## Size:

S (M, L, XL) for bust measurements 32 (36, 40, 44), to fit with 3-5 in. positive ease. If a snug fit is desired, make one size smaller.

## Materials:

- Cascade Yarns ${ }^{\circledR}$

Pacific ${ }^{\circledR}$ Chunky Color Wave
60\% Acrylic /
40\% Superwash Merino Wool

- $100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz}) /$ $120 \mathrm{yds}(110 \mathrm{~m})$
- $7(8,10,11)$ skeins of color \#41 (Grapevine)
- Crochet hook size J ( 5.5 mm )
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Needle and black thread
- \#6 $(6,7,7)$ sew-on frogs, black,
$7 \times 3 \mathrm{~cm}$ size


Gauge:
10 dc sts x 6 rows $=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ Blocked

## Special Stitches:

V stitch (V st) Pattern Stitch:
Directions: (dc, ch 1, dc) in specified st or sp

## Cluster (cl) Pattern Stitch:

Directions: Work 2 tr in specified st, retaining last lp of each tr on hook, draw new Ip through all 3 lps on hook

Double Crochet 2 Together (dc2tog) Pattern Stitch:
Directions: (Dc in specified st, retaining last lp of dc on hook) twice, draw new lp through all 3 lps on hook.

Pattern Notes:
Coat is worked in rows from the neck edge down, with raglan sleeve shaping and one round of edging to finish edges and create collar.
Always join a new skein at the beginning or end of a row. First ch 3 counts as first dc throughout.

## Begin Pattern:

Neck and Yoke

Ch 98
Row 1: V st in 6th ch from hook (first 6 chs counts as first dc and 2 chs), sk 2 chs, dc in next ch, (sk next 2 chs, $V$ st in next ch, sk 2 chs, dc in next ch) across; ch 3, turn. 16 V sts, 17 dc

Row 2: (V st in V st, dc in next dc) twice, (V st, dc, V st) in next $V$ st, * (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) twice, dc in next dc, (V st, dc, V st) in next V st, * (dc in next dc, V st in next V st) 4 times, dc in next dc, (V st, dc, V st)
in next V st, rep between *s, (dc in next dc, V st in next V st) twice, dc in last dc; ch 3 , turn. 20 V sts

Row 3: $V$ st in each $V$ st and dc in each dc across; ch 3, turn.
Row 4: (V st in V st, dc in next dc) twice, * V st in next V st, (dc, V st, dc) in next dc, * (V st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 3 times, $V$ st in next $V$ st, ( $d c, V$ st, dc) in next dc, * ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 5 times, rep between ${ }^{*}$, ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 3 times; ch 3, turn. 24 V sts

## Row 5: Rep row 3.

Row 6: ( $V$ st in $V$ st, dc in next dc) 3 times, * ( $V$ st, dc, $V$ st) in next $V$ st, ( $d c$ in next $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{V}$ st in next $V$ st) 4 times, dc in next dc, ( $V$ st, dc, $V$ st) in next $V$ st, * (dc in next $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{V}$ st in next V st) 6 times, dc in next dc, rep between ${ }^{*} \mathrm{~s}$, (dc in next dc, V st in next V st) 3 times, dc in last dc; ch 3, turn. 28 V sts

Row 7: Rep row 3.
Row 8: ( $V$ st in $V$ st, dc in next dc) 3 times, * V st in next $V$ st, (dc, $V$ st, dc) in next dc, (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 5 times, $V$ st in next $V$ st, (dc, $V$ st, $d c$ ) in next dc, * ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 7 times, rep between *s, ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 4 times; ch 3 , turn. 32 V sts

Row 9: Rep row 3.
Row 10: (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 4 times, * (V st, dc, V st) in next V st, (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) 6 times, dc in next dc, (V st, dc, V st) in next $V$ st, * (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) 8 times, dc in next dc, rep between *s, (dc in next dc, V st in next $V$ st) 4 times, dc in last dc; ch 3, turn. 36 V sts

Row 11: Rep row 3.
Row 12: ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 4 times, * $V$ st in next $V$ st, ( $d c, V$ st, $d c$ ) in next dc, (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 7 times, $V$ st in next $V$ st, (dc, $V$ st, dc) in next dc, * (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 9 times, rep between *s, (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 5 times; ch 3 , turn. 40 V sts

