 - For-profit US small biz
 - 500 or less employees
 - work done in US
 - Greater than 50% US-owned by individuals
 & independently operated
 - See rules for VC ownership of small biz

 SBIR – 3.2% of agencies' extramural research budget, with budget >\$100M

 STTR – 0.45% of agencies' extramural research budget, with budget >\$1B

- @ 160,000 awards granted
- @ 10 patents per day

 - Phase I concept development
 - Phase II prototype development
 - Phase III commercialization; no funding
- Principal Investigator (PI)
 - Employed by small biz applicant >50% SBIR
 - Employed by small biz or research institution




