NOTABLES: Denver beat the Golden State Warriors 126-121 in game four at Ball Arena on Sunday afternoon to get the series to $1-3 \ldots$.. It was all Nikola Jokic in the first quarter as he did everything for the Nuggets, scoring 18 points and grabbing six boards, Denver's defense also was tough, holding the Warriors to 8-26 shooting and five turnovers leading to only 21 points and they held a five-point lead ... The offense from the bench was a nice boost in the second as Bones Hyland scored 11 points, the Nuggets were able to get the charity stripe 11 times, making 10 to outscore the Warriors $37-31$ to take an 11-point lead into halftime ... It was a high scoring third with little defense, as the Nuggets shot $61 \%$ from the field and the Warriors $57 \%$, Denver also had nine assist on 11 field goals to help maintain their lead at 98-89 entering the fourth ... The Warriors would hang tight, mounting a late run to take a 121-119 lead with only minutes to go but the Nuggets answered, finishing the game on a 7-0 run to escape with the important victory.

NOTABLES: The Nuggets fell to the Golden State Warriors at home in game three, dropping to $0-3$ in the series ... It was a back and forth first quarter as both teams traded baskets to start and little defense was played, Nikola Jokic opened with 12 points and six boards and the Nuggets connected on 3-4 from long distance, however the Warriors would make five three's scoring 34 points to lead by two ... The Warriors stayed hot from long distance in the second going 7-9 from deep, and 13-17 overall, they scored 35 points but the Nuggets were able to force seven turnovers, losing the quarter by only eight and trailed by 10 at halftime ... Denver opened the third with a bang going on a run to get right back in the game, the Nuggets shot $60 \%$ from the field and held the Warriors to just $33 \%$ shooting and 18 points to outscore them by 12 and were able to take the lead ... Denver once again got off to a hot start in the first as Nikola Jokic scored 12 points and the Nuggets were able to outrebound Golden State 15-10, they would lead by as many as 11 before the Warriors cut it to one at the end of the quarter ... NOTABLES: The Nuggets fell to the Golden State Warriors 123-107 in game one ... It was a good first quarter for Denver as their defense created pressure and forced four turnovers for six points, they were able to jump out to an early lead behind 11-22 shooting from the field and eight assists on those 11 field goals to lead 27-26 ... The Warriors took advantage as the second unit entered the game and used a 13-2 run to jump out to the lead, Denver shot just 2-11 from three in the quarter while the Warriors were red hot, outscoring the Nuggets by 12 to lead by 11 at halftime ... The Nuggets battled early in the third but the Warriors used another big run to blow the game wide open, Denver had four turnovers for eight points and shot just $39 \%$ from the field, getting outscored by nine and they trailed by 20 entering the fourth ...The Nuggets used an early run in the fourth to cut the lead to 14 but it was short lived as the Warriors increased it back to 20 and were able to cruise for the rest of the game.

NOTABLES: Denver took down the Golden State Warriors on the road on Tuesday, moving their record to 17-16 ... The Nuggets came out locked in on the defensive end and it showed, they forced Stephen Curry into four turnovers and 0-2 shooting in the first and took advantage, Will Barton scored 14 points on 5-6 shooting and Denver held the Warriors to 16 points and led by 15 early ... It was more of the same for Denver in the second as they made it extremely hard for Curry to find a good look, the bench outscored the Warriors second unit 13-8 in the quarter to help stay afloat and Denver was able to take a 14-point lead into halftime ... The Warriors wouldn't go away easily, they opened the third on a $15-5$ run to get right back in the game but Denver never surrendered the lead and led by 13 at the end of three ... The Warriors would continue to fight and cut the lead down to single digits late in the game but a Nikola Jokić block while Denver was up two with seconds left sealed the win for the Nuggets.