Row 13: Rep row 3.
Row 14: ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 5 times, * ( $V$ st, dc - mark this dc, $V$ st) in next $V$ st, (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) 8 times, dc in next dc, (V st, dc - mark this $d c, V$ st) in next $V$ st,* (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) 10 times, dc in next dc, rep between ${ }^{*}$ s, (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) 5 times, dc in last dc; ch 3, turn. 44 V sts

Sizes M (L, XL) Only:
Row 15: Rep row 3.
Row 16: ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 5 times, *V st in next $V$ st, (dc, $V$ st - mark this $V$ st, dc) in next dc, ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 9 times, $V$ st in next $V$ st, (dc, V st - mark this $V$ st, dc) in next dc, * (V st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 11 times, rep between *s, (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 6 times; ch 3, turn. 48 V sts

## Sizes L (XL) Only:

Row 17: Rep row 3.
Row 18: ( $V$ st in next V st, dc in next dc) 6 times, * ( V st, dc - mark this $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{V}$ st) in next $V$ st, (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) 10 times, dc in next dc, ( $V$ st, dc - mark this dc, V st) in next V st, * (dc in next dc, V st in next V st) 12 times, dc in next dc, rep between ${ }^{*}$ s, (dc in next dc, V st in next V st) 6 times, dc in last dc; ch 3, turn. 52 V sts

## Size XL Only:

Row 19: Rep row 3.
Row 20: ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 6 times, *V st in next $V$ st, ( $d c, V$ st - mark this $V$ st, dc) in next dc, ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) 11 times, $V$ st in next $V$ st, (dc, V st - mark this $V$ st, dc) in next dc, * (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 13 times, rep between *s, (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) 7 times; ch 3, turn. 56 V sts

## Size S (L) Sleeve Shaping Row

(V st in next V st, dc in next dc) across to marked dc, ch 11, sk 10 (12) V sts, (dc in next dc, V st in next V st) across to marked dc, dc in marked dc, ch 11, sk 10 (12) V sts, (dc in next dc, $V$ st in next $V$ st) across to end, dc in last dc; ch 3, turn. 24 (28) V sts

## Size M (XL) Sleeve Shaping Row

[(V st in next V st, dc in next dc) across to marked V st, V st in marked V st, ch 11, sk 10 (12) V sts, V st in next (marked) V st, (dc in next dc, V st in next V st) across] twice, dc in last dc; ch 3, turn. 28 (32) V sts

## Body

Row 1: [(V st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) across to ch sp, (sk 2 chs, $V$ st in next ch, sk 2 chs, dc in next st) 2 times] twice, ( $V$ st in next $V$ st, dc in next dc) across to end; ch 3 , turn. $28(32,36,40) \mathrm{V}$ sts

Row 2: (V st in next V st, dc in next dc) across; ch 3, turn.
Rows 3-21 (21, 23, 25): Rep row 2.

Row 22 (22, 24, 26) (increase): mark a $V$ st in center of back, ( V st in next V st, dc in next dc) across to marked V st, V st in marked $V$ st, dc in last dc of same $V$ st, $V$ st in next dc, dc in first dc of next $V$ st, ( $V$ st in $V$ st, dc in next dc) across; ch 3, turn. 29 (33, 37, 41) V sts

Rows 23-28 (23-28, 25-30, 27-32): Rep row 26 times.

## Edging

Row 1: Sk first V st, * in next V st work [(cl, ch 2) twice, cl], dc in next $V$ st; rep from * across, but work last dc in last dc instead of last V st; ch 1, turn to work up front opening. 14 (16, 18,20 ) groups of cl

## Circumference Edging and Collar

Hdc evenly up front opening to top edge, work 3 hdc in corner, work 3 more hdc evenly along neck edge, (dc evenly along neck edge, dc2tog opposite from increase) 4 times, dc evenly along remaining neck edge until only approximatly 2 in. remain, work 3 hdc evenly along remaining neck edge, work 3 hdc in corner, hdc evenly down front opening to hem, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner, [sc in next cl, 2 sc in ch sp, (sc, hdc, sc ) in center $\mathrm{cl}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in ch sp , sc in cl , sl st in next dc] across hem, sc in next cl, 2 sc in ch sp, (sc, hdc, sc) in center cl, 2 sc in
 ch sp , sc in cl, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner; join with sl st in first hdc. Fasten off.

## Finishing

Join yarn under arm, ch 1, hdc evenly around opening. Rep for other arm. Weave in ends; block. With needle and black thread, sew frogs on either side of front opening, evenly spaced from neck edge to waist.
