
What is an e-book?

What do you do with e-text?

- Have it read out loud by the computer
- Magnify it, change the font, change the colors, increase the spacing between lines
- Use electronic highlighters to mark it up
- Insert comments, comprehension supports
- Quickly get the definition of a word
- Quickly search the text for a term

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
Who benefits from etext?

- Students who can't see the text
- Students who can't hold a book and turn the pages independently
- Students who can comprehend text when read to them that they can't decode by themselves

- Students who have difficulty tracking text
- Students who get distracted while reading
- Students who need extra supports to understand the text (thinking questions, vocabulary highlighted, "text attack strategies")
- Students who are still learning English



Why use digital text instead of human readers?

- No worry of getting extra hints
- Consistent presentation
- Don't need extra staff
- Kids can read at their own pace
- Kids can have read only the parts that they need
- Kids have access to tools like dictionary, highlighters, embedded supports

Description of Students	Category
Students who can't see the text	Visual Impairments (VI)
Students who can't hold a book and turn the pages independently	Physical Disabilities (PD)
Students who can comprehend text when read to them that they can't decode by themselves	Learning Disabilities (LD)

Teachers are responsible for providing **ALL** students with disabilities access to the general education curriculum




Students with "print disabilities" do not account for all students who need digital text