NOTABLES: Denver took down the Golden State Warriors on a last second shot from Monte Morris in the last game before the all-star break ... Nikola Jokić was red hot in the first quarter as he nearly had a double-double posting 11 points and eight rebounds but the Warriors kept pace, knocking down five three's and outrebounded the Nuggets 14-11 and led by eight early ... Denver's bench played well in the second quarter led by Bryn Forbes who had eight points and as a second unit they outscored the Warriors bench 18-12 in the quarter and as a team, the Nuggets had seven assists on 11 field goals to go into halfime trailing by nine 63-54 ... Jokić was able to score 10 more points in the third quarter as the Nuggets stayed afloat, they forced six turnovers in the quarter to outscore the Warriors by one, trailing by eight ... NOTABLES: The Nuggets beat the Golden State Warriors 131-124 at home on the second night of a back-to-back ... It was a high scoring first quarter as both teams combined for 71 points, the Nuggets had nine players score in the quarter and were red hot from the field, shooting 14-20 from the field and 4-7 from three, scoring 40 points to lead by nine early ... The Warriors would keep the game close in the second quarter as they continued to do whatever they wanted on the offensive end, despite the Nuggets scoring 31 points and shooting $55 \%$ from the field, the Warriors made six threes and had 10 assists to win the quarter by seven ...There was little defense in the third as both teams went back and forth, Denver managed 11 assists on 12 field goals, eclipsing the 30 point mark in the quarter again and held a slim four point lead ... It remained close until the final minutes but 10 points from Jokić in fourth helped seal the victory for Denver.

NOTABLES: The Nuggets fell to the Golden State Warriors at home on Thursday night, losing just their first game in the last five nights ... It was a back and forth first quarter as both teams traded baskets, the Nuggets hit the boards hard, grabbing 14 in the quarter but managed only three assists and trailed 30-29 early ...The Nuggets bench once again stepped up when needed in the second quarter, they scored 19 points in the quarter and outscored the Warriors second unit by 12 to help Denver take the lead, the Nuggets got the free throw line 11 times outscoring the Warriors by 10 to lead by nine at half ... It was a close quarter for most of the third until the final minutes as Steph Curry caught fire and brought the Warriors back from nine down to outscore the Nuggets $37-24$ in the quarter ... It once again came down to the final minutes as the game was tied with two minutes to play but two key turnovers a defensive lapse saw the Warriors win a close one.
GAME-CHANGERS: The Nuggets were led by Nikola Jokić who had 23 points, 12 rebounds and nine assists ... Monte Morris added 19 points and five rebounds ... The Warriors were led by Steph Curry who had 34 points and nine rebounds.

## NUGGETS TAKE GAME 4

It hasn't been an ideal start to the series for the Nuggets dropping the first three games but they were able to get on the board with their first victory, defeating the Warriors $126-121$ in game four at Ball Arena. Denver was led by the trio of Monte Morris, Nikola Jokic and Bones Hyland who showed out for the home crowd to try and climb back into the series. A few notes from the win:

- Morris registered a playoff season-high 24 points (7-11 FG, 5-7 3FG, 5-5 FT), two rebounds and five assists in 29 minutes.
- Morris is the 12th player in the NBA since 1997 to make $5+$ three-pointers in a single quarter. Three of the last four players to do it have been Nuggets (Morris, Murray and Jokic).
- Hyland went 5-10 from the field and 3-6 from deep, recording playoff career-highs in points (15), rebounds (4), assists (7), minutes (20), field goals (5) and threepointers (3). He also became the second rookie (Scottie Barnes) in these playoffs with $15+$ points, $4+$ rebounds and $7+$ assists.
- Jokic finished with a playoff season-high tying 37 points (14-21 FG, 3-5 3FG, 6-6 FT), eight rebounds and a playoff season-high tying six assists in a playoff season-high tying 38 minutes.
- Jokic is the fourth player ever in the playoffs with $37+$ points, $8+$ rebounds and $6+$ assists while shooting $67 \%$ or better from the field. It was his 12 th playoff game with at least $30 / 8 / 5$, the most such games by any player since 2019.
- The Nuggets shot $56.3 \%$ ( $41-73$ FG) from the field, their highest FG\% since 2010 and ninth best in postseason franchise history.
- Denver made a playoff season-high 15 three-pointers, tied for the seventh most in the team's playoff history.


## SHOWDOWN WITH GOLDEN STATE

The Nuggets are back in the playoffs, finishing with a 48 -34 record and the sixth seed in the Western Conference, lining them up with a showdown in San Francisco against the Golden State Warriors. This marks the fourth straight year Denver as made the playoffs, making them one of two teams in the Western Conference to appear in the playoffs the last four seasons.

