## Cutting Instructions - Wall Hanging

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Continuous Blocks - Ecru (A), fussy cut:
-(1) $191 / 2 " \times 14 "$ rectangle, centered on the large block.

- (6) 6 " squares, each centered on the small blocks.
-(1) 12 " x 6 " rectangle, centered on the medium block.


## From the Border Stripe - Ecru (B), cut:

-(2) $6 " \times 381 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
From the Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecru (C), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
From the Calico - Navy (D), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 14 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 231 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 " x $6 "$ strips.
- (3) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $2 " \times 9 "$ strips.
- (1) $2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 "$ x $15 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 6 "$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Bud Calico - Ecru (E), cut:

- (1) $81 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips and
(3) $3 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 511 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 431 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 161 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Polish Hen Allover - Black (F), cut:
- (3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 431 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Calico - Red (G), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
- (6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecru (Backing), cut:
-(2) 59 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $59 " \times 70 "$ back.

Block Assembly - Wall Hanging
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the $191 / 2 "$ x $14 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric A large block. Sew (1) 2" x $231 / 2 "$
Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A large block to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure $221 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$.

2. Sew (1)
$13 / 4 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (1) $2 " \times 6 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 6" Fabric A small block. Sew (1) 2" x 9" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small block to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). Trim the block to measure $81 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.


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4. Sew (1) $2 " \times 6 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $12 "$ x $6 "$ Fabric A medium block. Sew (1) 2" x $15 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A medium block to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4). Trim the block to measure $141 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2$ ".

> Trim block to measure D $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ AFTER adding Fabric B borders
5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $61 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C strip to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Block Four rectangle.

6. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 6$ " Fabric D strip to each end of (1) 6 " $\times 381 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " x $401 / 2$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B strip to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.

7. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Five strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block Five strip.

8. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) $51 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 8).
9. Sew (1) Block Four rectangle to each side of the Block One rectangle to make Row Three (Fig. 8).
10. Sew together (4) Block Two squares and (3) 3 " $\times 81 / 2$ " Fabric E strips, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right, to make Row Five (Fig. 8).
11. Sew together Row One, (1) Block Five strip, Row Three, (1) Block Five strip and Row Five, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Wall Hanging Center Block (Fig. 8).

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## Wall Hanging Assembly (Follow the Wall Hanging Layout in Figure 9 while assembling the top.)

12. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 511 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $431 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to each end of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 431 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Wall Hanging top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.

18. Place (1) $21 / 4 "$ Fabric C square on the bottom left corner of (1) 4" Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 "$ away from the sewn seam (Fig. 12).

19. Follow Figure 13 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 4$ " Fabric C square to the lower right corner of the 4" Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 14).
20. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (32) Unit 3 squares total.

21. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures $15-16$ for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (2) Unit 4 squares and (2) Unit 5 squares.

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22. Sew together (4) Unit 3 squares. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of the Runner Center Block (Fig. 17).
23. Sew (12) Unit 3 squares together. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the left end of the newly sewn strip and (1) Unit 5 square to the right end. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block to make the Runner top (Fig. 17).
24. Layer and quilt as desired.
25. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
26. Bind as desired.

## Cutting Instructions - Place Mats

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecru (A), cut:
-(1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
From the Calico - Navy (B), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
From the Bud Calico - Ecru (C), cut:
-(3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Calico - Red (D), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Sheep Allover - Ecru (Backing), cut:
-(2) $22 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $16 "$ x $22 "$ strips.


#### Abstract

Block Assembly - Place Mats Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


27. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 "$ x $121 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Place Mat Center Block (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat Center Blocks.

28. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 19). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 19). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 "$ away from the sewn seam (Fig. 20).
29. Follow Figure 21 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric D square to the lower left corner of the $31 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " Fabric C strip to make (1) Unit 6 rectangle (Fig. 22).
30. Repeat Steps 28-29 to make (24) Unit 6 rectangles total.

31. Sew together (3) Unit 6 rectangles lengthwise. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of (1) Place Mat Center Block to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 23). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

32. Layer and quilt as desired.
33. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal lengths.
34. Bind as desired.

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
