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Ways to Protect your Digital Footprint

- Honor age restrictions on websites
- Know that nothing is private online
- Assume everyone is watching
- Apply the "Golden Rule"
- Watch the clock - In other words, don't live your whole life online, get out and do something!
- Choose wisely - not everything online is good for you
- Don't hide behind your screen name
- Think about what you see - don't believe everything you see online

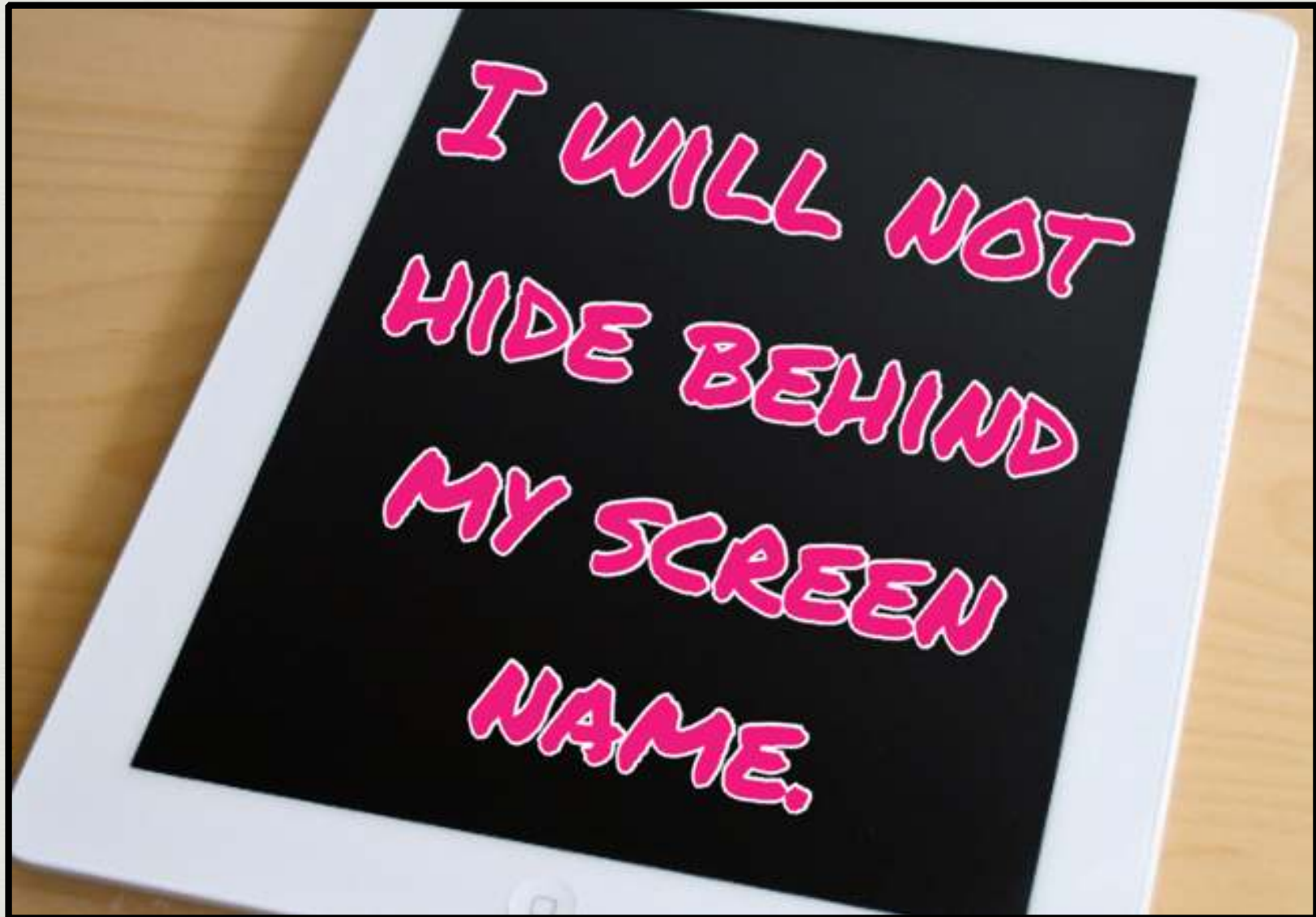