Denver and Golden State have matched up only one time in the playoffs coming in 2013 , when the seeds were flipped, and the Nuggets were third while the Warriors were sixth. Despite the Nuggets winning game one at home, Golden State would go on to win the series 4-2.

## PLAYOFFS CLINCHED

With the Nuggets controlling their own destiny and only needing one win to clinch a playoff berth, Denver answered the bell, defeating the Memphis Grizzlies 122-109 on 4/7. It marked the fourth straight year Denver as made the playoffs and guaranteed they would have the six seed at minimum. The Nuggets shot $55 \%$ from the field, the 11th time this season they have shot $55 \%$ or better (9-2). The last time the Nuggets had that many games shooting $55 \%$ or more was in the 1994-95 season (13).

## OFFENSE HUMMING

Denver is starting to hit their stride on the offensive end and it couldn't come at a better time as we enter the last week of the season. They took down the Los Angeles Lakers 129-118 on the road on $4 / 3$, winning their $25^{\text {th }}$ road game of the season. It marked their third straight game scoring $125+$ points ( 16 total on the season) and it was their sixth game in the last 10 scoring $120+$ points. They also dished out $30+$ assists for the second straight game.

They are now $20-7$ when handing out $30+$ assists and moved to $27-6$ when shooting above $50 \%$ from the field. The 27 games with 30 or more assists is second in the NBA trailing only the Spurs (30) and the 33 games with at least $50 \%$ FG ranks second to the Suns (36).

## ROAD WARRIORS

The Nuggets have once again made franchise history as they secured their $23^{\text {rd }}$ road win of the season taking down the Charlotte Hornets 113-109 on 3/28. The Nuggets had all five starters score 14+ in the game and outrebounded the Hornets 51-40. Denver now has the third most road victories in the Western Conference with one more road game to play.

## BONES BREAKING OUT

At a time in the season when most rookies are hitting the infamous rookie wall, Bones Hyland seems to be getting stronger and stronger with each game. Bones has been sensational for the Nuggets as of late and helped Denver take down the Los Angeles Clippers on 3/22, snapping their two-game losing streak. Hyland finished with 16 points ( $6-8$ FG, 4-6 3FG), two rebounds and three assists in just 18 minutes off the bench.

Over seven games, Hyland averaged 16.4 points, 4.6 assists and 3.3 rebounds while
shooting $51.9 \%$ from the field and $50.0 \%$ from three in 23.9 minutes. Bones has also surpassed Jamal Murray's franchise record for most three's in a rookie season and he leads the NBA with the most 4+ three-point games (12) this season among rookies.

## STARTING TO ROLL....

The Nuggets are starting to find their stride as the season ramps up and playoff positioning begins. Denver took down Sacramento Kings 106-100 on the road on 3/9, winning their third game in four nights and it marked their 10th win in the last 11 games. In those 11 games, the Nuggets are averaging 119.4 points on $49.3 \%$ shooting, 28.7 assists per game, 26.9 free throw attempts a game and have a +7.0-score differential. If you go back further, to January $23^{\text {rd }}$, the Nuggets are 17-5 which marks the third best record in the NBA in that span (Celtics 17-3, Suns 16-4).

## THREE POINT KING THRILL

Will Barton is the longest tenured Nugget on the roster, spending eight seasons in Denver and he has certainly left his mark on the franchise. Barton has gone from a second-round draft pick who was knocked for his jumper to becoming the Nuggets all-time leader in three-point field goals. Barton is just the second player in team history to eclipse 700+ threes in a career.

