Renewal Adoption Access— Year 2-6

Your initial adoption access was most likely via a pin code card attached to this manual. The teacher access is good for the entire length of the adoption. The initial student access was provided via a single generic code (I per 50 students) and must be renewed each year (for your new class) and we now offer a simpler system for that.

Pearson has an automated self-service system to provide this "coming year" access. This system is updated and live to registered teachers May 15 of each year. Teachers will need their current MyLab/Mastering user name/password or the email address from initial registration to use this system.



Downloading Resources
