



Ideal for financial institutions, it could be used, for example, to provide a functional divider between the main concourse and the self-service area that is usually open 24/7. The impression of space is thus maintained

even outside opening hours. Display rooms, shopping malls, foyers, railway stations and airports all provide scope for further applications. If desired, the individual units may be fabricated from intruder-inhibiting laminated glass or aluminium sections. So as to specifically prevent break-ins or vandalism, both versions are

equipped with security features so that they cannot be pushed up or levered open. Naturally, the entire system has passed all the official tests (e.g. TÜV in Germany) to ensure safety in operation, whilst electronic system monitoring ensures automatic, fault-free operation.




