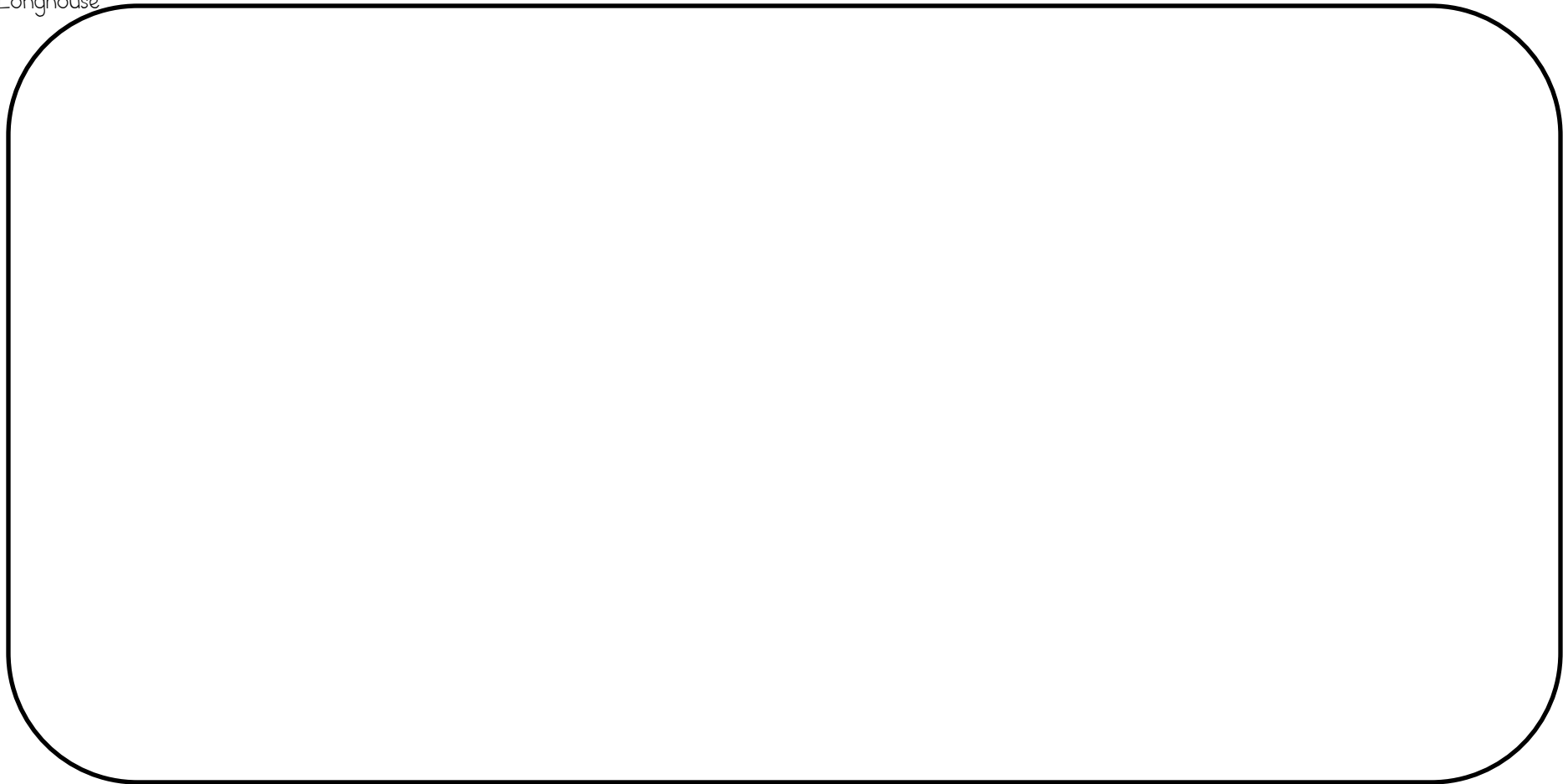




The Ojibway lived in forests. There were rivers and lakes. They traveled in canoes. Their canoes were made of bark.

