

Cranberry Pumpkin Bread



This Recipe was submitted by Peter Brawley

Prep: 20 minutes

Bake: 70 minutes & cooling Makes 2 loaves (16slices each)

Quote from a lady named Dixie Terry, Goreville, IL: Put leftover cranberries and pumpkin to great use in the moist quick bread. It's very good with my secondhand turkey casserole for an after-Thanksgiving meal.

Ingredients:

- 3 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 3 cups sugar
- 4 teaspoons Pumpkin pie spice
- 2 teaspoons Baking soda
- 1 teaspoon Salt
- 4 large eggs
- 1 can (15 oz.) solid-pack pumpkin
- 1/2 cup canola oil
- 2 cups fresh or frozen cranberries, thawed
- 1 cup chopped walnuts (Peter used pecans)



Directions:

- In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar, pumpkin pie spice, baking soda and salt. In another bowl, whisk the eggs, pumpkin and oil; stir into dry ingredients just until moistened. Fold in cranberries and walnuts.
- Spoon into two greased 9 X 5 in. Loaf pans. Bake at 350 degrees for 70-80 minutes or until a toothpick inserted is in the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pans to wire racks to cool completely.
