










DRAW A DINOSAUR!




HANDMADE CARDS

The next time you want to wish someone a happy birthday, instead of buying them a card, make one. You can design the card to look exactly how you like, and, because you made it, it will be extra special!






1. Draw a line in pencil on a square piece of paper 1in from the top. Cut strips every 1in along the bottom, toward the line.




2. Cut 1in wide strips from a different color of paper. Thread them over and under the strips, making a weave.




3. Continue weaving until you have a checkerboard pattern. Glue the flaps at the edge to secure them.




4. Fold a larger piece of paper in half twice and then unfold it so it looks like this. Cut out a shape in the bottom right-hand corner.




5. Glue your checkerboard pattern to the back side of the solid colored paper so that it shows through the cut-out shape.



6. Fold the paper again to make a square. Now all you need to do is write your message inside.








FIND THE SNAKES

You will need


- Inkpad or paints

2. Wait until the ink has dried and draw on details (arms, legs, and eyes) to transform the prints into characters. Add speech bubbles, too.








LABEL YOUR PLANTS

Summer is the perfect time to grow your own plants! Add some color and personalize them by making one or more of these different markers and labels for your pot!








Stone markers
