WELCOME

Welcome to the opening production of our Senior Company's Fifth Anniversary Season. It is not new for OVATIONS to bring shows to our young people that relate to what is actually going on in their lives. Spring Awakening once again allows OVATIONS students to be able to explore mature material in a safe space allowing them to have very open and frank conversations that for young people are often skirted around or all together ignored. During our process we've been able to discuss and explore some of the darker themes found in the material: teen suicide, sexual abuse, teen pregnancy, sexual exploration, to name just a few. As a company we were able to talk about

resources and options available to our students and those they know who deal with these issues. What is astounding is that these themes and circumstances are as prevalent today as they were back in the 1800s when the original text was written for this piece. What

I admire about this show is that it was not written to be edgy or to make audiences uncomfortable with teenage angst but rather to really open a dialogue about how consequences of censoring young people from knowledge can be detrimental to their development.

When students are being threatened and punished for speaking out for what is right, OVATIONS takes seriously the responsibility to provide a safe place where young people can hone their voice and actually be heard. It is a strange reality we live

in that our society thinks of young people as children until the age of 18 when magically they are adults.

"When you know better you do better; or you should at least try."

Exploring ideas of identity, community, sexuality and acceptance, Spring Awakening remains relevant as ever, as it examines what it means to be a young person in a changing world. The need for Knowledge is really the heart of our story. The show is set in a Victorian library where knowledge is everywhere around the students yet oddly hard to obtain. The show focuses on how knowledge was filtered to the students from the governing

adults providing them with only what they deemed appropriate.

This show, especially in the current polarizing society, continually challenges me about how I treat and communicate with young people. Our hope for this production is that our community leaves understanding that young people are hungry for knowledge- thirsty to be a part of our society- and desperate to have a voice. Unlike the characters in the script, our students are living in a time and a society where the access to knowledge and availability to have open conversations about tough subjects is available and happening. Our kids are empowered to speak out, question and seek understanding and put into action their efforts to leave this earth a little better than they found it. I am thankful to know that I have students who are truly thinking about the future and how their story will affect others for many years to come.

Spring Awakening is a production showing the inside of things most people are too scared to talk about. Set in 19th century Germany, it was a time when the only people who could receive information were parents and teachers, and children were commonly completely sheltered from harsh realities. There was no internet to let teenagers know that what they were going through was normal. During this show, teenagers learn to question authority and discover things their parents kept from them. Spring Awakening focuses on subjects such as suicide, sexual abuse and abortion; and learning to break free from society's standards.
