### 1. Install the SIM Card

CAUTION: To avoid damage to the SIM card from electrostatic discharge, do not touch the SIM card connectors during installation or removal.

To install the SIM card:

Insert the SIM card into the slot

To connect to the network, go to View Available Networks and select cellular to turn on the cellular radio.
