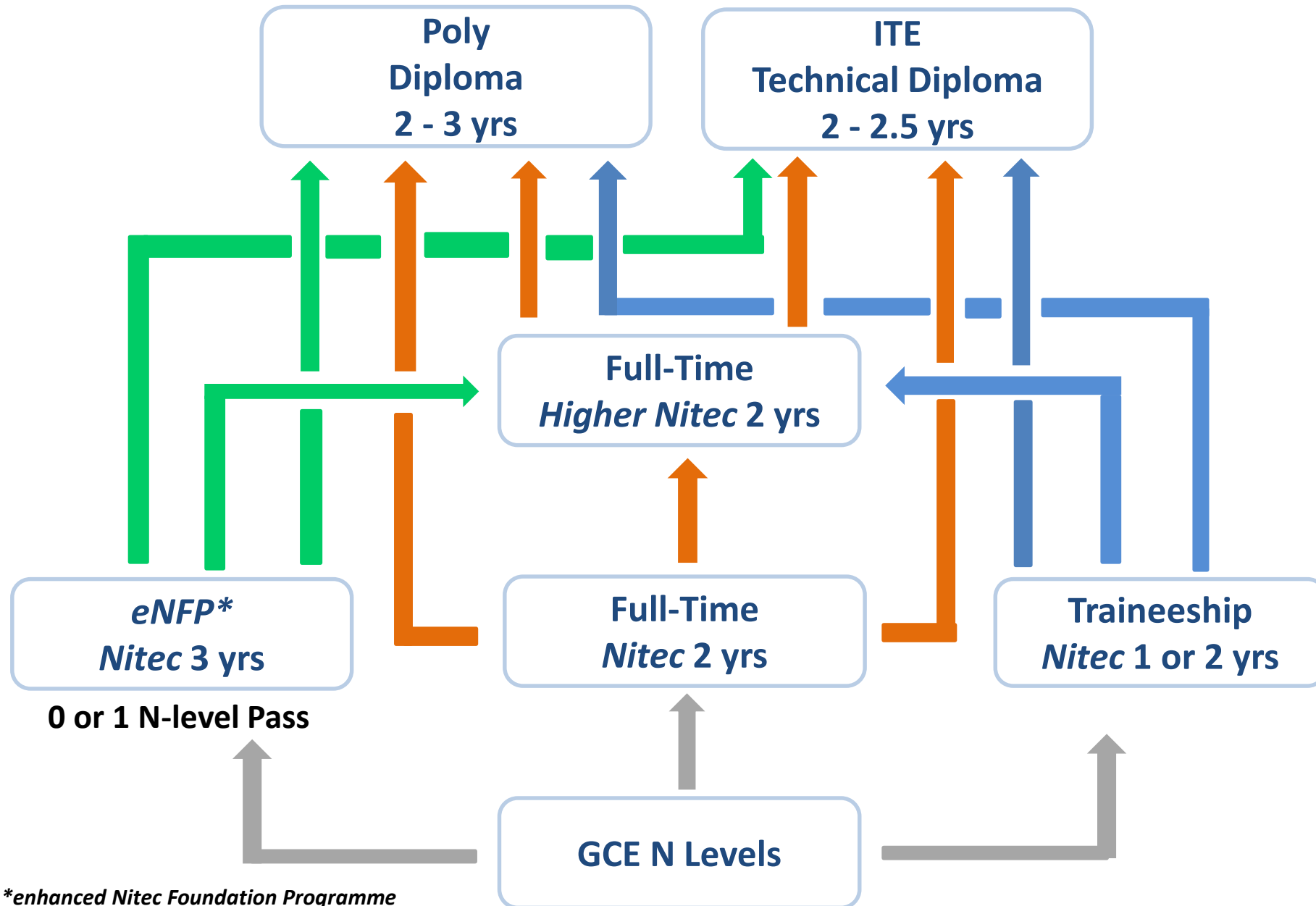

# Nitec courses

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- **3 Types**
  - **Full-time** studies (2 years)
  - **Traineeship** Programme (1-2 years)
  - **Enhanced *Nitec* Foundation Programme** (3 years)
- **6 Course Clusters**
  - Applied and Health Sciences    - Business and Services
  - Hospitality                            - Design and Media
  - Electronics & ICT                      - Engineering
- **Progression Opportunities**
  - ***Higher Nitec***: needs *Nitec* GPA  $\geq 2.3$  or  $2.8$  depending on the course
  - **Poly Diploma**: needs *Nitec* GPA  $\geq 3.5$  depending on the course
  - **ITE Technical Diploma**: needs *Nitec* GPA  $\geq 3.0$  or *Higher Nitec* GPA  $\geq 2.0$
  - **ITE Work-Study Diploma**: needs *Nitec* GPA  $\geq 2.0$

