

Countdown to Launch of AMSAT's RadFxSat Fox-1B)

RadFxSat (Fox-1B) is scheduled for launch on November 10, 2017. RadFxSat is one of four CubeSats making up the NASA ELaNa XIV mission, riding as secondary payloads aboard the Joint Polar Satellite System (JPSS)-1 mission. JPSS-1 will launch on a Delta II from Vandenberg Air Force Base, California.

RadFxSat is a partnership with Vanderbilt University ISDE and hosts four payloads for the study of radiation effects on commercial off the shelf components. RadFx-Sat features the Fox-1 style FM U/ v repeater with an uplink on 435.250 MHz (67.0 Hz CTCSS) and a downlink on 145.960 MHz.

New Digital Modes Changing Complexion of Bands and Perhaps of Ham Radio

The wave of software-based digital modes over the past several years has altered the atmosphere of the HF bands. Some suggest the popularity of modes that make it possible to contact stations neither operator can even hear has resulted in fewer CW and SSB signals on bands like 6 meters and 160 meters. Traditional modes require far more interaction and effort on the part of the operator; the newer digital modes, not so much. The recent advent of the still-beta "quick" FT8 mode, developed by Steve Franke, K9AN, and Joe Taylor, K1JT -- the "F" and the "T" in the mode's moniker -- has brought this to a head. Some now wonder if FT8 marks the end of an era and the start of a new, more minimalist age.

ARRL November Sweepstakes

For many, ARRL November Sweepstakes (SS) is the premier ARRL fall operating event, with the lure of a "Clean Sweep" being the ultimate goal. The challenge of SS is to work as many stations in as many of the 83 ARRL and Radio Amateurs of Canada (RAC) sections as possible. Be the first in your neighborhood to work all 83 and qualify for a "Clean Sweep" mug!

SS takes place on separate November weekends. The CW weekend is November 4-6, and the SSB weekend is November 18-20. The contest period for each contest begins at 2100 UTC on Saturday and continues through 0259 UTC on Monday. Stations may operate 24 hours of the available 30 hours. In a change this year, logs are due **5 days** after each event. SS is a "domestic" contest with broad appeal, and even stations with modest equipment and antennas can enjoy success.

Given its origins in the traffic-handling realm, ARRL November Sweepstakes has a lengthy exchange that replicates a radiogram preamble. In SS, stations exchange:

- A consecutive serial number (NR).
- Operating category -- Q for Single Op QRP; A for Single Op, Low Power (up to 150 W output); B for Single Op,

DX Insights

REVILLAGIGEDO ISLANDS, XF4 IOTA NA-030

#34 on the DXCC MOST WANTED LIST

The Revillagigedo Islands, located 450 miles off the coast of Mexico in the Pacific Ocean, have been under Mexican federal jurisdiction since 1861. The archipelago consists of three small islands with the island of Socorro home to a small military garrison. No other occupants live on the island.

The island is known for its unique ecosystem and is considered the Galapagos of Mexico. There are many native land and sea birds on the island as well as native plants and flora. The seas around the island are popular with scuba divers and have a vast variety of marine life. Visiting expeditions usually stay aboard their vessels and not on the island.


There have been several DXpeditions to the islands over the years. Getting the permits and authorization is very difficult to obtain. Because of the distance from the Mexican main land, the ITU prefix **XF4** was given and it is considered a separate entity for DXCC credit. The last DXpedition to operate from the island was a international group using the call 4A4A in March of 2011.

The bands are picking up with the change in the season and some good DX is showing up on the higher bands as well as the WARC bands. If you haven't been active it's time to tune the bands in search of a new one or new band entity.
