There will be no final exams this year so students are expected to attend in person and online remotely until end of day Friday. February. 5 The school will be closed on Monday. February. 8 so the first day of the second semester will be on Tuesday. February. 9 (Day 6—Group B).

A reminder that when students are doing remote learning they are expected to log in for attendance in each class. The teachers will either engage home—learning students with those who are in-person, and/or provide instructions on what to do independently that day (keeping both groups on track), and/or answer questions. The purpose is to provide daily connection; greater structure while at home; and keep learning moving forward (i.e. not have to wait a day to have questions answered with the goal of reducing back-and-forth text communications in Edsby). This will unfold differently course-by-course / teacher-by-teacher. We are mindful to not over-commit student time and over load students with assignments, homework, or independent learning activities. We continue to plan around priority outcomes with a focus on the knowledge and skills required for continued success at the next level.



Tec-Voc High School offers a range of unique, interesting and challenging programs/courses for students from grades 9 - 12. The **Grade 9 and 10 Program** is unique from other high schools in that students have the opportunity to earn both academic and vocational credits. Grade 9 students have four dedicated teachers year round who teach the core academic subjects with English and Math being taught all year long instead of just one semester. One cohort of Grade 10 students (4 classrooms) also have a similar setting. The cohort model has been highly successful for students in their transition to high school.

WHAT IS UNIQUE ABOUT TEC-VOC?

Unlike many high schools in Winnipeg, students can explore many interests and graduate with two diplomas. Tec-Voc has a selection of 19 technical programs where students can acquire hands-on experience and develop essential skills in specific areas.