(No GPA requirement for *Higher Nitec*)

  - **Employment**



# What is there after *Nitec*?

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- Progression opportunities:
  1. Higher Nitec
  2. ITE Technical Diploma
  3. Polytechnic Diploma (needs *Nitec* GPA  $\geq$  3.5)
  4. Work-Learn Technical Diploma (WLTD)
  5. Earn & Learn Programme (ELP)
    - Work + Study (12 to 18 months) in a Poly
    - Completion: Certificate + Potential wage increase
    - Add few more modules => Convert to a Poly Diploma
  6. Employment

<b>B (70-74)</b>	<b>2</b>
<b>C (60-69)</b>	<b>3</b>
<b>D (50-59)</b>	<b>4</b>
<b>U &lt; 50</b>	<b>5</b>

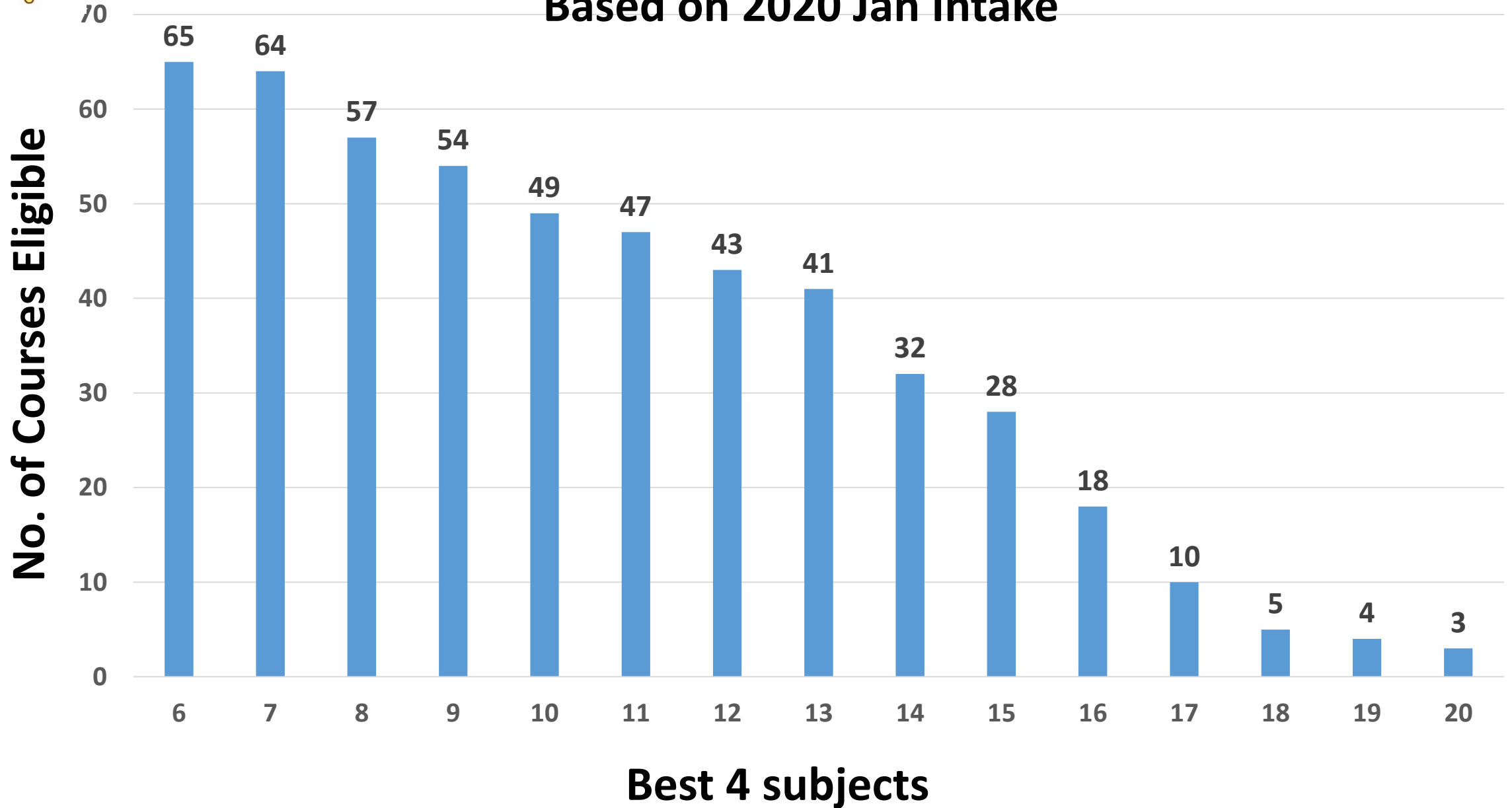
# Computation for Admission to Full Time Nitec Courses at ITE

