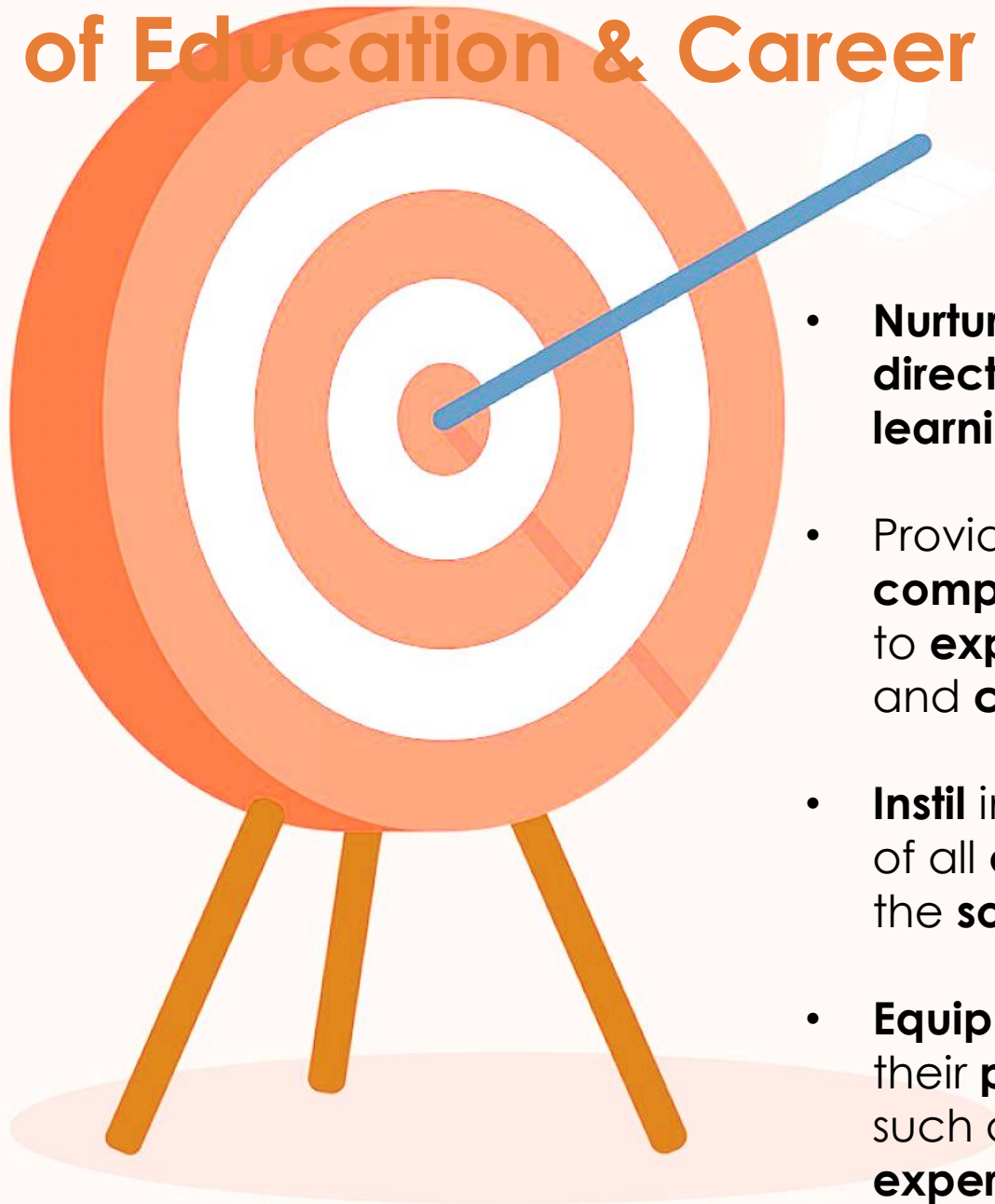

What is Education & Career Guidance (ECG)?

