

DAD-COS Requirements Division in coordination with the Office of the Joint Staff Surgeon, synchronizes requirements and capabilities across DHA to deliver joint integrated solutions to the Combatant Commands (CCMDs) and Services for the 21st Century Battlespace.

Key Functions/Capabilities

- Management of DHA operational capabilities through the Joint Capabilities Integration and Development System (JCIDS) and Business Capability Acquisition Cycle Process (BCAC)
- Responsible for the establishment of Agency-level guidelines, policies, and procedures for defining, documenting, coordinating, and managing DHA operational capabilities through JCIDS
- Manages DHA participation in JCIDS activities, workshops, and related actions to ensure compliance with responsibilities outlined in DoDD 3000.06
- Advocates DHA position at Health Services Working Group (HSWG)
- Advocates DHA position at Deputy Medical Operations Working Group