- **Bonus Points**

<b>Types of Bonus Points</b>	<b>No. of Bonus Points awarded</b>
<b>CCA grades: Excellent Good</b>	<b>2 points 1 point</b>
<b>Applicants with GCE N (A) Level grades of 1 to 5 for pre-requisite subjects (e.g. Mathematics, English and Science) for the courses applied for</b>	<b>2 points for each prerequisite subject, up to a maximum of 4 points for the course applied for</b>

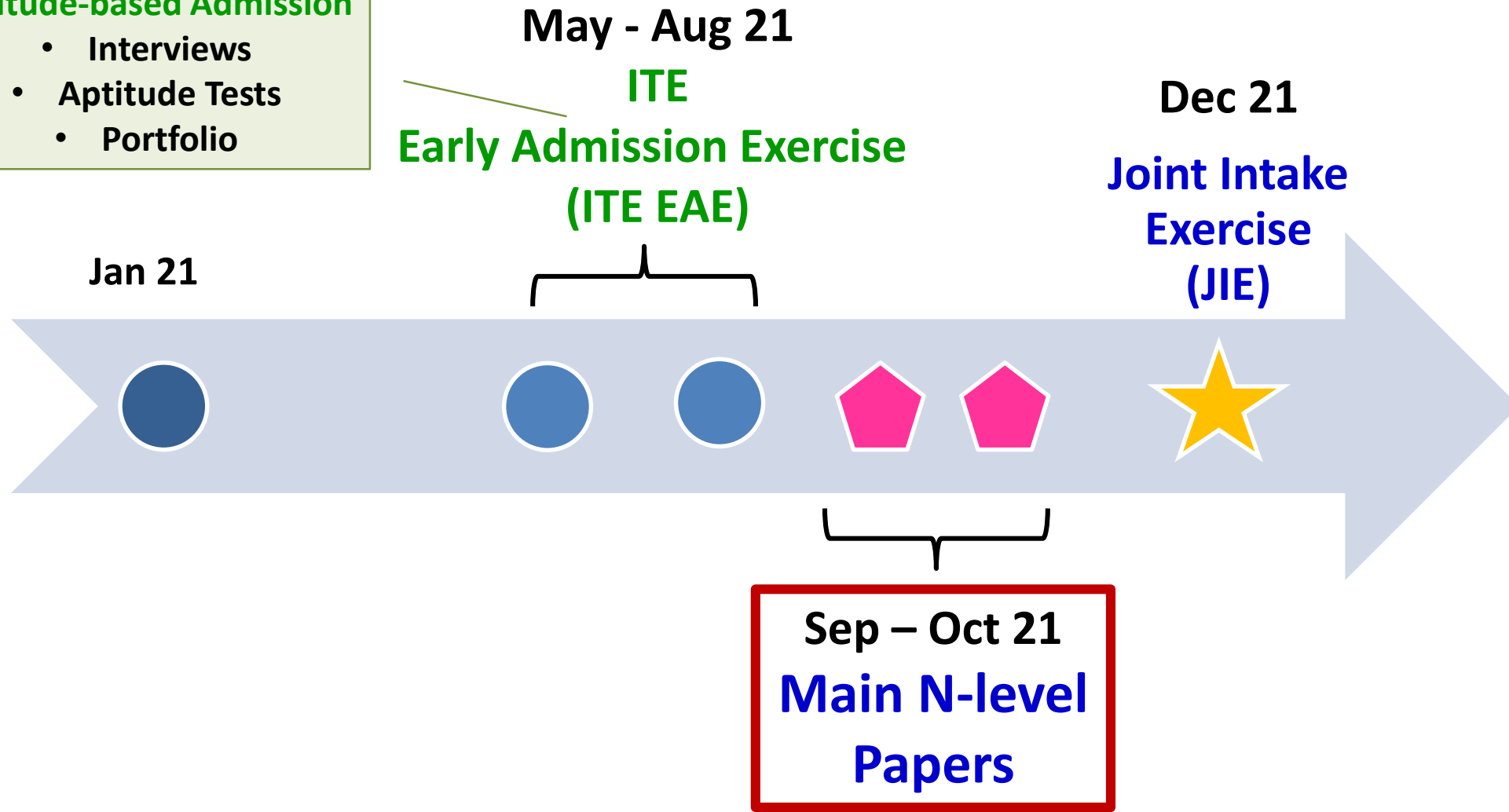

- Aptitude Tests
- Portfolio

# ITE Early Admission Exercise (EAE)

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- **Aptitude-based** admission to Poly
  - Course-specific aptitudes and interests
  - Other considerations  
(eg. Sports/Arts/Leadership/Service/Entrepreneurship etc)
- **Interviews; Aptitude tests ; Portfolio review**
- Provisional Offering of a place in Poly prior to N-level exams
- Meet **Minimum Entry Requirements**
  - eg. pass in English/Math/Science etc
- **Application Period: May (Tentative)**

