Iowa Assessments Begin March 15

FDCSD 3-11 grade students will take the Iowa Assessment March 15-27.

The Iowa Assessments provide information about each child's academic achievements which we can use to help them excel and succeed. The Iowa Assessments provide detailed information about student growth and progress from year to year in content areas including reading, math and science. Information provided also shows a student's academic performance relative to their school, the district and the nation. All of this data helps teachers identify students' strengths as well as areas where additional emphasis may be needed.

By working together we can make your child's test experience positive and successful. Please help your child do his/her best by: Making sure that he/she gets to school on time. Being late or having to make up the test makes a student feel unsettled.

Ensuring that he/she gets a full night's rest before each test. Getting him/her a nutritious breakfast each morning of testing.

Encouraging your student to give his/her best effort. Refraining from scheduling doctor's appointments, vacations, etc. during the testing time frame.