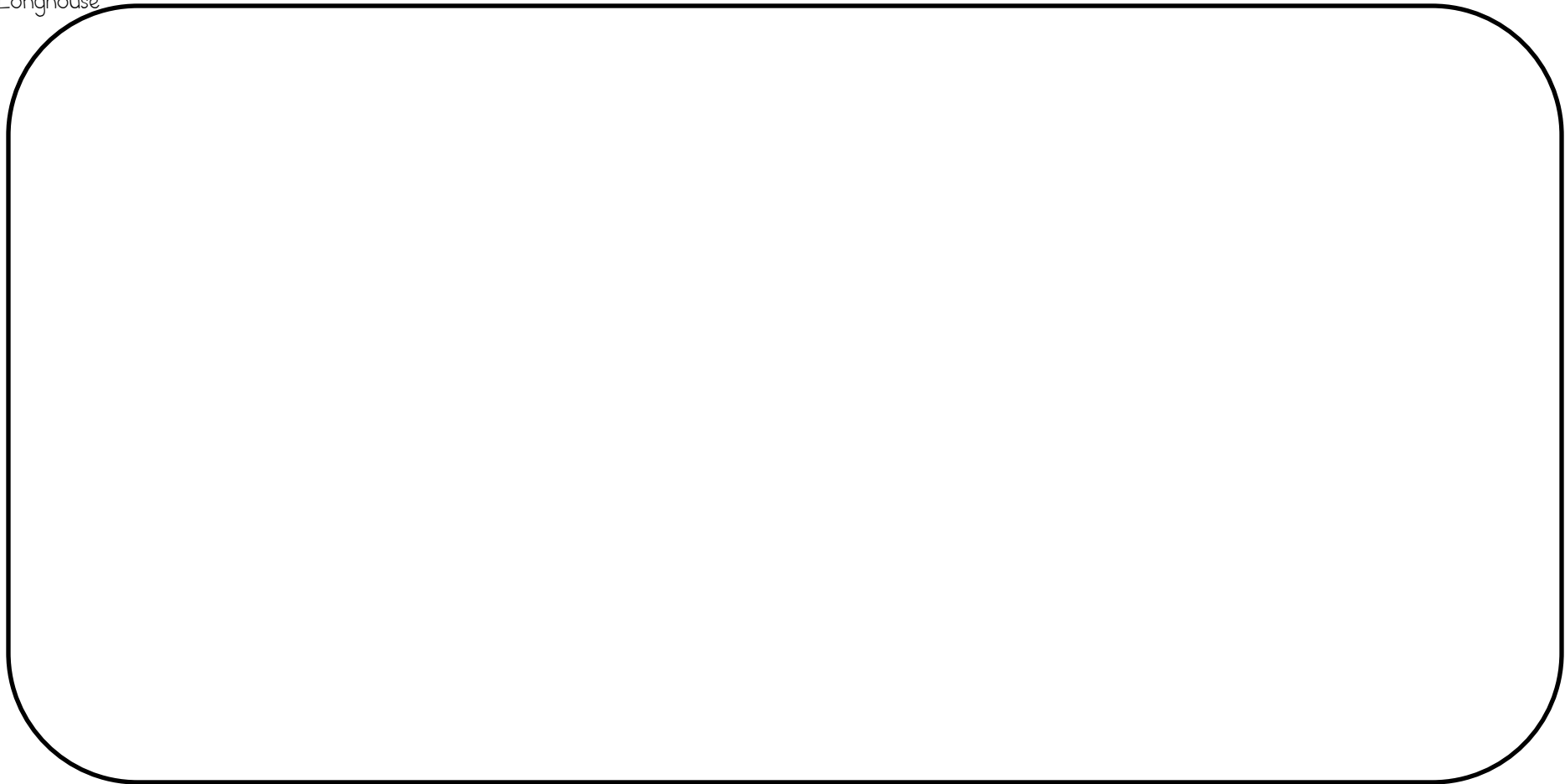