## More Choices

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- Aim for **at least 4 N-level Passes**, including EL, Math and Science

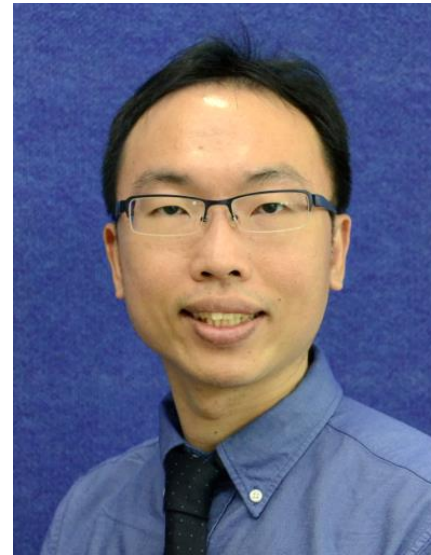

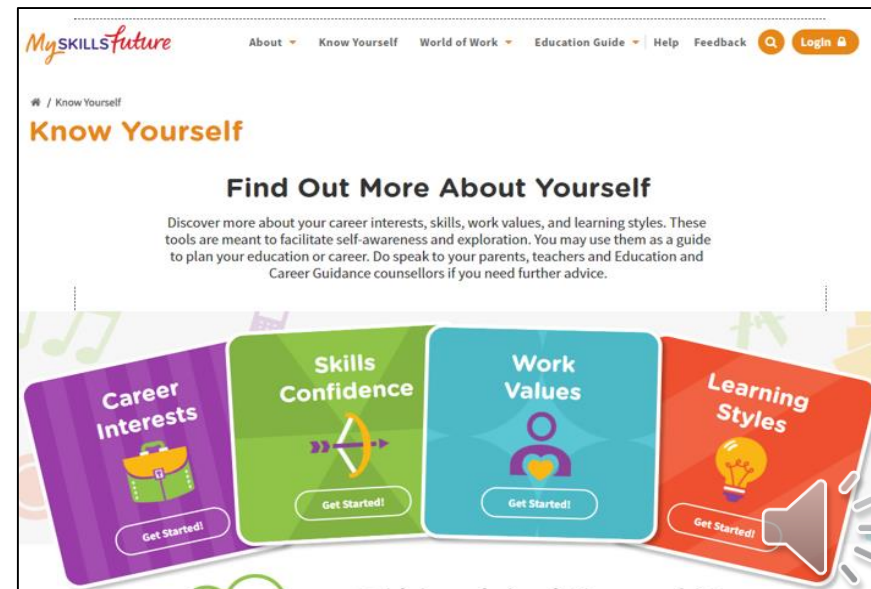

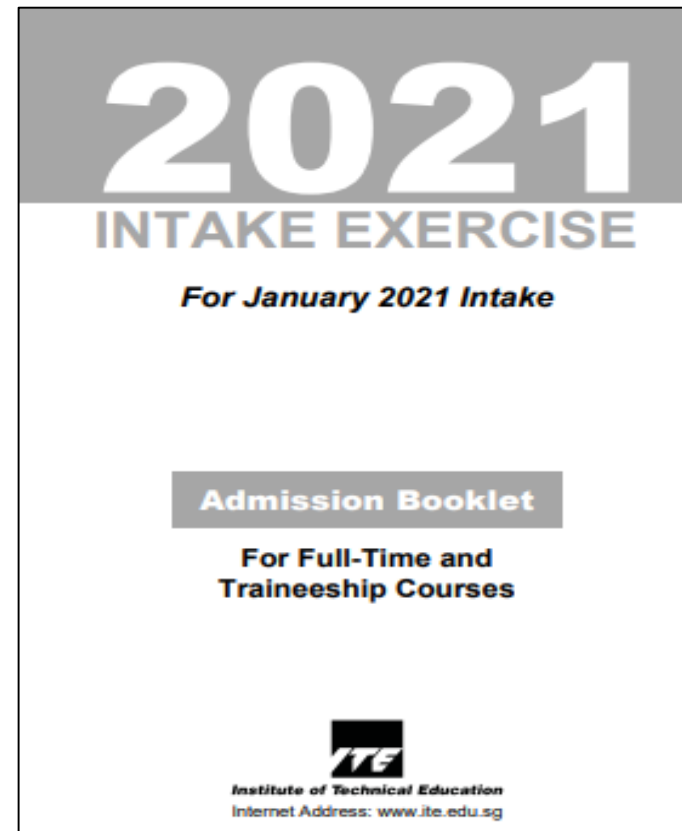
