3D Cutlery Flowers


Use plastic party cutlery to make 3D flowers with. There are two designs above and if you have several spoons and forks you could make a bunch of flowers!

These can be painted like shown in the picture of the forks above and then paper or pipe cleaners added to make leaves around the stems.



Dried Pasta Necklace or Bracelet

Paint or decorate dried pasta shapes
When dry thread onto wool or string
to make necklaces or bracelets to
the length that you want.




Big Paper Hug!

Get a long piece of paper or join several pieces together to make a long strip. Colour, paint, decorate or collage the paper. When dry concertina up and put to one side. Draw around your hands and then cut out, these too can be coloured and decorated.

Attach a hand cut out to either end of the concertina strip and write a message on the hands...something like the one in the picture. Fold the hands up and unfold to give a big hug!


