Frequently Asked Questions about Headquarters Conferences

• Do I need to register in advance?

• In order to ensure a seat at the program, it is best to register in advance. Some programs have limited enrollment and can sell out.

• How can I register?

By mail to: Conference Registrar, A.R.E. Headquarters Conferences, 215 67th St., Virginia Beach, Va., 23451 and give name of conference, member ID#, and customer code. Make check payable to "A.R.E." **On-line:** Click on the registration link for the program you are attending.

By cash: You may pay cash at the door as space allows. Please do not send cash through the mail.

At-door: We highly recommend advance registration. However, you can register at the door as space allows and pay by cash, check, or credit card.

Registration Confirmation:

By Online, Phone, or Mail: A confirmation postcard will be mailed to you in the postal mail. You'll receive a name badge and any other conference materials in person at registration check-in the day of the program.

• I registered online. Will I receive an e-mail confirmation?

• You will receive a registration confirmation postcard by postal mail. You'll receive an attendee packet, name badge, and other materials in person at registration check-in the day of the program.

• Will I receive a packet of materials by mail?

• You will receive a registration confirmation postcard in the postal mail. You'll receive an attendee packet, name badge, and other materials in person at registration check-in the day of the program.

• Where do I check in for the conference once I arrive at the A.R.E.?

• Registration is held in the Visitor's Center. You will receive a packet and name badge at check-in.

• Do I need a ticket?

 You'll receive a registration confirmation postcard in the postal mail; it is not necessary to bring it with you but it's helpful. Your name badge will be given to you in person at registration check-in at the start of the program. Your name badge is your admission and you will receive that at registration check-in. Please wear it at all times.

• How will I be notified if a program is cancelled?

 Program changes and notifications will be sent to registrants via e-mail, so please <u>be sure we have your</u> <u>current e-mail on file and check it before you depart</u>. Should A.R.E. deem it necessary to cancel or postpone a conference due to speaker cancellation, extreme weather conditions, or other unforeseeable event, A.R.E. bares no responsibility for attendee expenses other than a refund of registered attendees' program tuition. • I need to cancel. Can I get a refund?

• For most programs, you may receive a full refund or credit toward another conference. Some programs incur a processing fee and/or forfeiture of deposit. See individual program registration pages for details.

• What is a Life Member program?

 Certain programs are designated as "Life Member" programs. Registration for these programs is open to all members and non-members, however, A.R.E. Life Members may chose to redeem their Life Member Pass to attend. A.R.E. Life Members are eligible to attend one designated Life Member program per year.

Do you issue CEU's (Continuing Education Units) for your conferences?

 \circ $\,$ No, A.R.E. does not issue CEU's unless indicated on the brochure.

• Can I get a Certificate of Attendance or Certificate of Completion?

• There is a \$30 fee for a Certificate of Attendance or Completion for a conference that you have attended, unless stated otherwise in the course description. You will receive your certificate approximately three weeks after your request. This is not a Continuing Education Certificate.

• Can I get a printout of the schedule?

• Once available, the daily schedule is posted online at EdgarCayce.org/conferences either on the brochure pdf or on the programs schedule page. It is usually available 10 to 12 weeks in advance of the program date.

• How do I get to the A.R.E.?

• Our address is 215 67thStreet (at Atlantic Avenue) in Virginia Beach. You'll find directions on our Web site: Edgarcayce.org/directions.

• Where can I stay?

- The Wyndham Virginia Beach is the closest hotel to A.R.E. They provide free parking and a free shuttle to the A.R.E., plus a discounted rate for our conference attendees. All rooms include a microwave, refrigerator, hair dryer, and coffee maker. For hotel reservations, call 800-365-3032. Be sure to tell them you are attending an A.R.E. conference. Please make your reservations early, since hotels in our area are often booked months in advance, and the Wyndham cannot guarantee a room fewer than four weeks prior to a conference. - Holiday Inn Express at 2607 Atlantic Ave., offers all oceanfront rooms with private balconies and free breakfast. *Please make your reservations early; rates are available based on hotel availability.* For hotel reservations, call 757-491-6900 and ask for the A.R.E. group discount.

- Is there a shuttle from the Wyndham Hotel to the A.R.E.?
 - The Wyndham hotel will provide a free shuttle service to and from the A.R.E. according to the conference schedule given to them by the Conferences team. The hotel is about 10 blocks away from the A.R.E.
- What is the closest Airport?
 - o Norfolk International Airport is about 30 minutes west of Virginia Beach.

Is there a shuttle from the airport to local hotels?

- Shuttle services are available and average \$55. Taxis and rental cars are also available.
- Where is the nearest campground?
 - There are several campgrounds nearby. The most convenient is First Landing State Park on the Chesapeake Bay, located about five minutes from A.R.E. Contact dcr.virginia.gov/state-parks for more information and reservations.
- Where are the conferences held?
 - Conferences are held in the A.R.E. Headquarters Visitor Center in the Main Auditorium, on our campus in Virginia Beach. For Field conferences, venues vary by city and program.
- What type of clothing should I bring?
 - In Virginia Beach, temperatures vary from generally cool winters to hot summers. To make sure you are comfortable during the program itself, it is a good idea to wear comfortable, layered clothing.
- Can I bring my own water and snacks?
 - You can, but water and other beverages and light refreshments are provided during program breaks and also are available for purchase in our bookstore and in our new Cayce-Miller Café.
- Is there a lunch service?
 - Lunches can be purchased in our new Leaping Lizard Restaurant in the Cayce-Miller Café. They prepare delicious fresh, natural, and locally-sourced sustainable foods. The menu varies but includes salads, sandwiches, soups, vegetarian and gluten-free options, desserts, and fresh breads baked in their own bakery. The café hours are currently Tuesday-Sunday 11-3, and hours may vary depending on conference schedule and other activities.