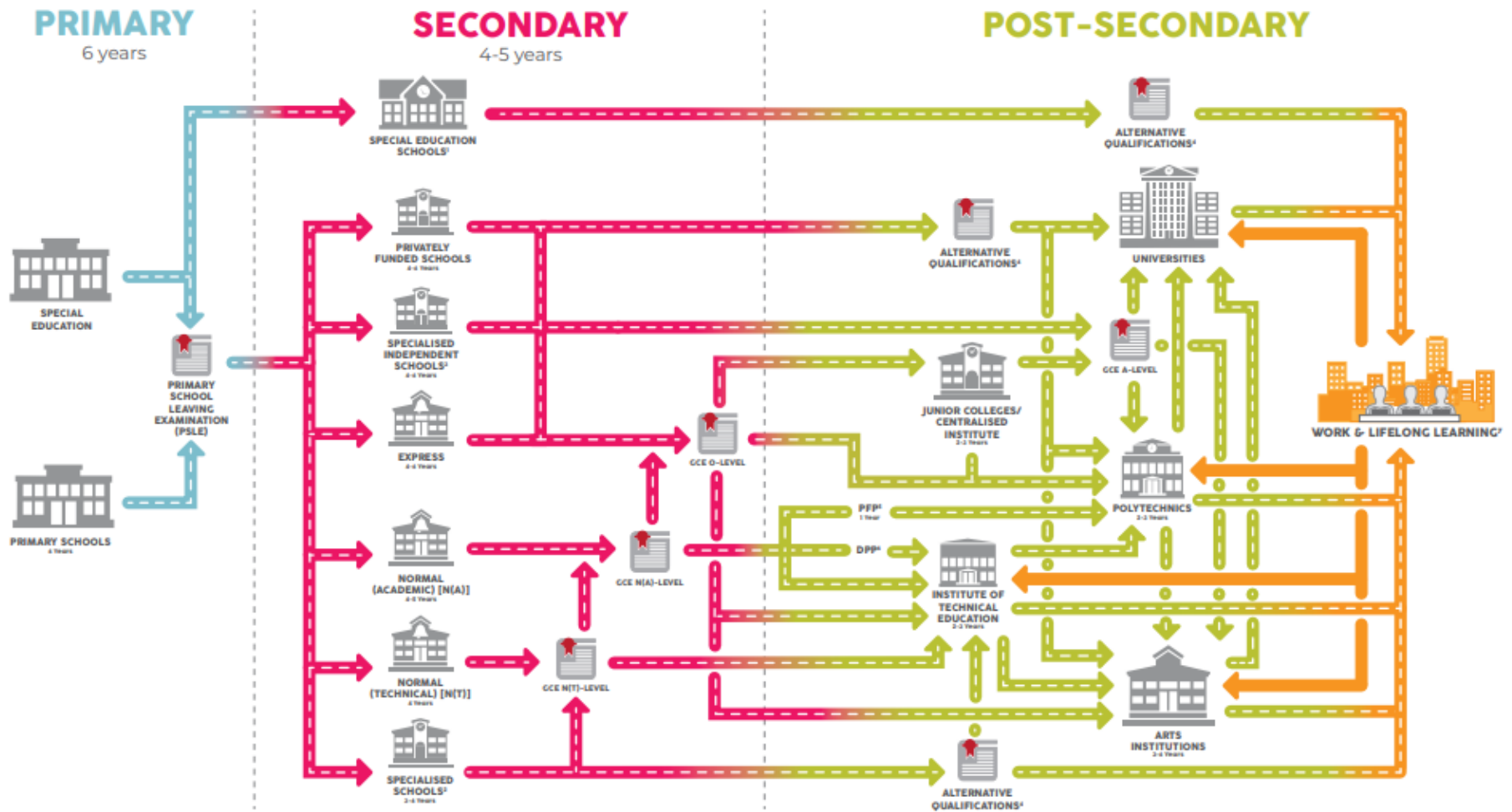
- Aims to **equip** students with the necessary **knowledge, skills** and **values** to make **informed education** and **career decisions**.