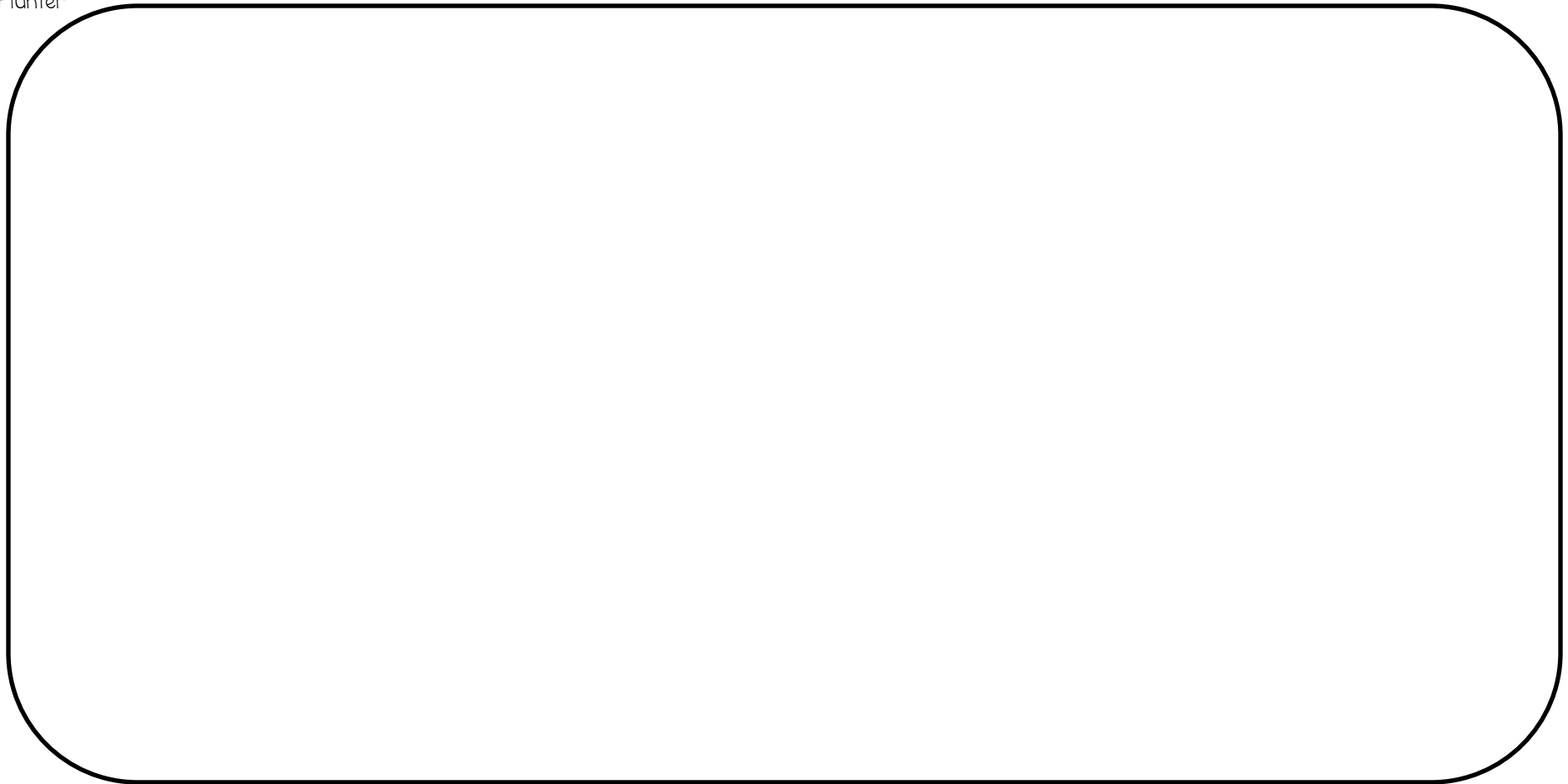


The Iroquois built bark houses.