## VINTAGE COUSINS

The Nuggets were without Nikola Jokić due to a non-covid illness for their home matchup against the Houston Rockets on $3 / 4$ and DeMarcus Cousins stepped in and played his best game in a Nuggets uniform. Boogie posted a season-high 31 points ( $10-14$ FG, $3-43$ FG, $8-9 \mathrm{FT}$ ), nine rebounds, four assists and three steals in just 24 minutes, leading the Nuggets to a 116-101 win. His 31 points in 24 minutes, were the fewest minutes in a $30+$ point game in Nuggets NBA franchise history and the third fewest minutes played in a $30+$ point game in his career. Some other highlights from his big night:

- Third career game recording 30 points in 35 minutes or fewer, matching Freeman Williams for the most such games in the shot clock era (since 1954-55).
- 11 th career game with $31+$ points, $9+$ rebounds, $4+$ assists and $3+$ steals.
- Scored $30+$ points for the first time since $1 / 22 / 18$ vs. CHI.
- Made a season-high 10 FGs and a season-high three 3FGs.


## BOOGIE ON DOWN

DeMarcus Cousins time with the Nuggets has become exactly what the team was looking for to help solidify their second unit. The big man signed for the remainder of the season on $2 / 25$ and then dominated the Trail Blazers bench on $2 / 27$, finishing with 19 points on $7-10$ shooting, eight rebounds, six assists and one steal in just 18 minutes, helping the Nuggets win 124-92. He is the only NBA player in the last 35 seasons to post those numbers while playing 20 minutes or less.

Additionally, the Nuggets have won 11 of 12 games when Cousins sees the court to begin his stint in Denver. In those 12 games for Denver, he is averaging 9.5 points, 6.8 rebounds and 2.0 assists in 14.6 minutes per game.

## MR. 300

The Nuggets and the city of Denver are lucky to have Michael Malone. Malone has helped lead the Nuggets ascension in the Western Conference since taking over in the 2016 and the wins have piled up. With their 128-110 victory over the Sacramento Kings on 2/24, Coach Malone won his $300^{\text {th }}$ game as the Head Coach of the Denver Nuggets, becoming only the third coach in franchise history to have at least 300 wins.

## REBOUNDING = SUCCESS

The Nuggets returned home to Ball Arena in their final home game before the All-Star break and they didn't disappoint the home fans, beating the Orlando Magic 121-111. Denver had all five starters score in double figures, winning 28 of the last 32 games when that has occurred. The Nuggets also outrebounded the Magic 52-42, moving to 22-8 on the season when they outrebound an opponent.

The 52 total rebounds were significant, as it marked the fifth straight game the Nuggets have grabbed $50+$ rebounds (4-1). It is the longest streak with 50+ boards since April 1991 and the second longest all-time in franchise history (six games in a row, done November 1976).

## TRAVELING DEFENSE

The Nuggets have played a Western Conference leading 31 road games as of $2 / 12$ and they added to their win total, taking down the Toronto Raptors 110-109 on February $12^{\text {th }}$. The Nuggets defense held strong in the second half allowing 52 points including a game sealing Nikola Jokić block as time expired. For the game, they held the Raptors to 48.9\% shooting from the field.

Denver is quietly building an impressive road streak, the win against the Raptors marked the $17^{\text {th }}$ road game in which the Nuggets have held their opponent to under $50 \%$ shooting from the field. It marks the second longest streak in franchise history, with the longest stretching 37 games done from 11/30/93-11/11/94.

## TALE OF TWO HALVES

The Nuggets snapped their three-game losing streak with a 124-104 victory over the Brooklyn Nets on $2 / 6$. The story of the game was how the Nuggets flipped in the second half and looked like a new team from the first half. After allowing 75 points in the first half, Denver held Brooklyn to just 29 points in the second half. It was a season-low allowed by Denver in the second half and the first time doing so since 12/9/13 at WAS. It also marked the 11th time in franchise history holding an opponent to 29 or fewer points in the second half.

The Nuggets also handed out 37 assists, their second most this season, and are now $25-9$ when having $25+$ assists and $11-4$ when dishing out $30+$ assists this season.

## FIVE STRAIGHT TO END JANUARY

The Nuggets continued their winning ways on the road on their current six game road trip. Denver took down the Milwaukee Bucks 136-100 on $1 / 30$, winning their fifth straight game. It also marked their fourth straight win on the road, the longest streak since winning six in a row in February/March 2021. The Nuggets made 23 threes in the game, tying for the third most made in team history and hade nine players knock down at least one 3FG. Denver is now 11-0 all time when making at least 20 threes in game.

