Where such a mighty guest may come.

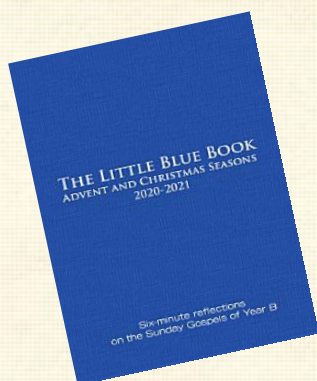

## OCEANSIDE INTERFAITH COUNCIL 2020 COMMUNITY THANKSGIVING DINNER

Here is a brief summary of the 2020 Thanksgiving Dinner Program:

- ◆ The OIC Dinner Committee gratefully thanks all the volunteers, and all the generous donors and vendors who assisted to make the program succeed in an entirely new way.
- ◆ The Council was able to serve **1,089** dinners to 908 individuals and to 181 first responders. It goes without saying that this was the largest, by far, number of dinners prepared and distributed in the 27-year history of this event.
- ◆ Everyone received a dinner that included turkey with gravy, mashed or sweet potatoes, a vegetable, a roll and a Thanksgiving themed decorated cupcake. Not a single bit of food went to waste.
- ◆ Due to greatly increased demand this year - and the limitations and restrictions involved in doing this program during the pandemic, costs & expenses were considerably greater and



made it necessary to rely on local caterers to prepare the meals --rather than cooking the dinners onsite.

- ◆ Logistically, from setting up and assembling the meal packages to dispatching volunteer drivers and delivery, everything went very smoothly.

◆ The generosity of the Oceanside community is astonishing. More money was raised than ever before in support of the dinner. In fact, the OIC **crowdfunding** site alone, which was established to help defray the increased costs, raised **\$11,536**; more than double the previous high.