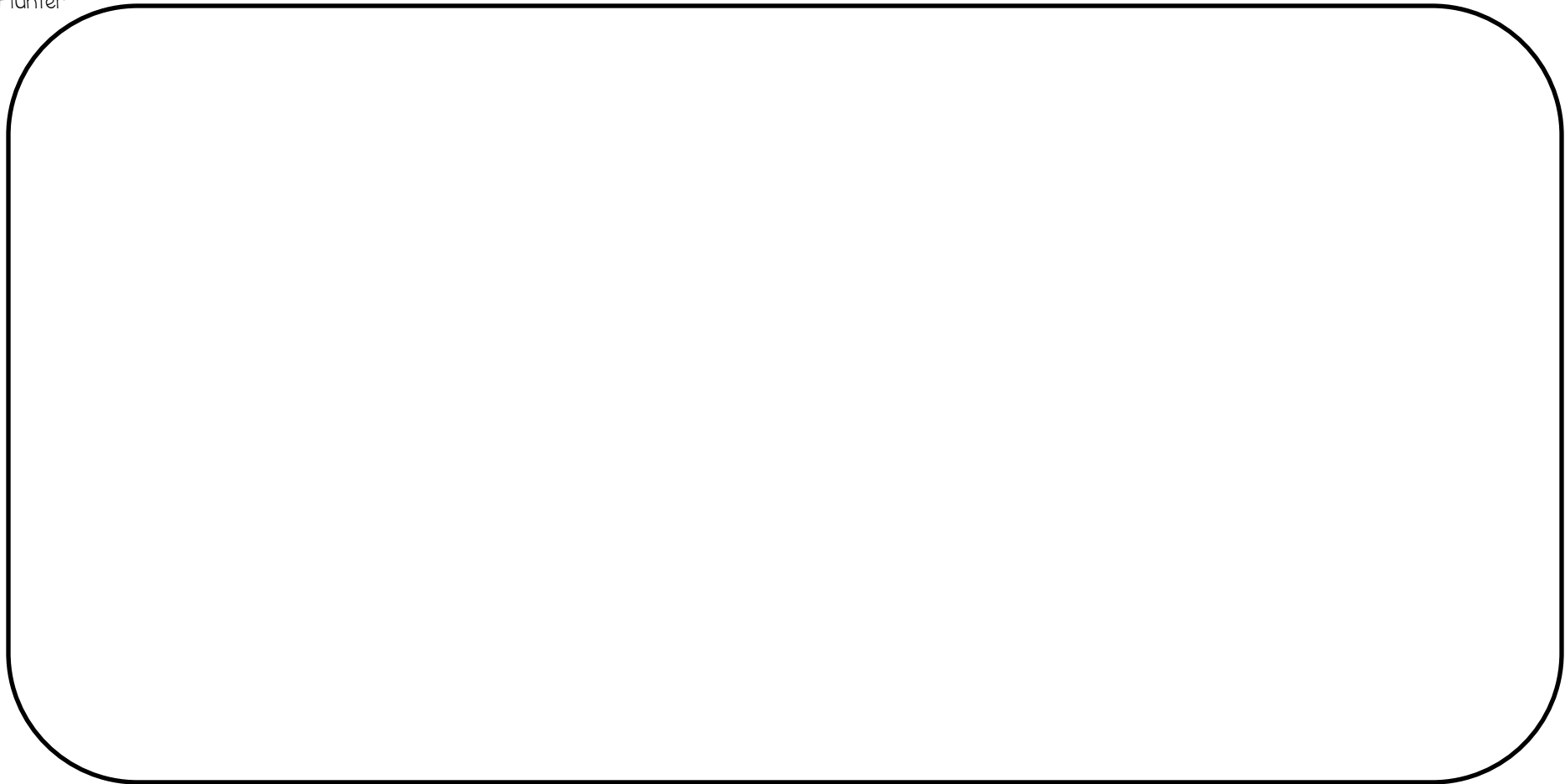
Some were very large. They were called longhouses. Many families lived in them.