They also dished out 39 assists, the 40th time in team history with that many (just 11th since 1991, 11-0 in those game). The Nuggets end January with 11 wins, their fourth straight year with 11+ wins in January. In the first 42 years in team history, Denver had a total of 11+ wins in January only six times.

## BENCH GOES, WE GO

It's no coincidence that when the Nuggets bench plays well, that usually means good things. They did exactly that on $1 / 26$ at BKN, helping Denver secure a 124-118 road win. The second unit accounted for 51 points, marking the fifth time this season that the bench has had $50+$ points in game and the third time in last eight games.

Austin Rivers led the way for the second unit, putting up a season-high 25 points on $8-11$ FG's and $7-103 F G$ 's and two steals in 26 minutes. Rivers became the first Nuggets reserve since Will Barton (3/16/17) to make 7+ threes in a game and the first to do so on the road since J.R. Smith in 2010.

## GOING STREAKING

The Nuggets finally have their first extended home stand of the season and so far, they have made the most of it. Denver has opened with three wins against the Trail Blazers Lakers and Clippers. Their shot making and ball movement has been elite, helping them achieve two impressive streaks. Denver made 23 three-pointers on $1 / 15$ vs. LAL, the second most made threes in franchise history. The previous game vs. POR on $1 / 13$, the Nuggets knocked down 21, marking the first time in franchise history Denver has made $20+$ threes in back-to-back games and just the 28th time in NBA history a team has accomplished that feat.

The Nuggets also had a season-high tying 35 assists against the Lakers, followed by 31 assists against the Clippers on $1 / 19$, improving to $9-2$ when handing out $30+$ assists and 19-6 when having $25+$ assists in a game. It also marked the third straight game Denver had 35+ assists, the first time doing that since December 1990

## ONE-OF-ONE

Nikola Jokic has done everything he can this series to help his team and despite a game three loss at home the Joker put up a big stat line. He finished with a playoff seasonhigh 37 points (14-22 FG, 2-3 3FG, 7-9 FT), a playoff season-high 18 rebounds, five assists and a playoff season-high tying three steals in a playoff season-high 38 minutes for his third straight double-double of the postseason.

It was his first career playoff game with $37+$ points, $18+$ rebounds, $5+$ assists and $3+$ steals, joining LeBron James as the only two players in NBA playoff history with those numbers. He is also the first player in franchise history with $35+$ points and $15+$ rebounds in a playoff game.

## PLAYOFF MACHINE

Nikola Jokić played in his $44^{\text {th }}$ career postseason game against the Golden State Warriors in game one at Chase Center on 4/16.
Despite the 123-107 loss, Jokić recorded 25 points (12-25 FG's) 10 rebounds and six assists in 35 minutes. It was his $13^{\text {th }}$ career

game in the playoffs posting at least 25 points, 10 rebounds and five assists, the most games in franchise history.

## CLUB OF HIS OWN

Nikola Jokić has arguably one of the best seasons in NBA history and his stat totals reinforce that statement. Jokić helped the Nuggets clinch a playoff spot with the minimum of a six seed with their win against the Memphis Grizzlies on 4/7. Jokić finished with 35 points ( $16-24 \mathrm{FG}$ ), 16 rebounds, six assists and a season-high five steals in 35 minutes. It was his first career game with $35+$ points, $16+$ rebounds, $6+$ assists and $5+$ steals and became just the fifth player in NBA history to put up those numbers, joining Hakeem Olajuwon, Larry Bird, Kareem Abdul-Jabbar and George McGinnis. Jokić and Karl Malone are the only two players in NBA history to record five straight double-doubles with $35+$ points in each game

Additionally, with the 35 points, Jokić has eclipsed 2,000 points, 1,000 rebounds and 500 assists on the season becoming the FIRST player in NBA history to achieve $2 \mathrm{k} / 1 \mathrm{k} / 500$ in a season.

## 11x PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For the second time this season, Nikola Jokić has been named the NBA Western Conference Player of the Week for games played from Monday $3 / 28$ - Sunday $4 / 3$. Jokić has now earned Western Conference Player of the Week honors 11 times in his career, surpassing Carmelo Anthony for the most in franchise history.

