

This CSU is home to the longest operating graduate Criminalistics and Criminal Justice program west of the Mississippi. They also houses a crime lab for the police and sheriff department right on their campus.



This CSU became the first university in the US to have a winery fully licensed to produce, bottle and sell wine.











# "Name that CSU...."

This CSU houses the Capital Fellows Program to give students a handson learning experience about public service. Students work as fulltime staff members in the California State Assembly, Senate, Executive branches or within the California court system. The Capital Fellows Program is named one of the top 10 internship programs in the nation.



A 2 Years: US History & Social Science

B 4 Years: English

2 Years: Science with a Lab (biological and physical science)

**2 Years:** Language other than English

1 Year: Visual & Performing Arts (art, dance, drama/theatre, or music)

**1 Year:** 1 year selected from the UC "A-G" list

Students must receive a "C" or better in all A-G courses





# Grade Point Average | GPA

#### 9th Grade

✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better



#### 10th & 11th Grade

- ✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- ✓ Grades from 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grades are used to determine eligibility

#### 12th Grade

- ✓ Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- ✓ Grades from 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, & 12<sup>th</sup> grade are used to maintain eligibility
- CSU will award up to 8 points of AP/IB/Honors credit
   \*Grades of D or F earned in AP/IB/Honors courses are not given an extra point\*

# **CSU** Impaction

Campus Impaction: A campus receives more eligible applications in the initial filing period than there are enrollment spaces available for the <u>class level</u> (freshman or upper division transfer).

#### Campuses fall into 3 categories:

- Admit using CSU eligibility
- Campus impaction (freshman/transfer)
- Impacted in all programs (all majors)



The local area- includes all high schools in Orange County, Walnut, Whittier, Chino Valley, Corona, Norco and Alvord School districts.






### Cost of Attending a CSU

# Important Deadlines & Dates for CSUF (2016)

- Feb. 2 Official SAT and/or ACT scores must be submitted
- Mar. 2 Last day to apply for priority consideration (Financial Aid: <a href="https://fafsa.ed.gov/">https://fafsa.ed.gov/</a>)
- Mar. 20 7<sup>th</sup> semester transcripts must be submitted (if requested)
- Apr. 9 Welcome to CSUF Day
- May 1 Last day to accept admissions and pay \$250 enrollment deposit
- May 2 Last day to take all required ELM & EPT placement tests.
- May 13 Sign up for New Student Orientation
- July 15 Submit final official transcripts

\*Deadlines are strictly enforced. Students who miss a stated deadline may have their application cancelled or their admission rescinded\*