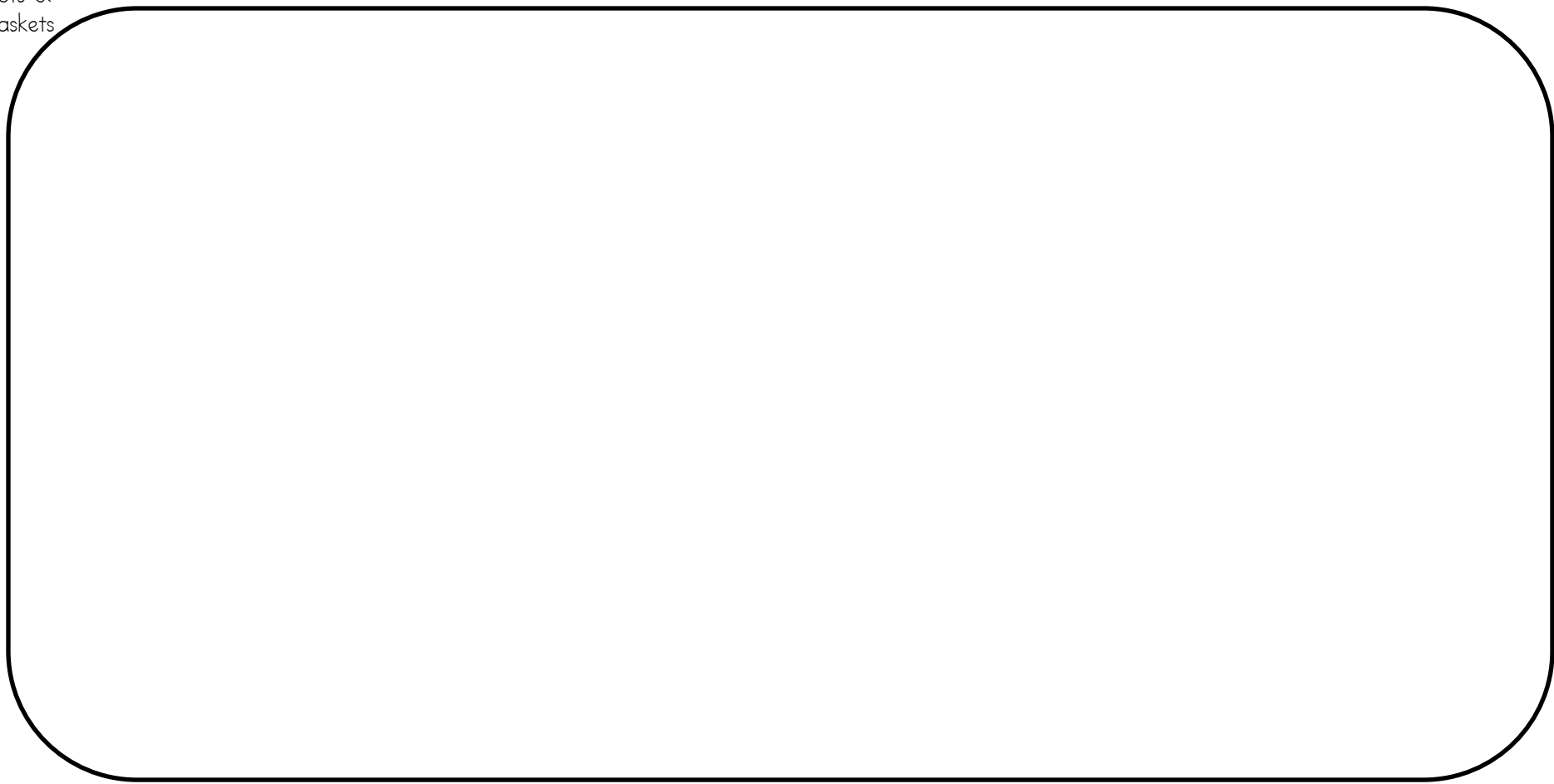
The Hopi lived in pueblos. Pueblos had several rooms. Many families lived together. A pueblo was like an apartment.



