Blue Sky Bridge

Located in Boulder, Colorado, Blue Sky Bridge fosters safe communities, healing and justice to end child abuse. We are a nonprofit organization that uses the Child Advocacy Center model to create a child-focused approach to abuse investigations in partnership with law enforcement, social services and the District Attorney's office. All of our programs are offered free of cost. In the past 25 years, we have supported more than 10,000 children and family members.

Our programs include:

Child Advocacy

Blue Sky Bridge provides immediate intervention, skilled forensic interviews, crisis intervention counseling, family support and follow-up services to child victims of abuse and non-offending family members, including medical treatment, if necessary. Of the children interviewed in a recent year, 78% were related to allegations of child sexual abuse and 72% identified as female. 52% of the children were between the ages of 9 and 15 years.

Therapy

Blue Sky Bridge offers Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) and Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) for children ages 4-17. The aim of this program is to reduce trauma symptoms, strengthen the parent-child relationship and support the entire family in moving forward. 100% of the therapy clients who graduated from the program in a recent year reduced their trauma symptoms.

Education and Outreach

We are committed to helping children recognize situations that may be unsafe and how to seek help. We are also dedicated to helping adults learn how to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. We accomplish these commitments through a variety of in-school trainings for kindergarten and 3rd grade students, as well as adult education. Blue Sky Bridge is in 38 schools and 144 classrooms, reaching more than 3,000 students and 1,000 adults annually.

- Confidently work with the Executive Director and Board of Directors to think creatively and act boldly as we position Blue Sky Bridge for its next phase of growth and evolution and make a greater impact on the cause.

- Professionalize our fundraising systems and infrastructure to support efficiencies, sustainability and growth. This will include a migration to a new CRM and creating new systems that are helpful for prioritizing work, tracking and dashboard reporting.

Director of Development and Communications

We are looking for a strategic thinker who is aligned with the values of the organization who can translate our work to a broad audience to further engagement. As a key member of the Executive Director's direct reports, you will serve as a valued team member and thought leader who will help to guide our mission internally and represent us to the public. Specific responsibilities of the role include:

Fundraising − (80%)

- a. Oversee an annual fundraising program of \$1.5 million generated by our two signature events, individual appeals, private foundation grants, corporate sponsorship and grants, third-party and government support. This includes planning, executing and reporting.
- b. Work with the Executive Director and Board of Directors to create a plan to increase revenue in support of new programs and initiatives. Fundraising results

- have been strong over the past five years and will need to continue on this growth trajectory.
- c. Work with a consultant partner to execute the grants program (the Executive Director is involved with several large grants).
- d. Staff the Development Committee of the Board of Directors and event committees (the development associate takes the lead on the By the Glass event).
- e. Expand our non-event related individual giving program beyond three appeals a year to create a more textured and robust initiative.
- f. Expand corporate giving beyond sponsorship.
- g. Expand our major gifts program with a focus on individual giving plans over multiple years that results in an increased standard of giving overall.
- h. Transform the systems, records, information tracking, reporting and gift acknowledgment processes that are in place (with help from an outside consultant as needed).

II. Communications – (20%)

- a. Oversee organization-wide communications working from an annual plan that supports a multi-year strategic plan, including, but not limited to:
 - Developing online and print communications materials, including the Annual Report. The Development and Communications Associate plays a key role in executing communications across platforms.
 - ii. Handling public relations, including sending press releases, responding to inquiries and offering interviews to the media.
 - iii. Creating informational materials for community engagement, agency tours and event sponsorships.
 - iv. Maintaining the website and communicating via social media.
 - v. Building and strengthening the Blue Sky Bridge Brand.

Our Director of Development and Communications will be a proficient fundraiser with 7-10 years of experience and at least 5 years in a role leading and managing others. A bachelor's degree is required, and a master's degree or advanced certification is preferred.