The big man averaged 34.8 points, 17.3 rebounds, 8.5 assists and 2.00 steals while shooting .671 from the field en route to a $3-1$ week. He ranked first in the NBA in total rebounds for the week and among the Western Conference he ranked first in points, first in field goal percentage and third in assists. A few other highlights from his week:

- First Nuggets player with three straight 35+ point games since Carmelo Anthony in 2008.
- First player in franchise history to have three straight games with $35+$ points and $10+$ rebounds.
- Scored $35+$ points on $65 \%$ shooting in three straight games, tied for the longest streak in NBA history (O'Neal, Barkley, Dantley, Chamberlain).


## MARCH MADNESS

Nikola Jokić capped his stellar month of March in typical Joker fashion, finishing with 37 points on 15-19 shooting, 13 rebounds, nine assists, two steals and one block in 36 minutes at IND on $3 / 30$, helping Denver move into the fifth seed in the Western Conference.

The month was an historic one for Jokić as he led (or co-led) the Nuggets in points, rebounds and assists in 13 of 15 games. It is the most such games in a calendar month by any player in the shot-clock era. As well, he ranked in the top-10 across the NBA in points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks to become the first player since Kareem Abdul-Jabbar in March 1976 to be top-10 in all five categories.

## CONSTANTLY CONSISTENT

As the Nuggets enter the final stretch of the season, they earned a hardfought home win over the Oklahoma City Thunder 113-107 on 3/26. Nikola Jokić put on a masterful performance, registering 35 points (13-15 FG, 9-10 FT), 12 rebounds, eight assists and two blocks in 35 minutes for his league leading 60th double-double of the year. It was his third straight game attempting $10+$ free throws, tied for the longest such streak in his career (three

Jokić also added to his total number of games with $20+$ points, $10+$ rebounds and $5+$ assists this season. He now sits at 47, ranking him fourth all-time in NBA history for must such games in a season. Only five players in NBA history have totaled over 40 games in a season (Robertson, Chamberlain, Abdul-Jabbar, Westbrook, Jokić).

## $10 \mathrm{~K} / 5 \mathrm{~K} / 3 \mathrm{~K}$

Nikola Jokić's career milestones continue to grow and grow. The Joker posted 29 points ( $10-14$ FGs, 7-7 FTs), 13 rebounds, eight assists and two steals in just 26 minutes at WAS on $3 / 16$. It marked his $50^{\text {th }}$ game this season with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds, the most the NBA has seen in a season since 2013-14 (Kevin Love). Jokić eclipsed 10,000 points, 5,000 rebounds and 3,000 assists in his $516^{\text {th }}$ career game. He becomes the second fastest player in NBA history to reach 10,000 points, 5,000 rebounds and 3,000 assists, in just one game more than Larry Bird.

## VIDEO GAME LIKE NUMBERS

Nikola Jokić might be on one of the most impressive streaks of his career as the season ramps up towards the playoff push. With a tough stretch of three games in four nights the NBA's MVP stepped up and did everything he could to lead the Nuggets to a 3-0 record and 10 wins in their last 11 games.

In that three-game span, the Joker totaled 116 points, 45 rebounds and 31 assists, becoming the only player in NBA history to reach those numbers over three games. If you break it down, he averaged 38.7 points on $68.3 \%$ shooting from the field and $42.9 \%$ from three, 15.0 rebounds, 10.3 assists, 2.3 blocks and 1.3 steals in 37.4 minutes per game.

## CLIMBING TOWARDS WILT

Wilt Chamberlain and Nikola Jokić seem to have their name next to each other in several historical categories and that continues with the NBA's all-time triple double list. The Joker posted 32 points (12-17 FGs, $8-14 \mathrm{FTs}$ ), 15 rebounds and 13 assists in 35 minutes vs. GSW on $3 / 7$ for his second straight triple double and a league leading fourth since the all-star break. Jokić's 75 career triple doubles are closing in

## MVP PERFORMANCE

It was one of those nights at Ball Arena on $3 / 6$ against the New Orleans Pelicans, where Nikola Jokić was once again the best player in the world. With his team trailing late in the game, Jokić took over, scoring 30 points in the fourth quarter and overtime to will the Nuggets to a 138-130 victory. Jokić finished with 46 points (16-22 FG, 3-5 3FG, 11-12 FT), 12 rebounds, 11 assists, three steals and a season-high tying four blocks in a season-high 43 minutes for his league leading 17th triple-double of the year.