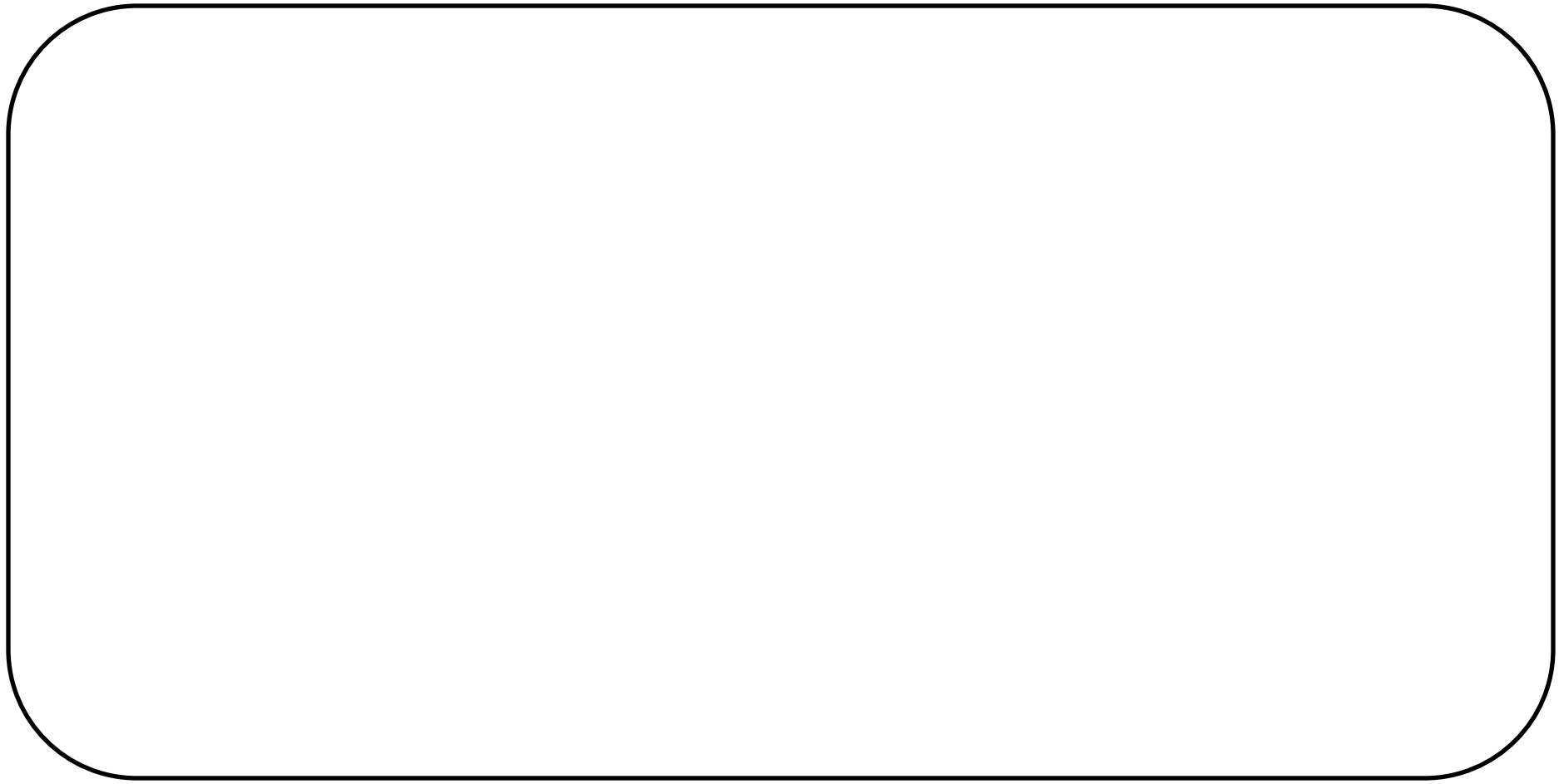

