If you're looking for a thrill, try dropping into a halfpipe at the SLO Skate Park.










Mission San Luis Obispo de Tolosa

Traverse to the heart of SLO to explore one of the city's gems: Mission San Luis Obispo de Tolosa. Founded in 1772 by Junipero Serra, the landmark is much more than a Catholic church. Residents and visitors enjoy Friday night concerts in Mission Plaza during the summer, and the plaza attracts thousands of people each year for dozens of community events.

Hearst Castle

Travel up Highway 1 a bit to the mansion of the late William Randolph Hearst, perched atop a mountain on the San Simeon coast. Hearst Castle was designed by architect Julia Morgan.








Farmers' Markets
