, qu, sh, ch, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er
- 2. Now, let's look at a sound we have previously learnt. The 'oo' sound makes two sounds: the u sound as in book and also an oo sound as in moon. Oo can make both these sounds in different words.


3. Using the pictures to help you, can you write in the words? The pictures below are all short 'oo' sound words. I have done the first word as an example:




4. Next, let's try writing words with the LONG 'oo' sound. I have done the first word as an example:



Can you match up the capacity to each bottle? I have done the first one for you. You can point to your answer.




Now, let's compare the capacity of two containers. Which container <u>holds the most?</u>



We are looking at books.






Today, we will be comparing heights of Jack's beanstalks. You will be pointing to which beanstalk is the tallest or shortest.


1. Which beanstalk is the shortest? Which is the tallest?



2. Which beanstalk is the shortest? Which is the tallest?








3. Are you ready for a challenge?




Topic