He becomes the first player in NBA history with 46+ points, $12+$ rebounds, $11+$ assists, $3+$ steals and $4+$ blocks in a game. Jokić has now put up 45/10/10 twice this season, with no other player having done it once this year. A few other notes from the big night:

- Is the seventh player (Harden, Westbrook, Chamberlain, Baylor, Bird and Robertson) in NBA history with multiple 45/10/10 games in their career.
- Jokić is the first player since Kobe Bryant in 2007 to record $30+$ points in the fourth quarter and OT and shoot $80 \%$ or better from the field.
- His 17 th triple-double, Jokić now stands alone with the most single season triple-doubles in franchise history.
- Joins Wilt Chamberlain as the only two players in NBA history with a $45+$ point triple double on $70 \%$ shooting.


## NUGGETS TRIPLE DOUBLE KING

Nikola Jokić continues to torment the Western Conference as he had another all-time performance against the New Orleans Pelicans on 3/6. Jokić registered 46 points ( $16-22$ FG, $3-53$ FG, 11-12 FT), 12 rebounds, 11 assists, three steals and a season-high tying four blocks in a season-high 43 minutes for his league leading 17th triple-double of the year. With his 17th triple-double, Jokić now stands alone with the most single season triple-doubles in franchise history.

The big man just missed a triple double, finishing with 25 points, 12 rebounds, nine assists and four steals in 34 minutes. Jokić has now had $20+$ points, $10+$ rebounds and $5+$ assists in nine straight games, tying the third longest streak with those numbers in NBA history.

## JOKER AND THE STILT

Snapping their three-game losing streak was the goal as the Nuggets took on the Brooklyn Nets on 2/6 and they did exactly that, winning 124-104. Nikola Jokić registered 27 points (12-15 FG), 12 rebounds, 10 assists and two steals in 30 minutes for his league leading 14th triple-double of the year. With his 12 made field goals, Jokić passed Byron Beck for sixth all-time in franchise history in total made field goals $(3,684)$ and the Nuggets are now 54-17 all-time and $34-8$ in home games when Jokić has a triple double.

Jokić also joins Wilt Chamberlain as the only players in NBA history with multiple $\mathbf{2 5 +}$ point triple doubles on $80 \%$ shooting. As well, Joker now trails Chamberlain by only seven for the most triple doubles by a center in NBA history.

## JANUARY TO REMEMBER

Nikola Jokić had one of the best months of his career in January and was rewarded for the stellar play. He was named the Western Conference Player of the Month on February $2^{\text {nd }}$ for games played in January, winning the award for the first time this season and the third time in his career, tying Carmelo Anthony and Alex English for most Player of the Month honors in franchise history.
Jokic averaged 26.6 points, 13.2 rebounds, 9.0 assists and 1.43 steals while shooting .601 from the field, .431 from three-point range and .880 from the charity stripe in 16 games. He helped lead the Nuggets to an 11-5 record in the month, including a season-long five-game winning streak.

He also recorded seven triple-doubles in January and is one of just five players in NBA history to have seven-or-more in a single month (Westbrook, Robertson, Chamberlain, Jordan). He registered two 20-point/20-rebound games, had a double-double in 15 games and scored $25+$ points in seven straight, the longest streak by a Nugget since Anthony in 2010. For the month, Jokić ranked first in the NBA in total rebounds, second in assists, third in total points and third in field goals made.

## Playoff Record: 21-26

Michael Malone enters his seventh season as head coach of the Denver Nuggets. He was named the 16th head coach in Denver's NBA franchise history on June 15, 2015 and currently ranks third all-time amongst Nuggets head coaches with 314 wins.

Last season saw Coach Malone lead the Nuggets to a 47-25 record in a 72-game shortened season as they clinched a playoff berth for the third straight year. Denver finished the season tying a franchise record with 22 road wins, securing the third seed in the Western Conference and became the only team in the NBA to have home court advantage in the playoffs in each of the last three seasons.