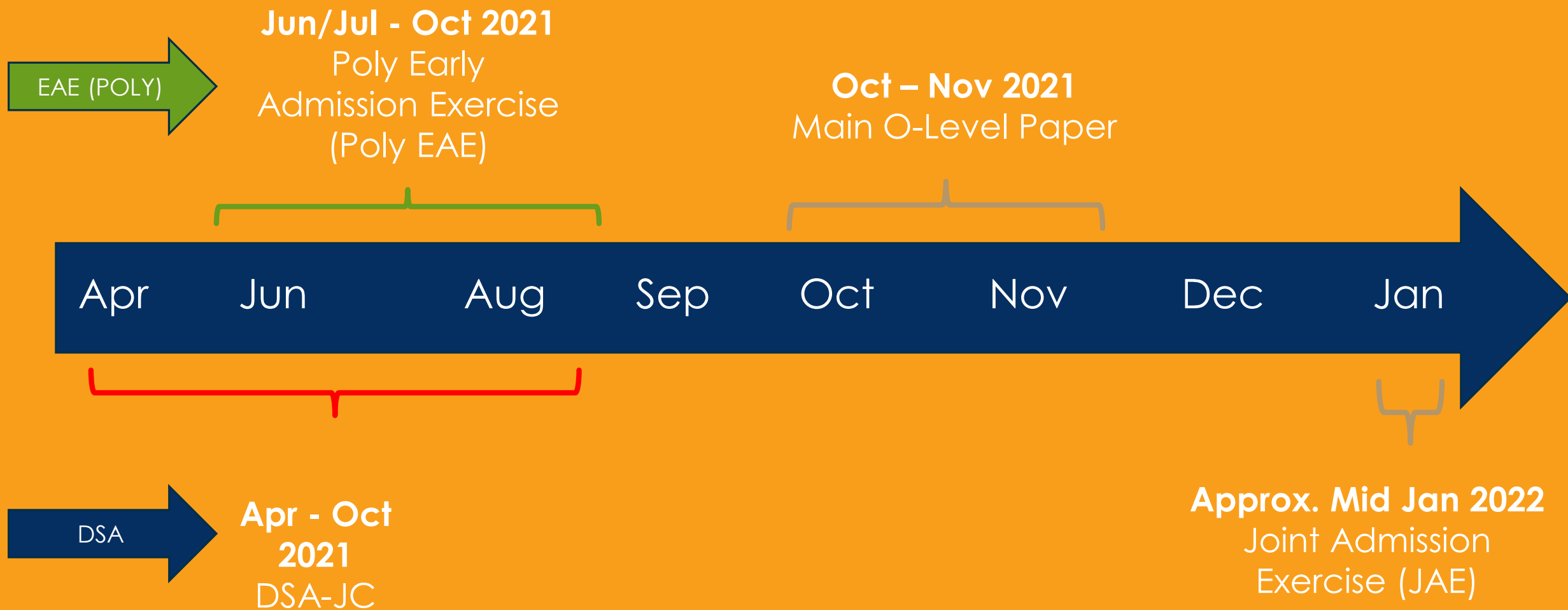

In General

- The conditional offer is automatically confirmed once your child meets the requirement for the JC-DSA or Poly-EAE course.
- As such, your child **will not be given** the option to apply Joint Admission Exercise (JAE).
- Students who wish to withdraw from their conditional offers must do so before the stipulated deadlines.