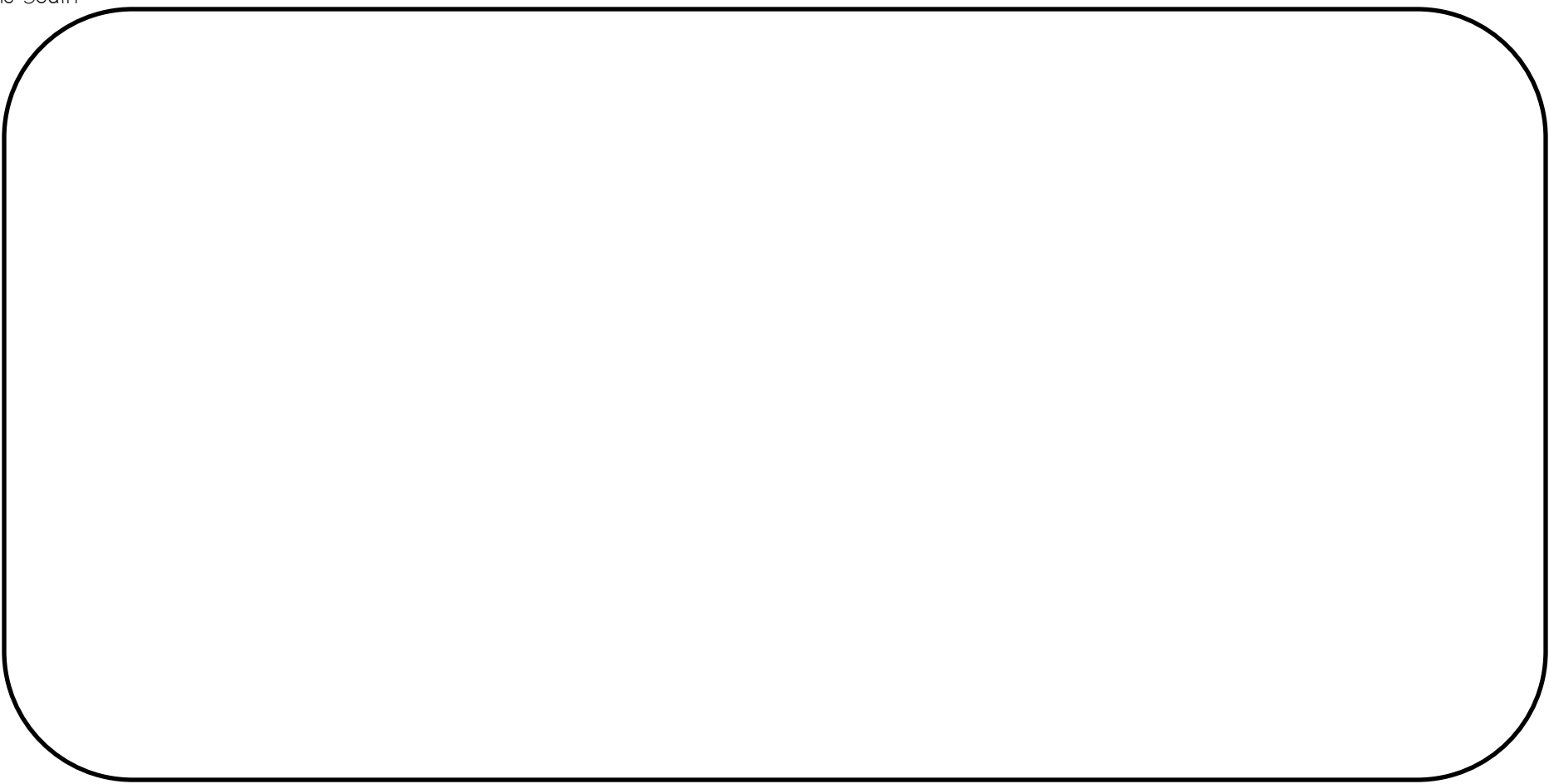

