KLEC Compliance Commander, LMPD Training Academy, 2009-2010 – Maintained all curriculum for the LMPD Training Academy, conducted compliance inspections of all certified instructors teaching for the LMPD Training Academy, created curriculum/courses and taught classes at the LMPD Training Academy as well as the DOJT Office located at the University of Louisville Shelby Campus, supervised all civilian staff at the LMPD Training Academy (4) and took part in all KLEC meetings as the LMPD representative for those meetings.