In the playoffs, despite missing Jamal Murray due to injury, Malone helped lead the Nuggets to a 4-2 first round series victory over the Portland Trail Blazers. It was a historic series win for Denver as they won a playoff series in three straight seasons for the first time in franchise history. It marked the fourth playoff series win in the ast three seasons, after winning a total of four in the last 32 years. It was also the first time in Nuggets history they clinched a best of seven series on the road (excluding the bubble).

Since Malone has taken over prior to the 2015-16 season, the Nuggets have seen the postseason on three occasions including a Western Conference Finals appearance in 2020, the first for the franchise since 2009. The Nuggets are also second in the NBA, trailing only the Milwaukee Bucks for the most combined regular season and postseason wins in a three-year span with 167 . Malone has totaled 20 postseason wins, sitting fourth all-time in franchise history trailing Doug Moe by four for first.

Malone has 305 victories as an NBA head coach and possesses over 24 years of coaching experience, 20 coming in the NBA with six different teams - New York, Cleveland, New Orleans, Golden State, Sacramento and Denver. The teams that Malone has been a member of the coaching staff have amassed 12 playoff appearances, including one NBA Finals showing and three conference finals appearances. Malone and his staff also were selected to coach Team LeBron at the 2019 NBA All-Star game in Charlotte, NC, defeating Team Giannis 178-164.

Before joining the Nuggets, Malone served as the head coach of the Sacramento Kings for two seasons. Before his time with the Kings, Malone was the lead assistant for the Golden State Warriors under Mark Jackson from 2011-13 where they clinched a postseason berth in 2013, their first since 2007

Prior to Golden State, Malone worked as the lead assistant to Monty Williams in New Orleans and helped the Hornets achieve a 46 - 36 record and a trip to the 2011 NBA Playoffs. The Hornets were the most improved defensive team in the NBA in 2011, allowing a league-best 8.7 fewer points per game than in the previous campaign (94.0 ppg, after giving up 102.7 ppg in 2009-10).

Malone also served as an assistant coach under Mike Brown for the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons, during which the Cavs posted a $272-138$ (.663) record, the third-best mark in the NBA over that span. The Cavaliers made five consecutive playoff appearances during Malone's time on the bench, reaching the NBA Finals in 2007 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2009. In 2008-09, the Cavs notched a franchise record and NBA-best 66 wins, with Malone and the rest of the team's staff earning the right to coach the Eastern Conference All-Star squad. In 2009-10, the Cavaliers again captured the league's best regular season record with 61 wins.

Malone's NBA coaching career began with a four-season stint with the New York Knicks, where he originally joined Jeff Van Gundy's staff as a coaching associate in the summer of 2001, and was promoted to assistant coach in May 2003.

Before joining the NBA, Malone coached seven years in the college ranks, with his last stop coming at Manhattan College where he was the lead assistant. During the 1998-99 season Malone worked at the University of Virginia as its director of men's basketball administration. Malone also spent three seasons (1995-96 - 1997-98) at Providence College under New York Basketball Hall of Fame coach Pete Gillen after beginning his coaching career working for Greg Kampe at Oakland University in Michigan.

Malone is a three-time participant in the NBA's "Basketball Without Borders" program, having coached at the league's global outreach camps in Africa (2017), Puerto Rico (2006) and Argentina (2005). In 2017 Malone traveled to Johannesburg, South Africa where he spent a week coaching at the BWB camps and then served as an assistant coach for Team Africa, for the NBA Africa Game 2017.

Malone also served as an assistant coach for the Canadian Men's Senior National Team for three years. He helped guide the Canadian team to a top-four finish in the 2009 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico, qualifying Canada for the 2010 World Championships

A native of Queens, New York, Malone played college basketball at Loyola College in Maryland, where he graduated with a BA degree in 1994. He is a graduate of New Jersey's Seton Hall Prep where he played two years under Bob Farrell. Malone also played a season under Tom Blackburn at Worcester Academy (Mass.).

Michael is the son of longtime NBA coach Brendan Malone, who has coached over 28 years in the league. He
and his wife, Jocelyn, have two daughters, Caitlin and Bridget.