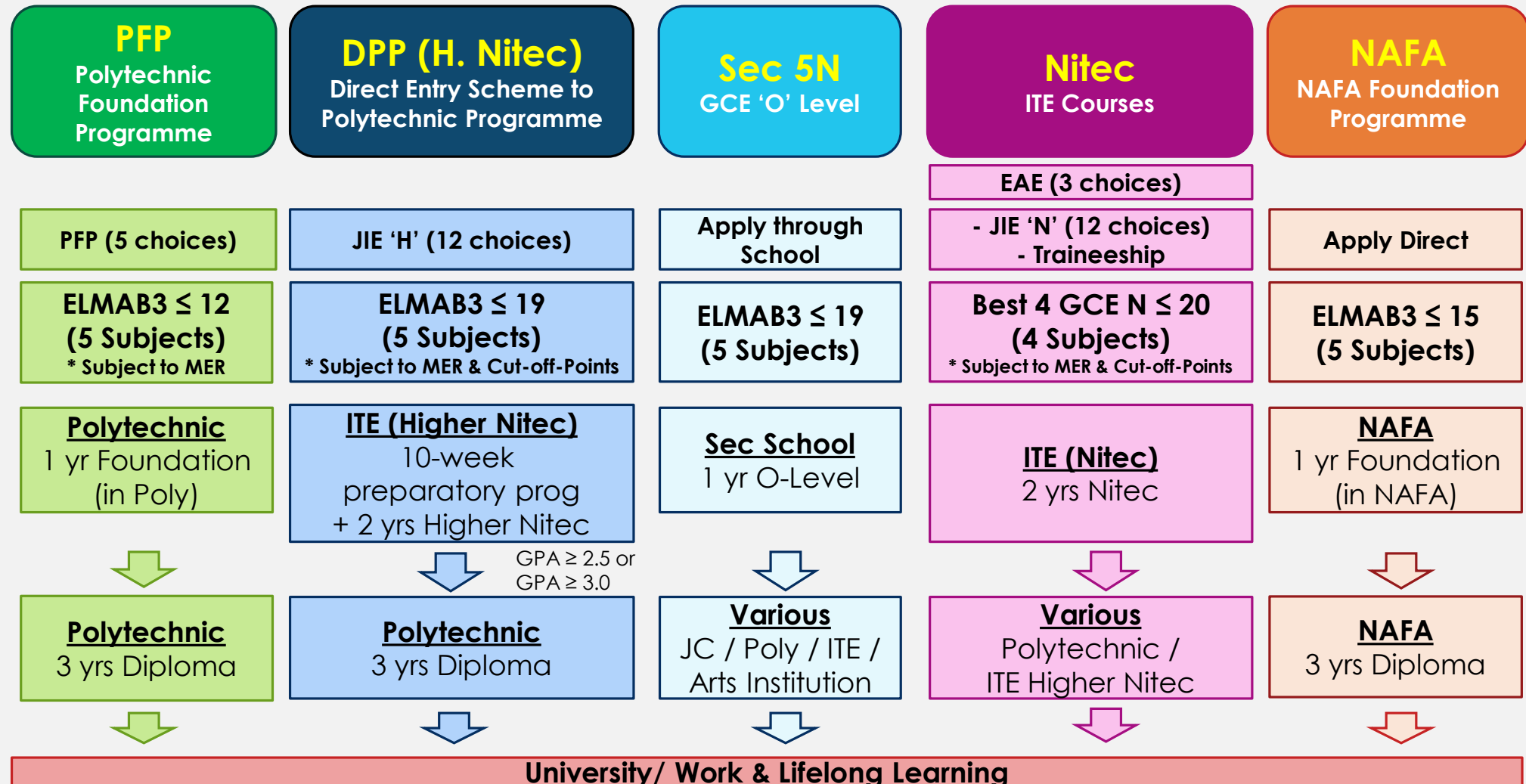
DSA-JC

- O levels results must meet JC Admission requirement to secure the place.

Poly-EAE

- Do be aware of the minimum entry requirements and aggregate score (NET ELR2B2 \leq 26) required to secure the place.