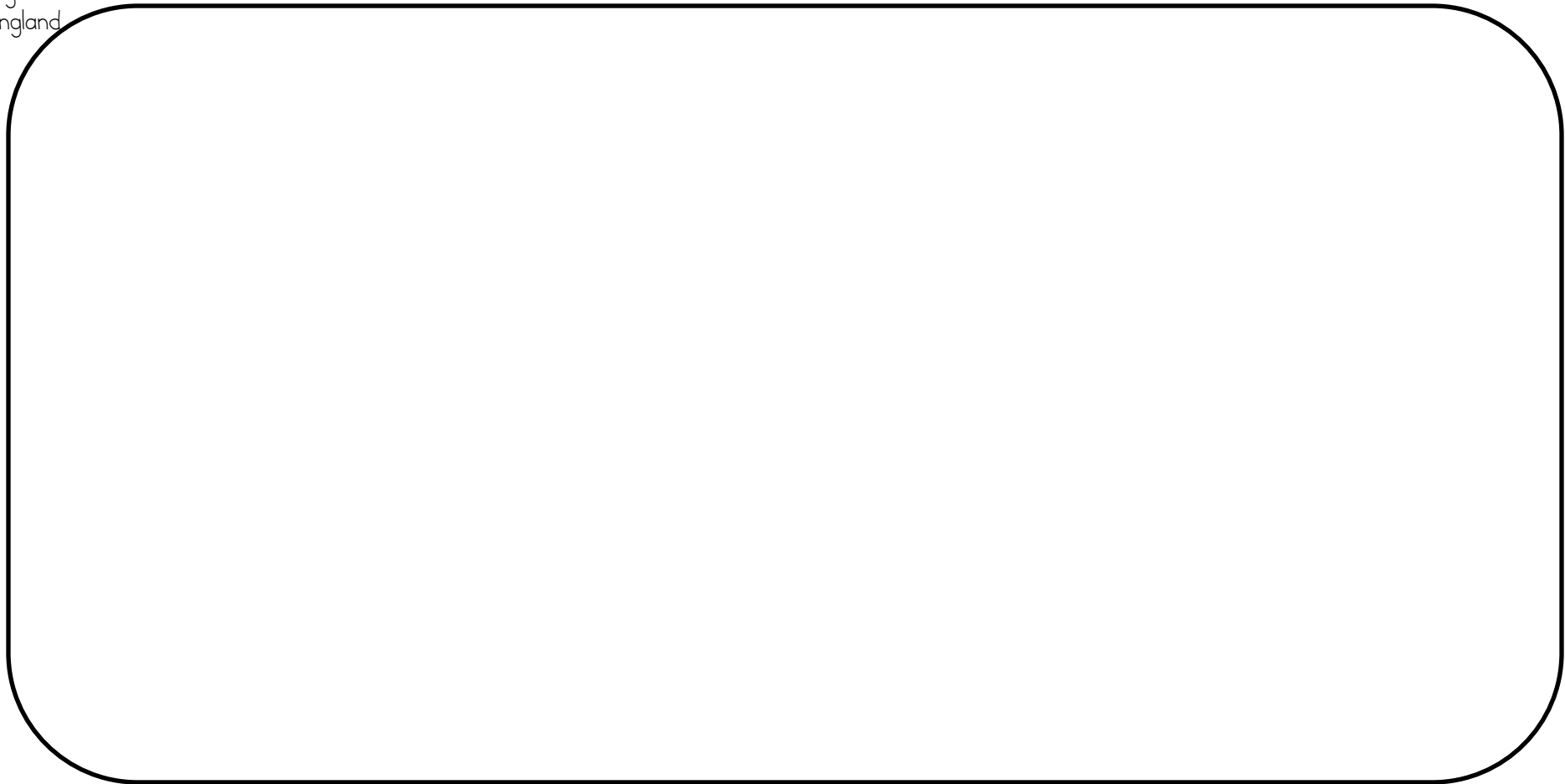