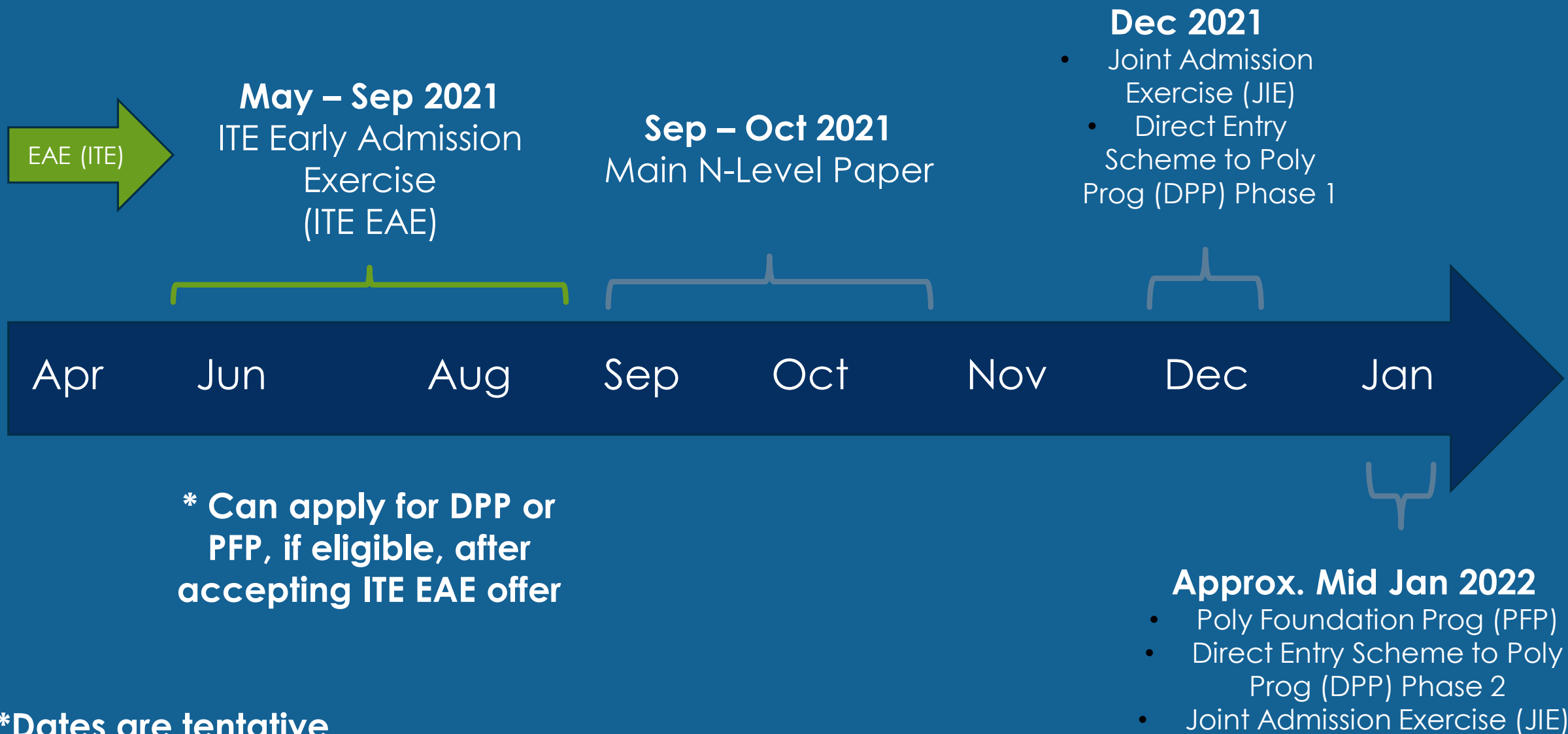

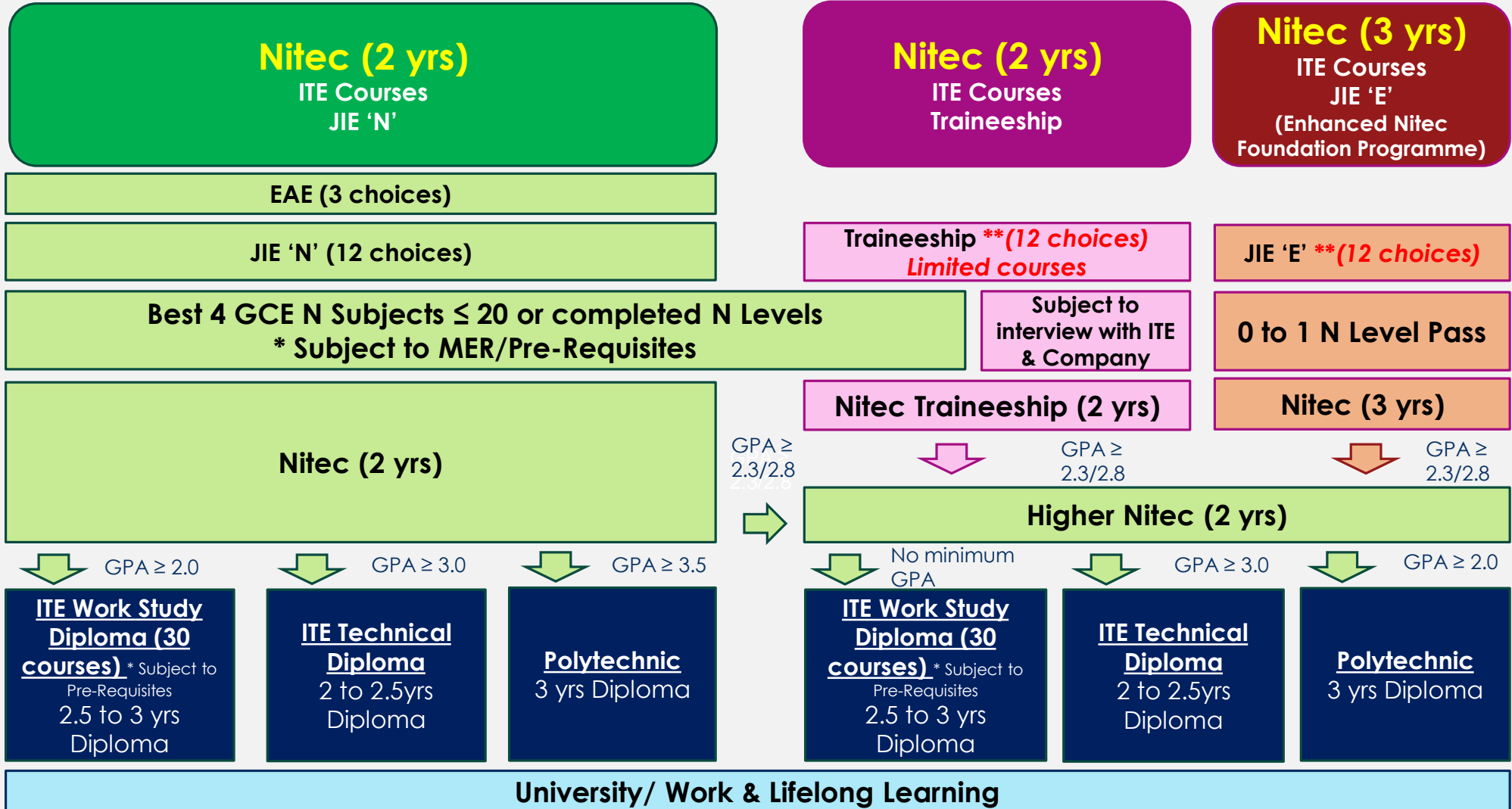

TYPICAL TIMELINE – 4NA



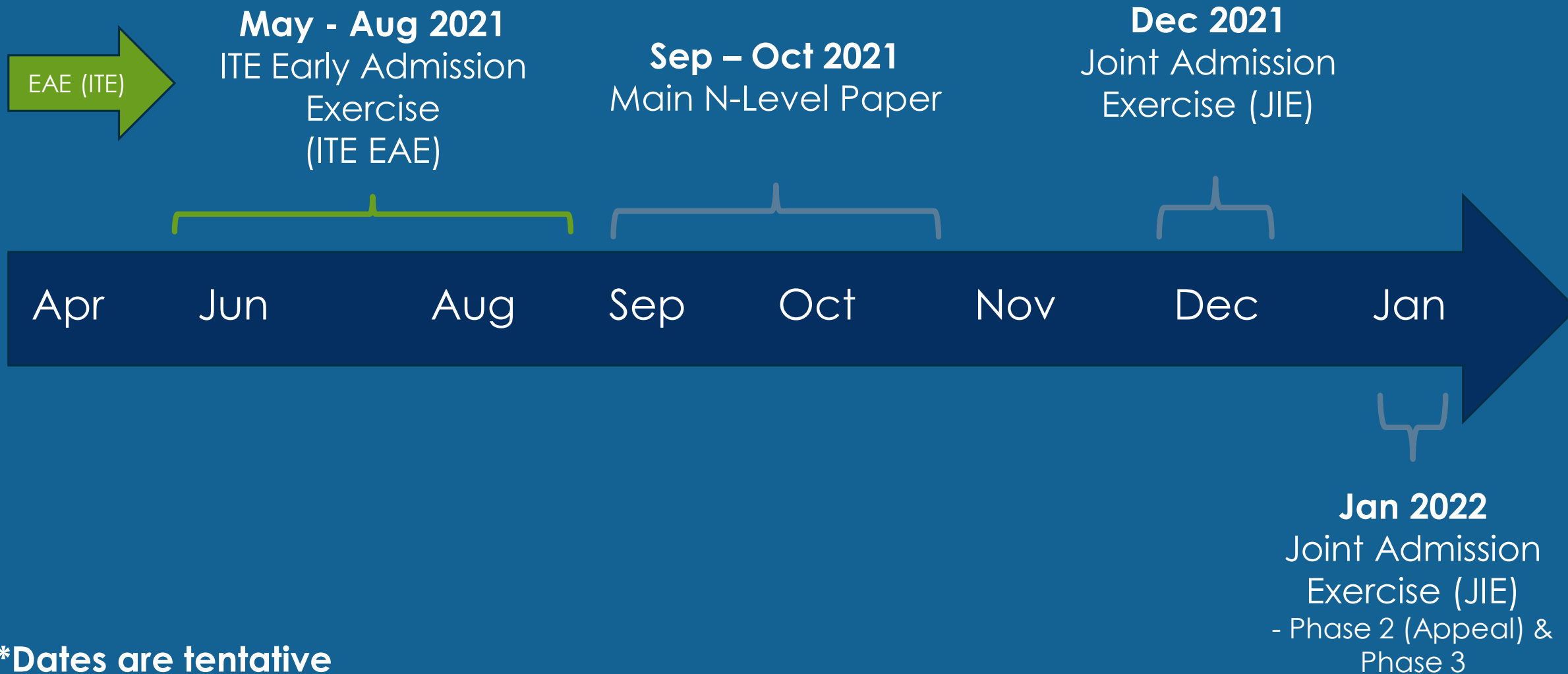

TYPICAL TIMELINE – 4NT



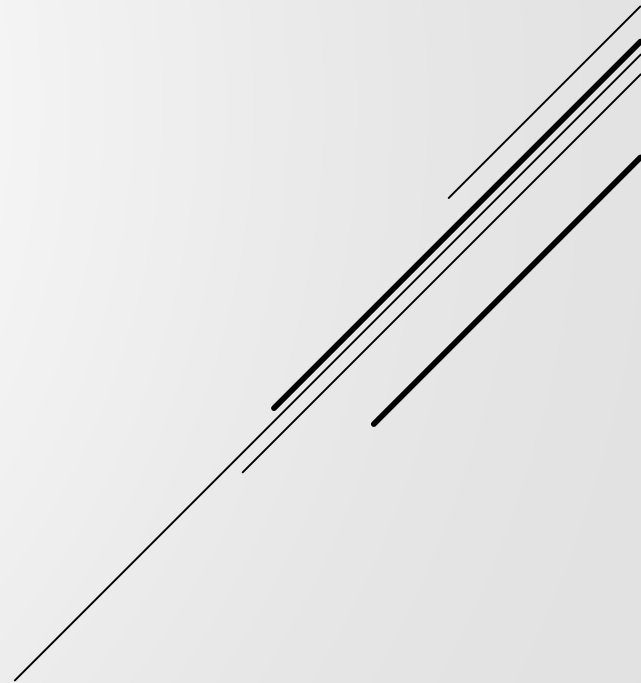

ITE-EAE


- When your child has accepted an ITE EAE offer, he or she is deemed to be admitted into the school (must meet Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) and **not allowed** to participate in JIE after GCE 'N' Results
- However, if your child (from 4NA) qualifies for **Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) / Secondary 5 (O Levels)** or **Poly Foundation Programme (PFP)**, he or she **can still apply** for these courses, and to withdraw from ITE EAE once placing has been confirmed. PFP application opens in January, hence students applying for PFP may progress to ITE first and may withdraw once PFP is confirmed.
- Students who wish to withdraw from the conditional offer must do so before the stipulated deadline.
